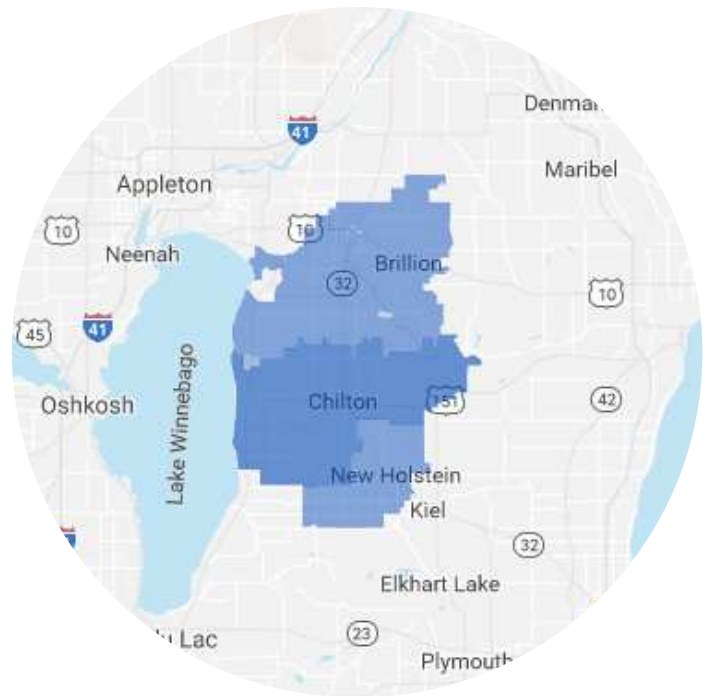
Median household income is **\$14.7K above** the national median household income of \$55.3K.

As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 1.1%** since 2013, growing by 527. Population is expected to **increase by 1.7%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 867.

From 2013 to 2018, jobs **increased by 6.0%** in Calumet County, WI from 14,539 to **15,406**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.4% by 1.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 70.4% to 71.5% between 2013 and 2018**.

Concerning educational attainment, **21.8% of Calumet County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.2% above the national average), and **11.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.2% above the national average).

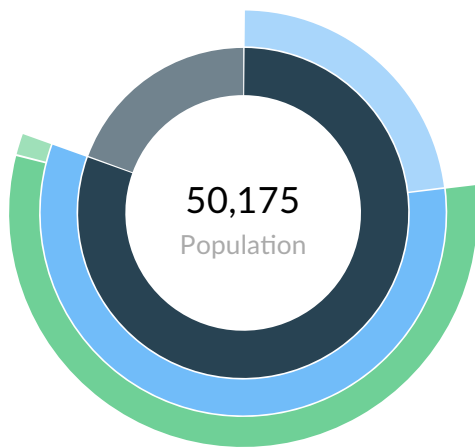
The top three industries in 2018 are Agriculture, Construction, and Mining Machinery Manufacturing, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Animal Production.

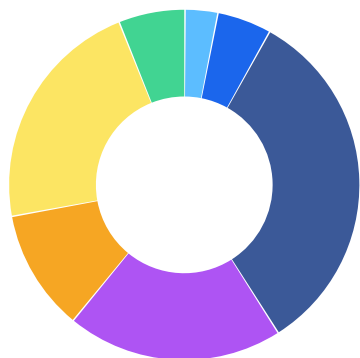

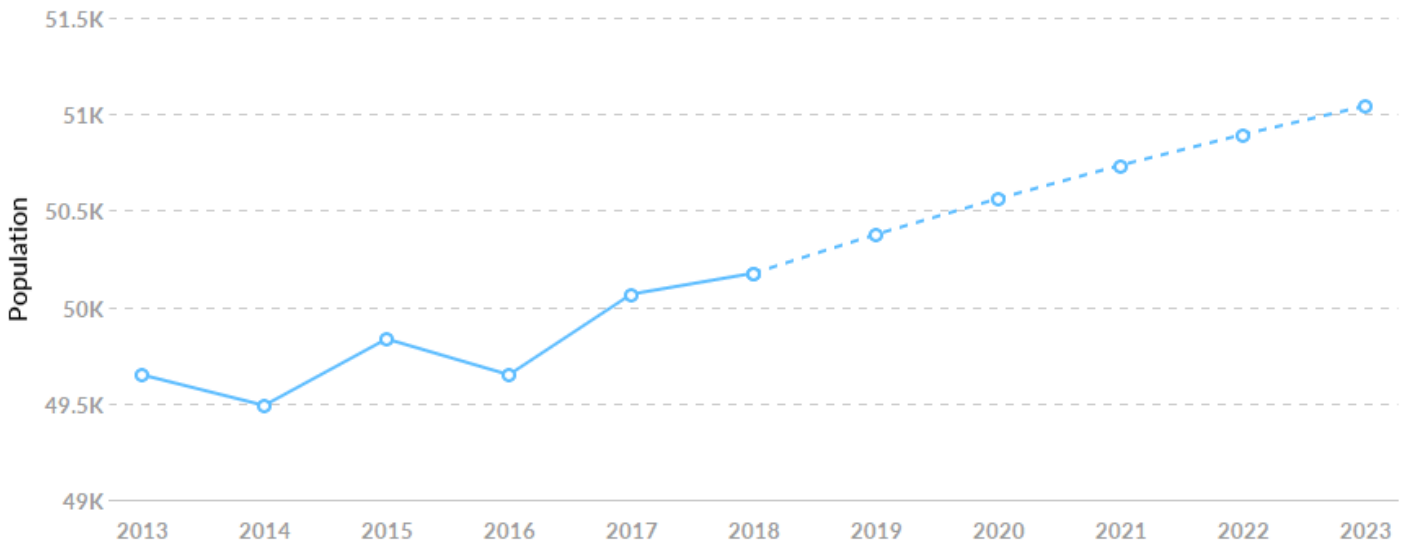

As of 2018 the region's population increased by 1.1% since 2013, growing by 527. Population is expected to increase by 1.7% between 2018 and 2023, adding 867.

