City of Clintonville Seeks Community Input on Shaping its Future!

The City of Clintonville is seeking input from residents, businesses, visitors and others on how it will look in the future in terms of housing, business development, downtown revitalization, and transportation. In partnership with the Chamber of Commerce and working with East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission and SEH consultants, the City is in the process of updating both its current Comprehensive Plan, commonly referred to as a “Smart Growth” plan, and the Downtown Master Plan.

As part of the effort to engage the community in this project, a public visioning workshop, held in an “open house” format, will be held on **Wednesday, December 6, 2017 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** at the Clintonville Community Center, 30 N. Main Street. No pre-registration is required.

Project representatives will walk participants through a series of quick, thoughtful and highly visual exercises which are meant to stimulate and document ideas and concerns in topic areas associated with community identity, land use, housing, transportation, economic development, recreation, downtown revitalization and more! The workshop will assist in the initial stages of formulating a vision for how the City will look, function and feel as new development (or re-development) takes place over the next twenty years. Participants are encouraged to stop in, even if only for 10 or minutes, to share their thoughts and ideas.