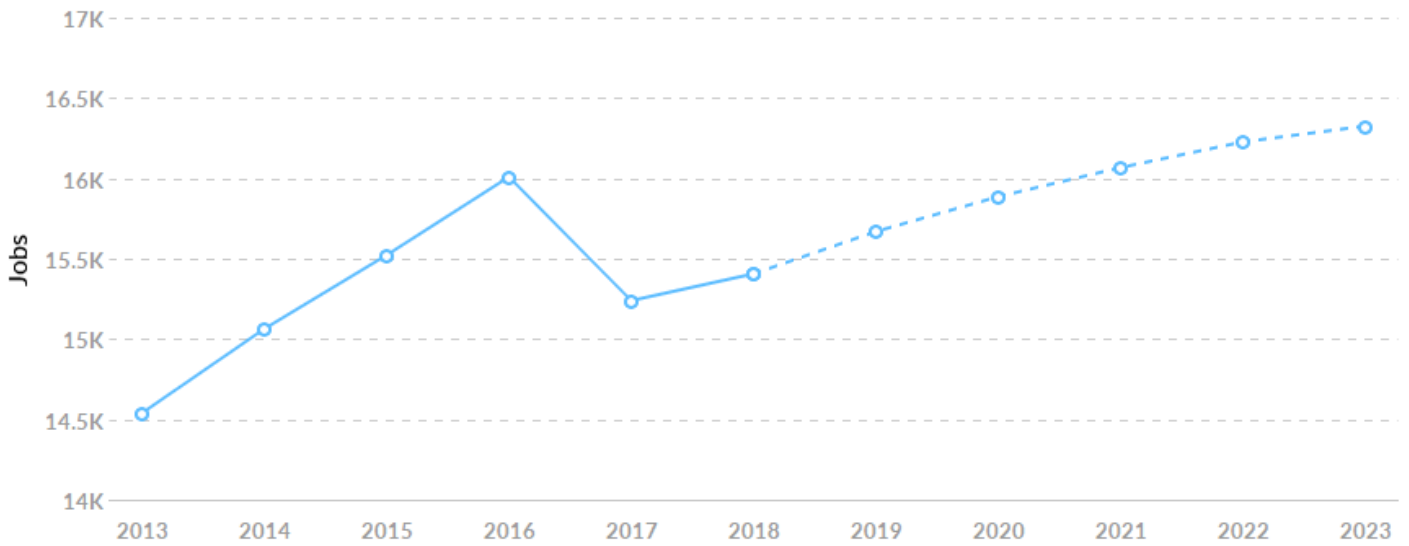

Job Trends

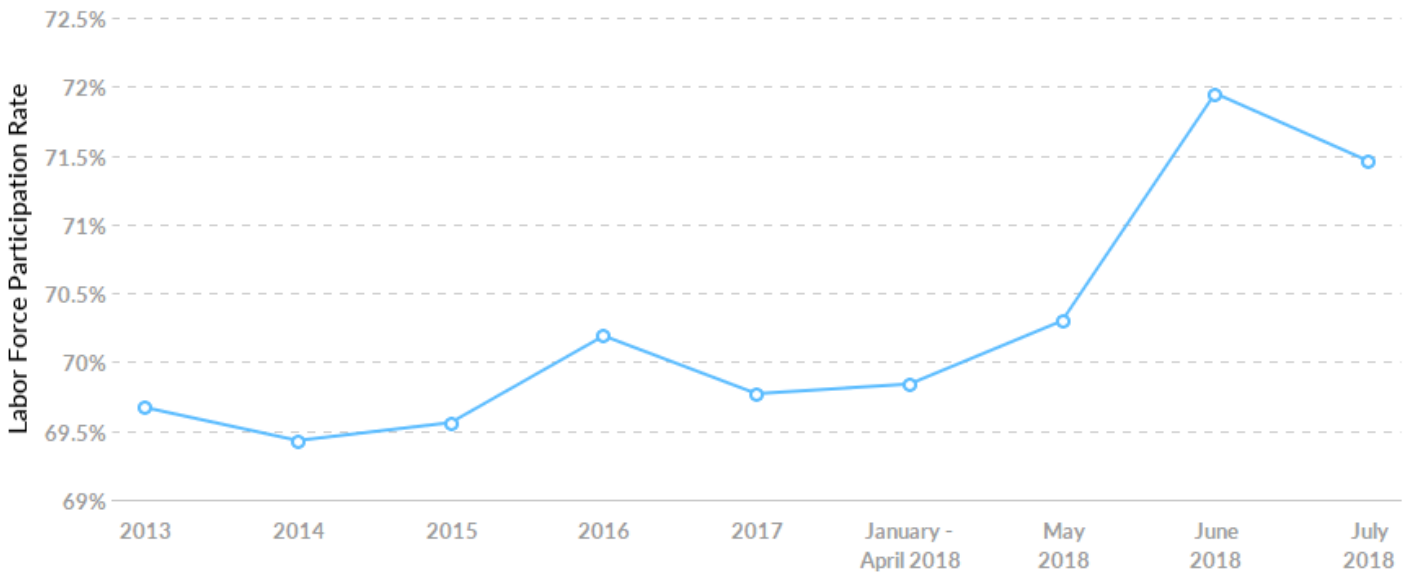

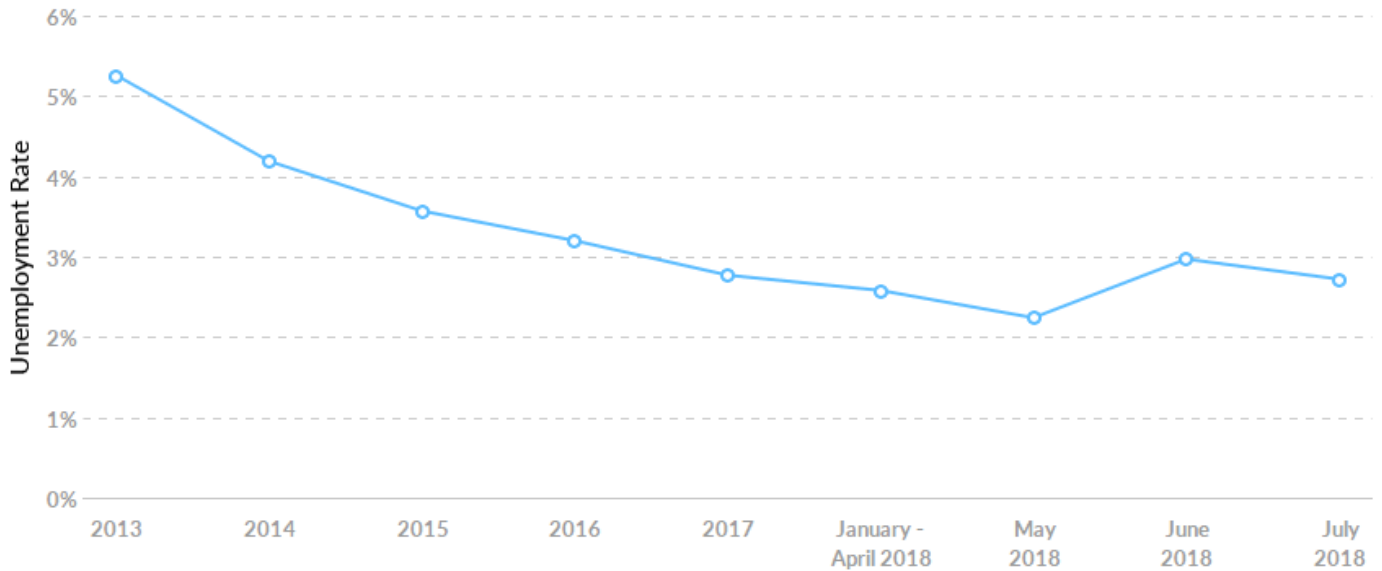

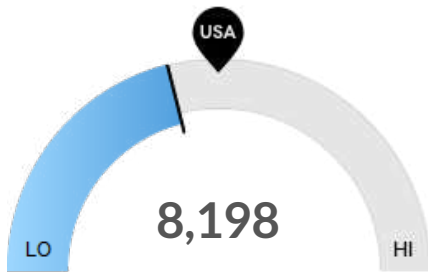
Unemployment Rate Trends

Calumet County, WI had a July 2018 unemployment rate of 2.72%, **decreasing from 5.26%** 5 years before.



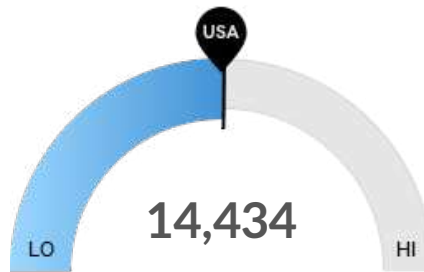

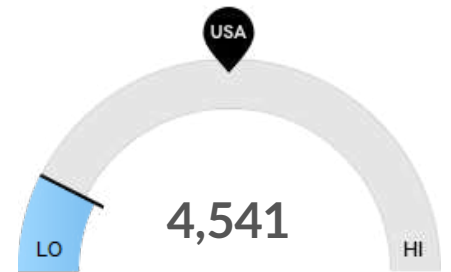
Millennials

Calumet County, WI has 8,198 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 10,370.



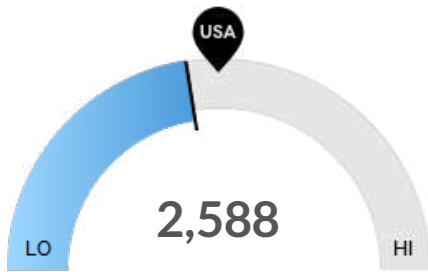
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Calumet County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 14,273 people 55 or older, while there are 14,434 here.



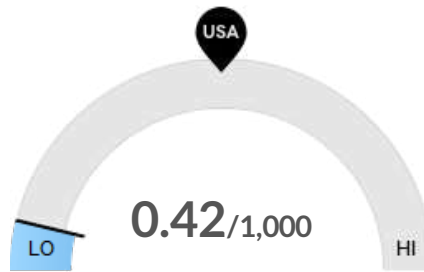
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Calumet County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 19,662 racially diverse people, while there are 4,541 here.



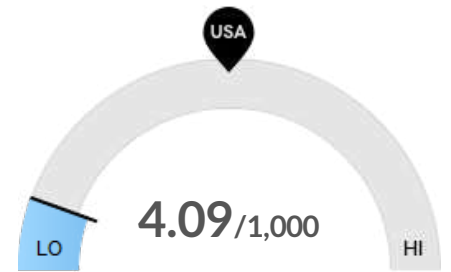
Veterans

Calumet County, WI has 0.42 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.



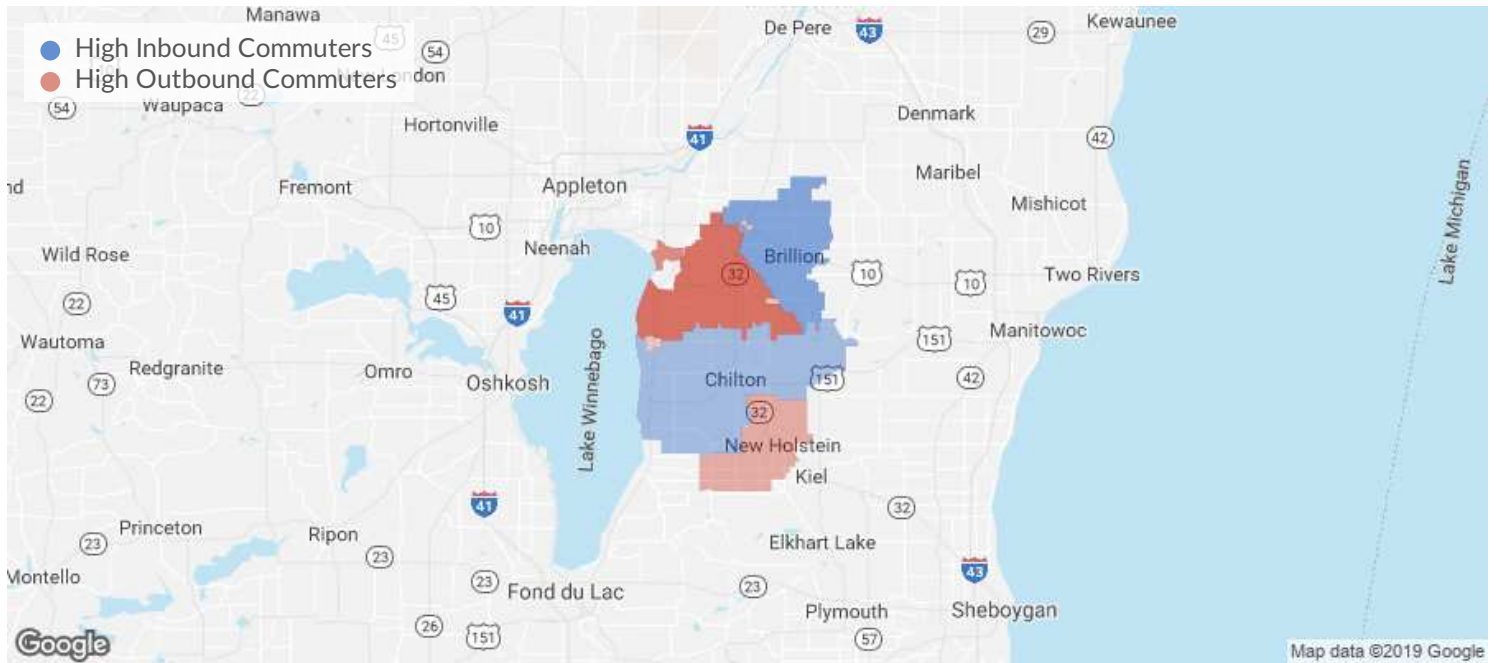
Property Crime

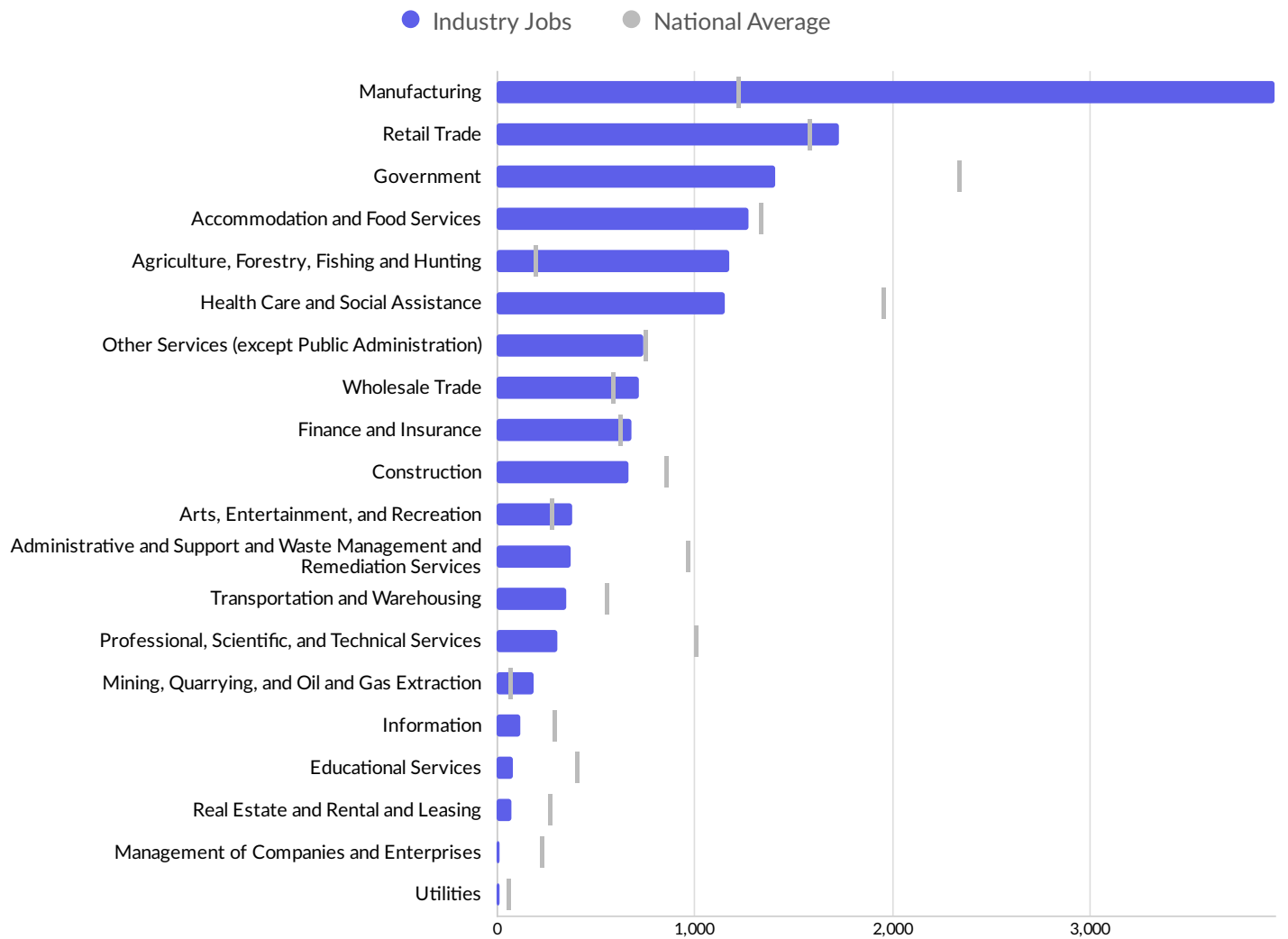

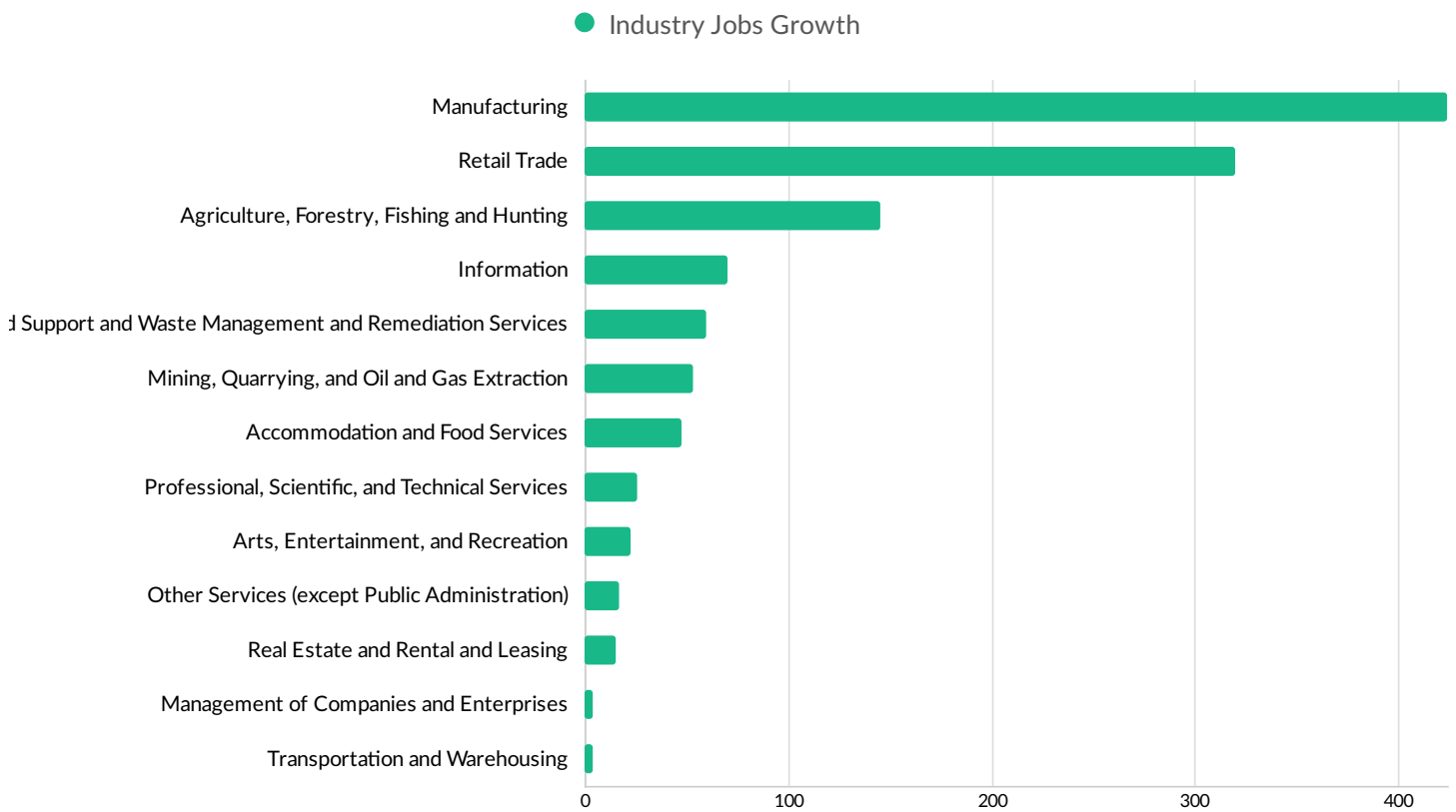

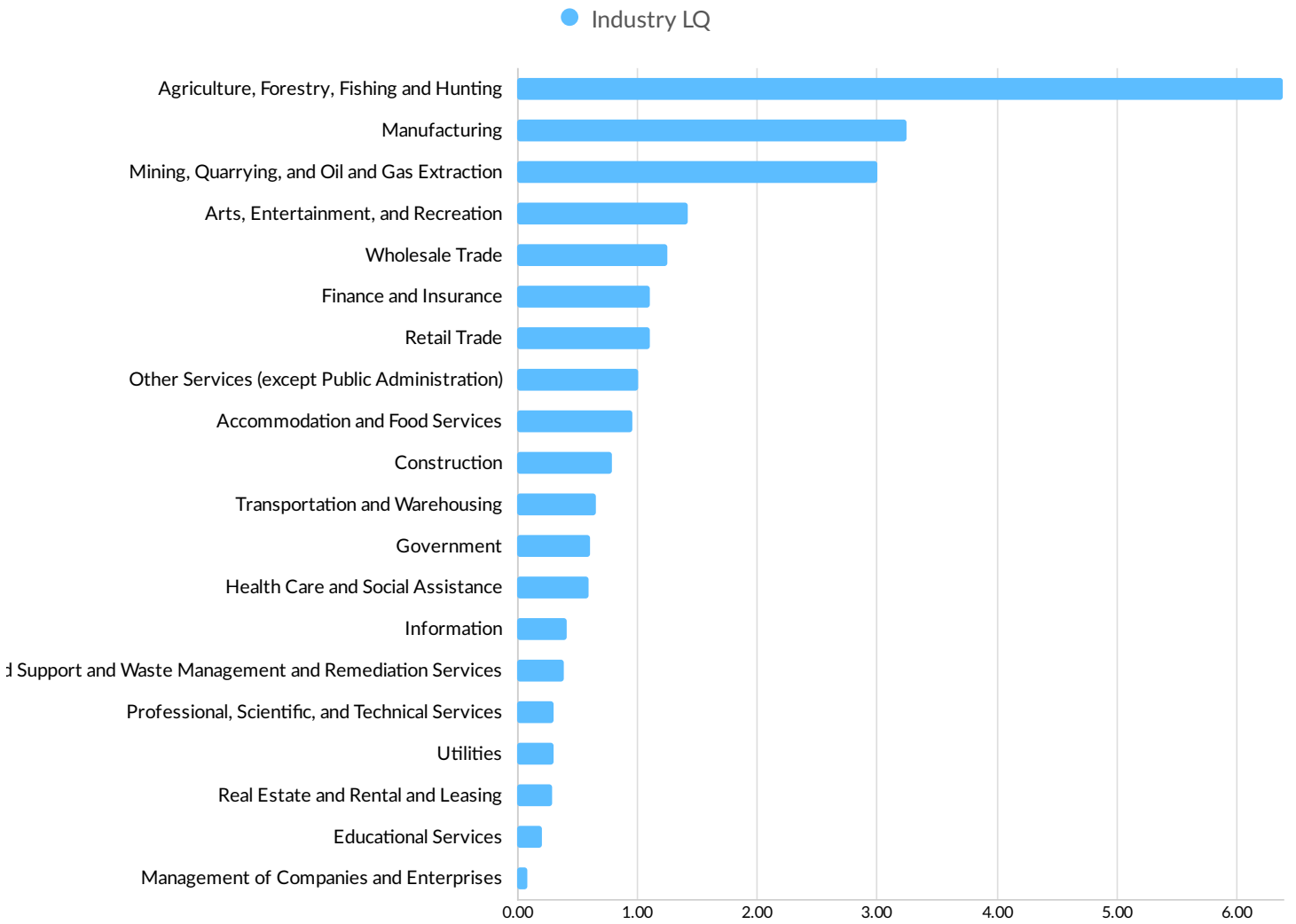

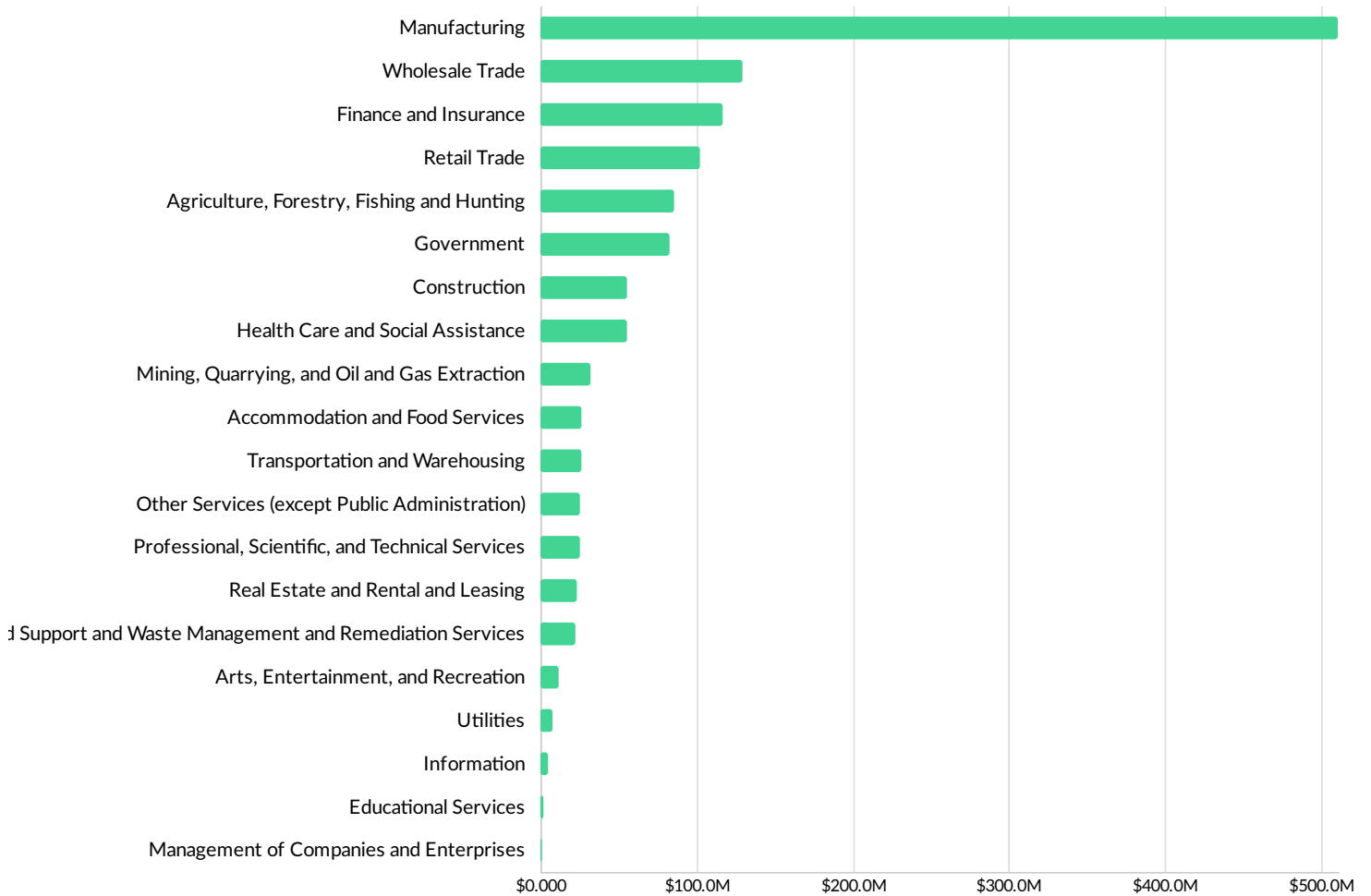
Top Industry LQ

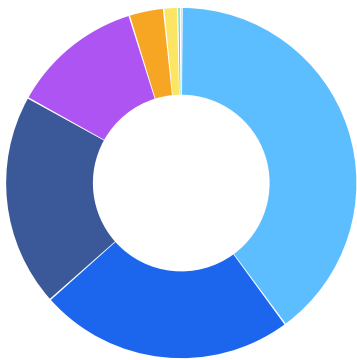

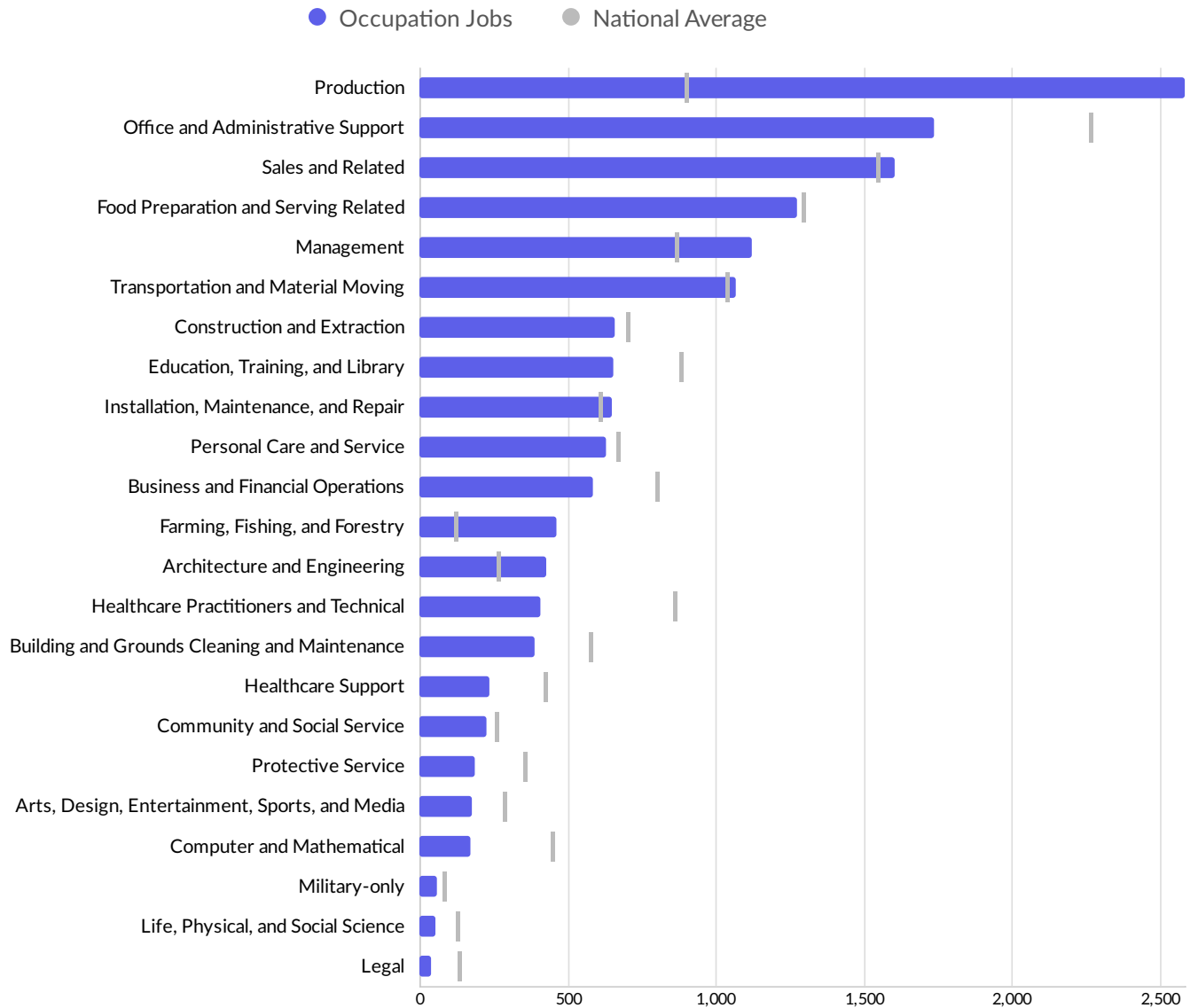

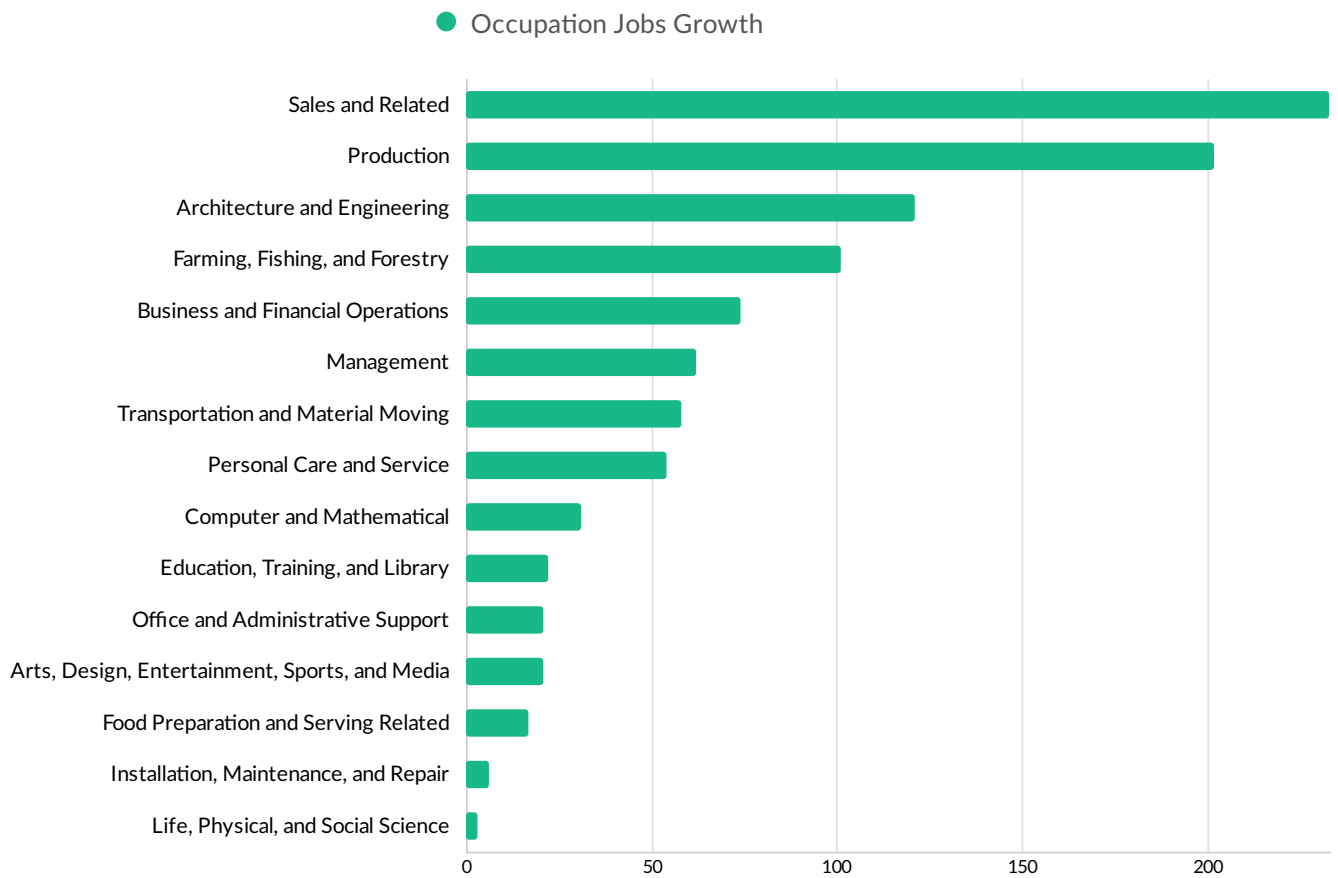

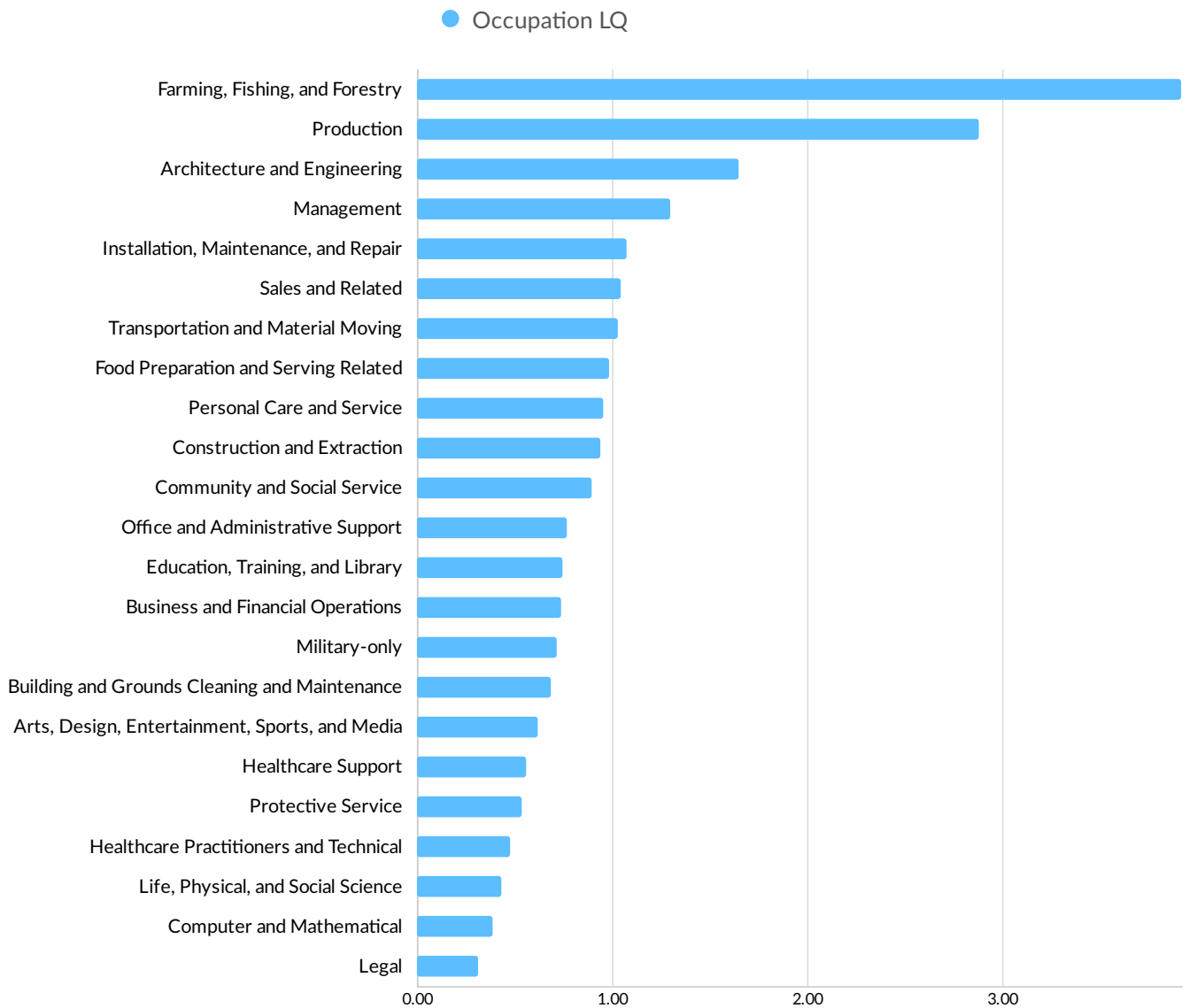

Top Growing Occupations



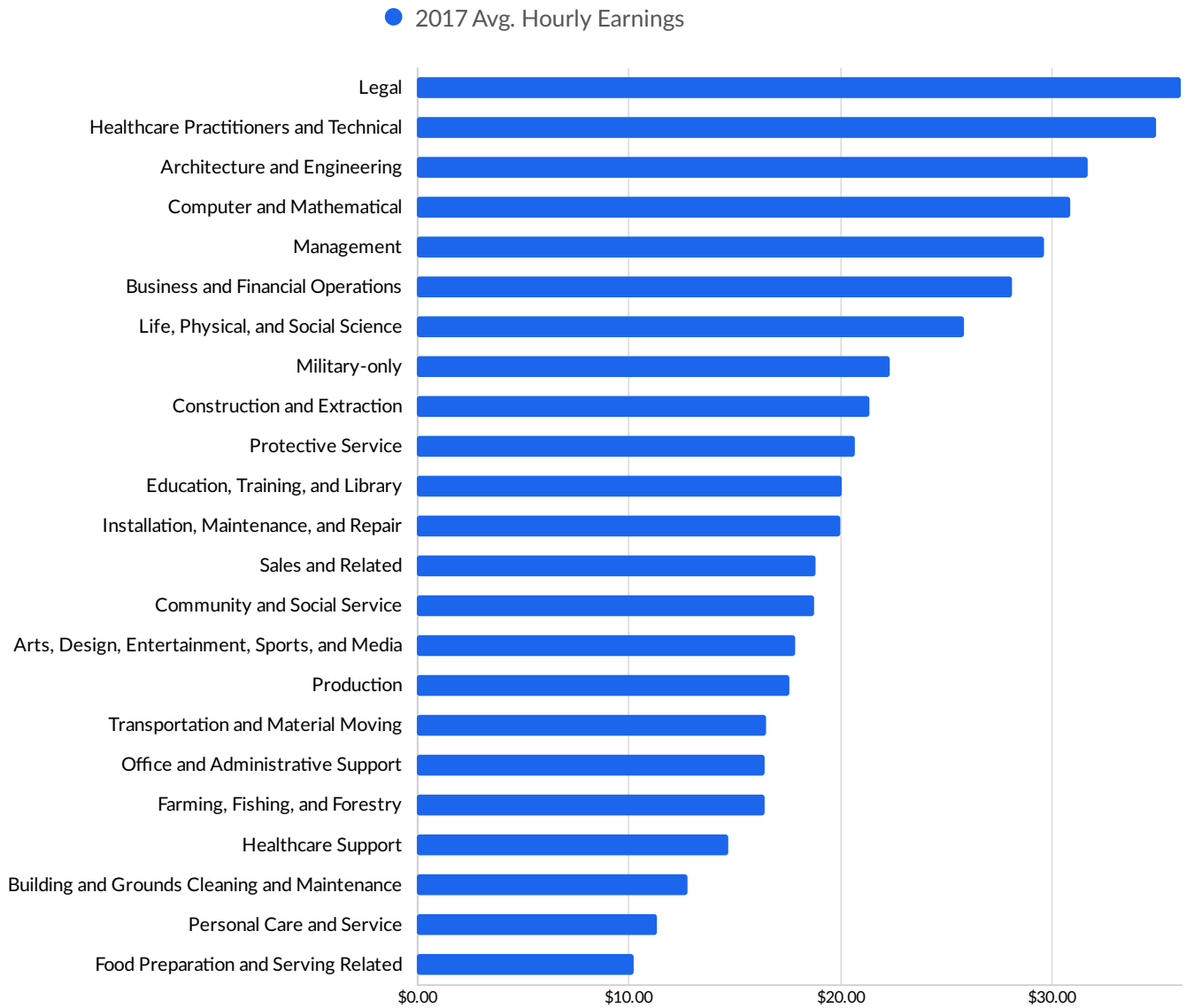

Top Occupation LQ



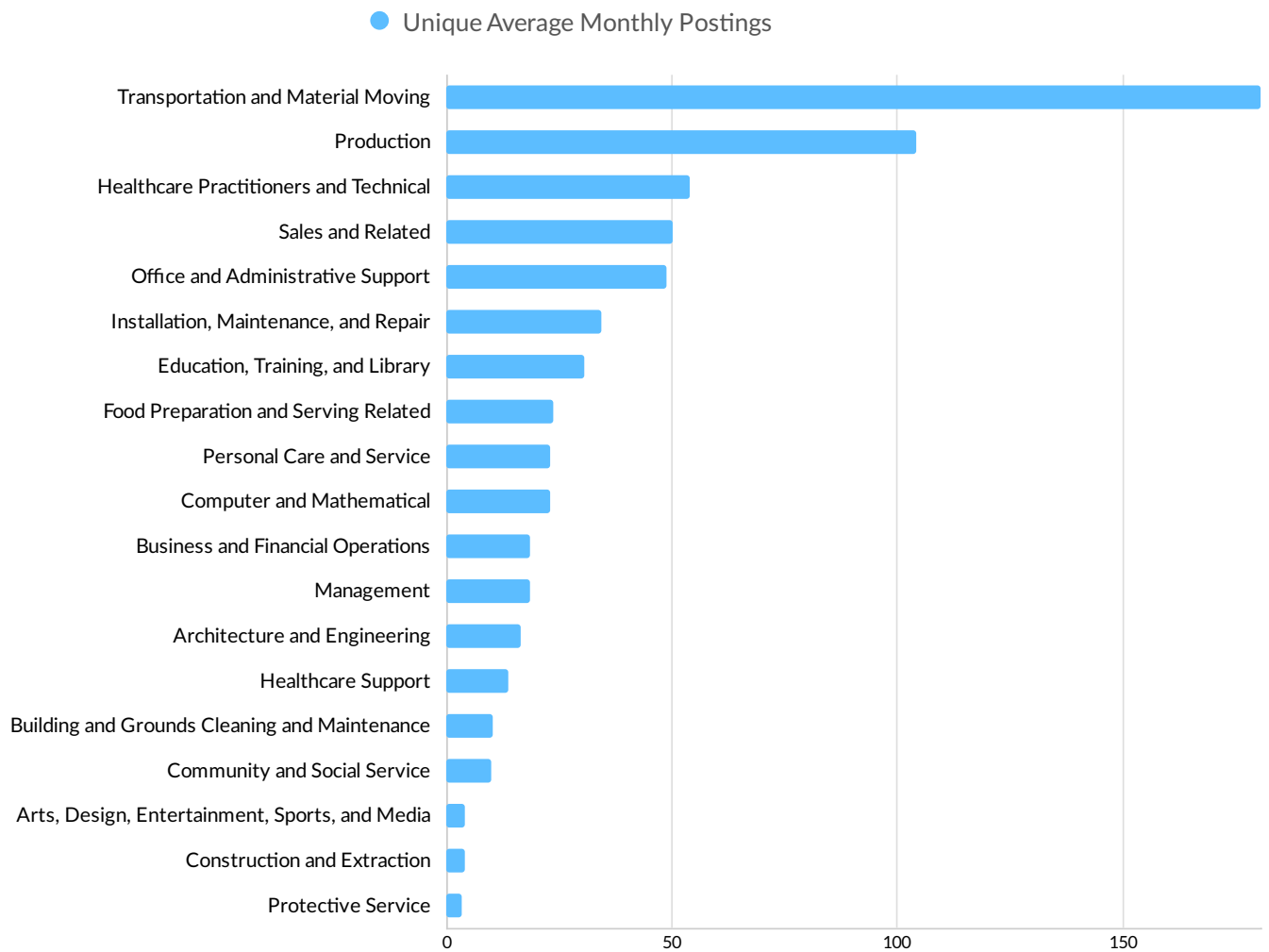
