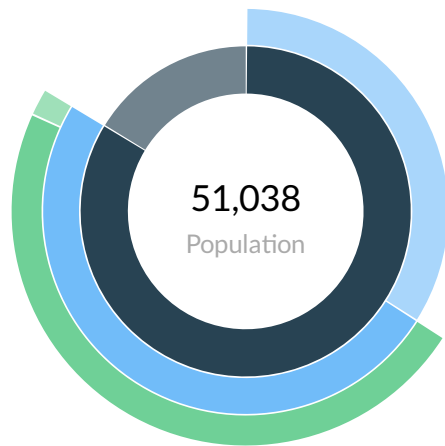
Median household income is **\$4.2K below** the national median household income of \$62.8K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 1.2%** since 2015, falling by 642. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.1%** between 2020 and 2025, losing 36.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 5.2%** in Waupaca County, WI from 22,355 to **21,188**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 6.5%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 63.0% to 59.4% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.8% of Waupaca County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.3% below the national average), and **12.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Foundries, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

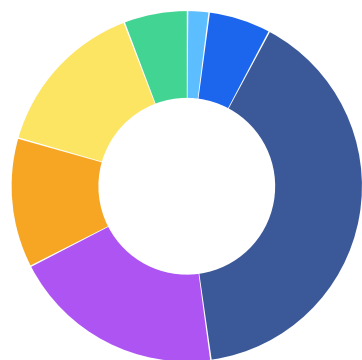

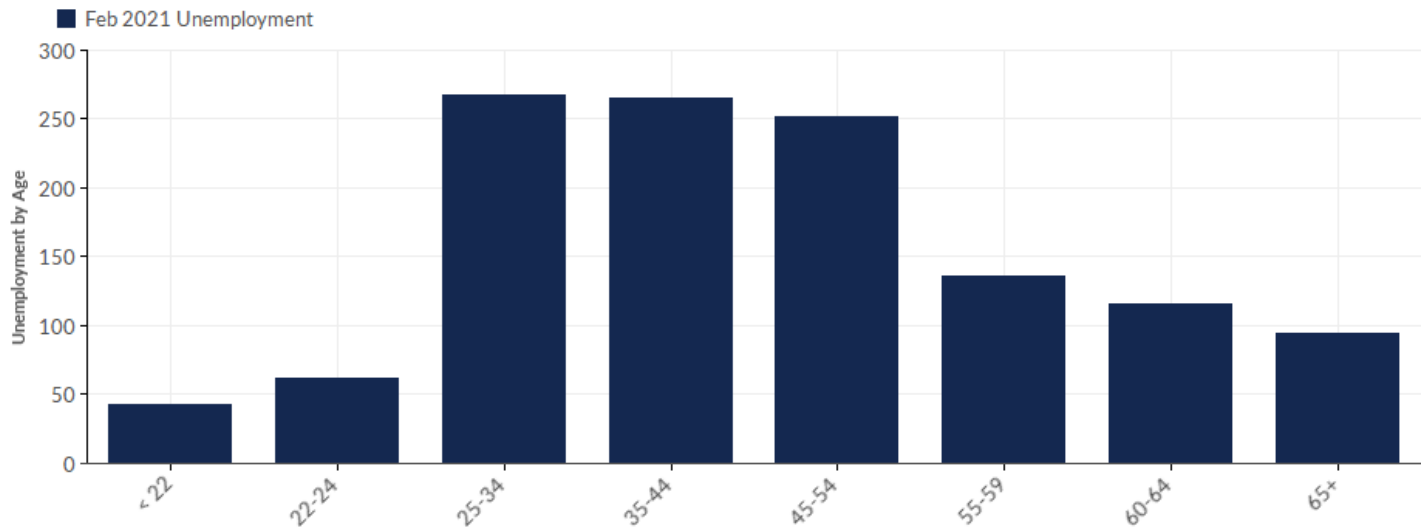

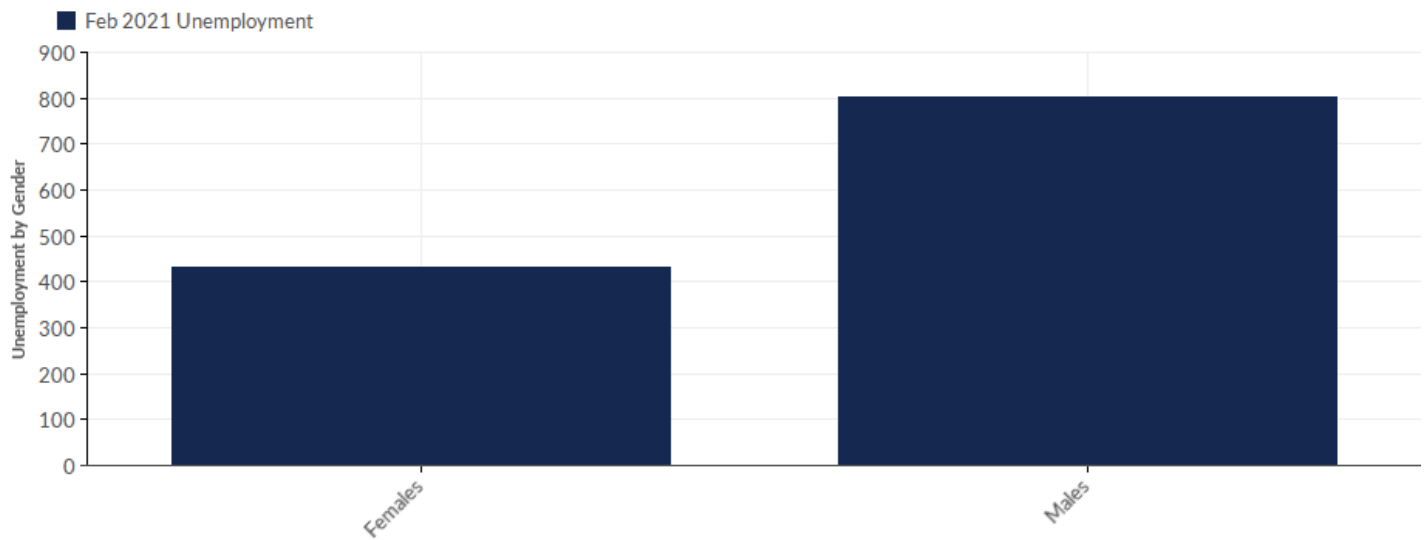

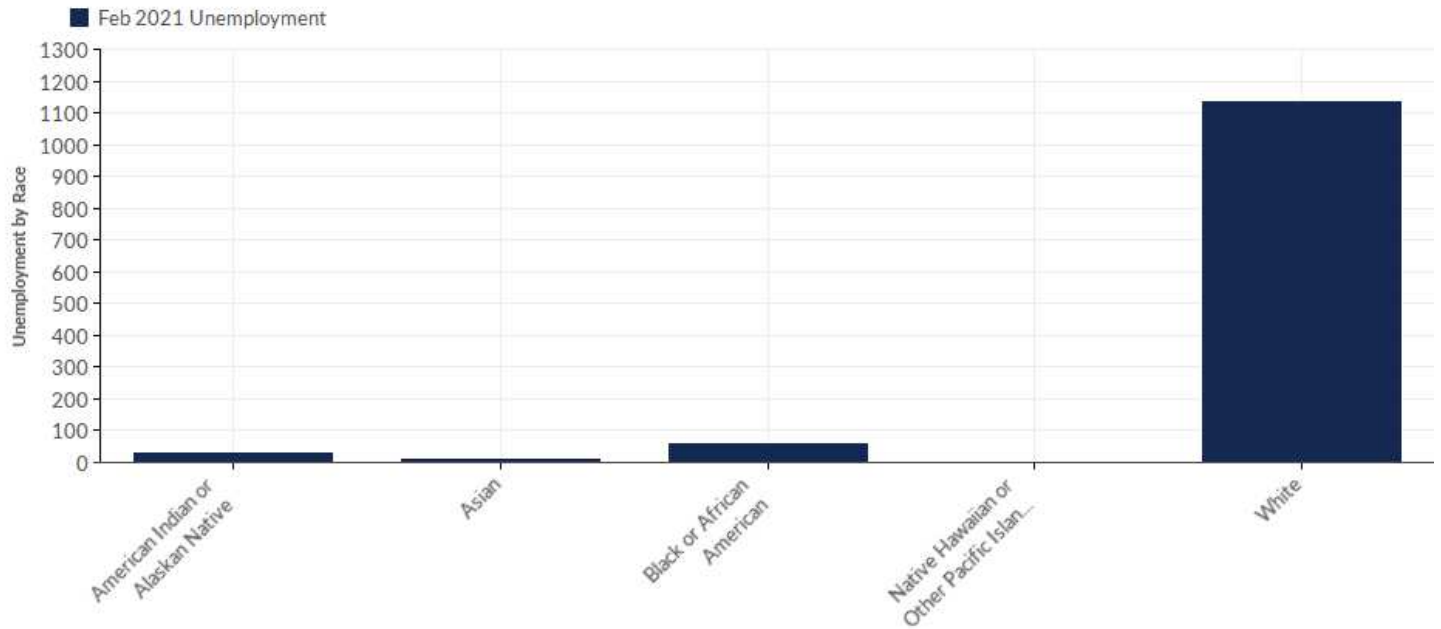

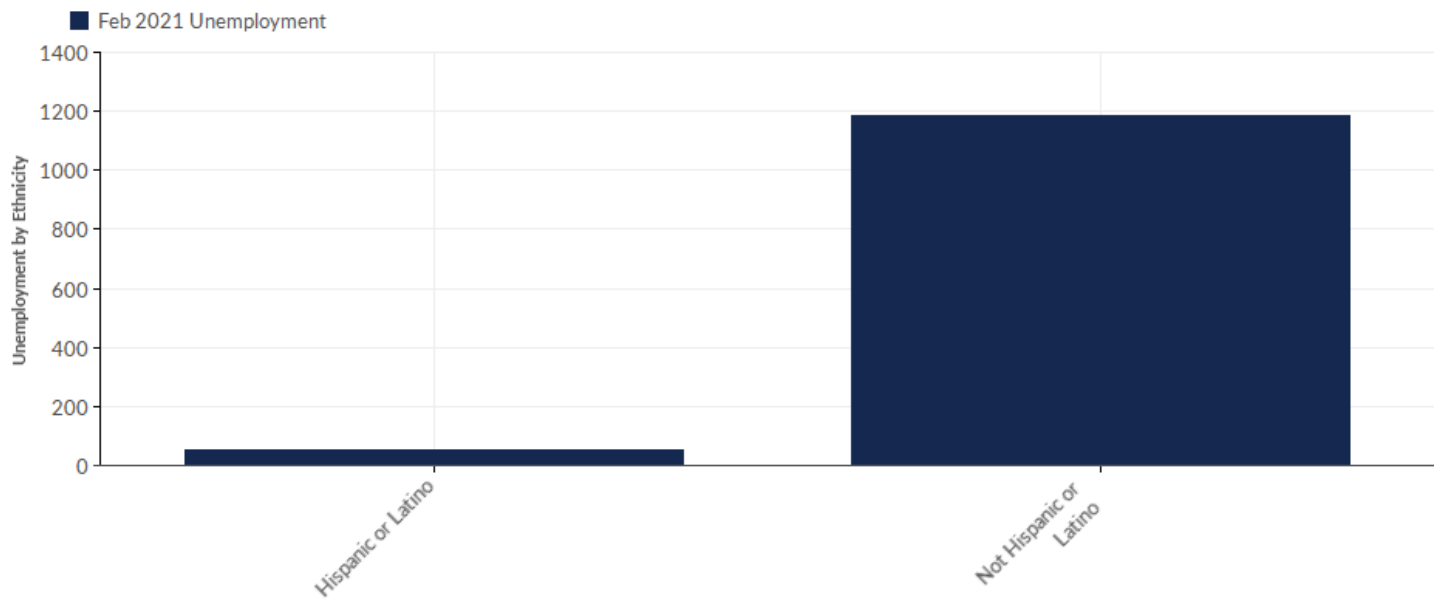

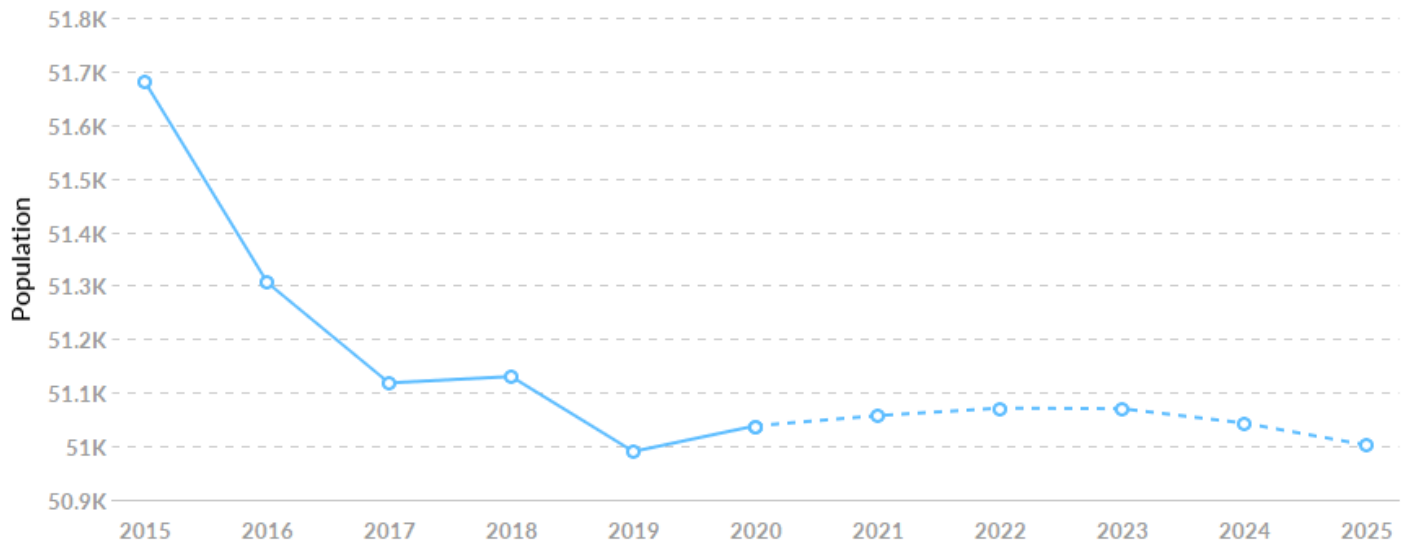

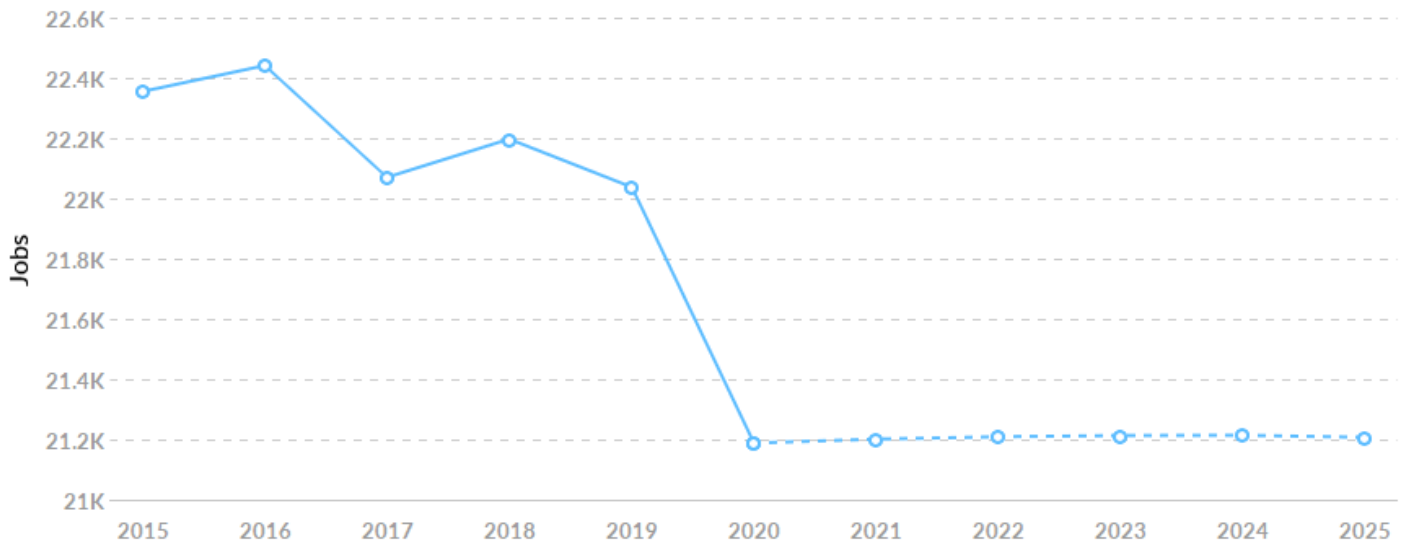

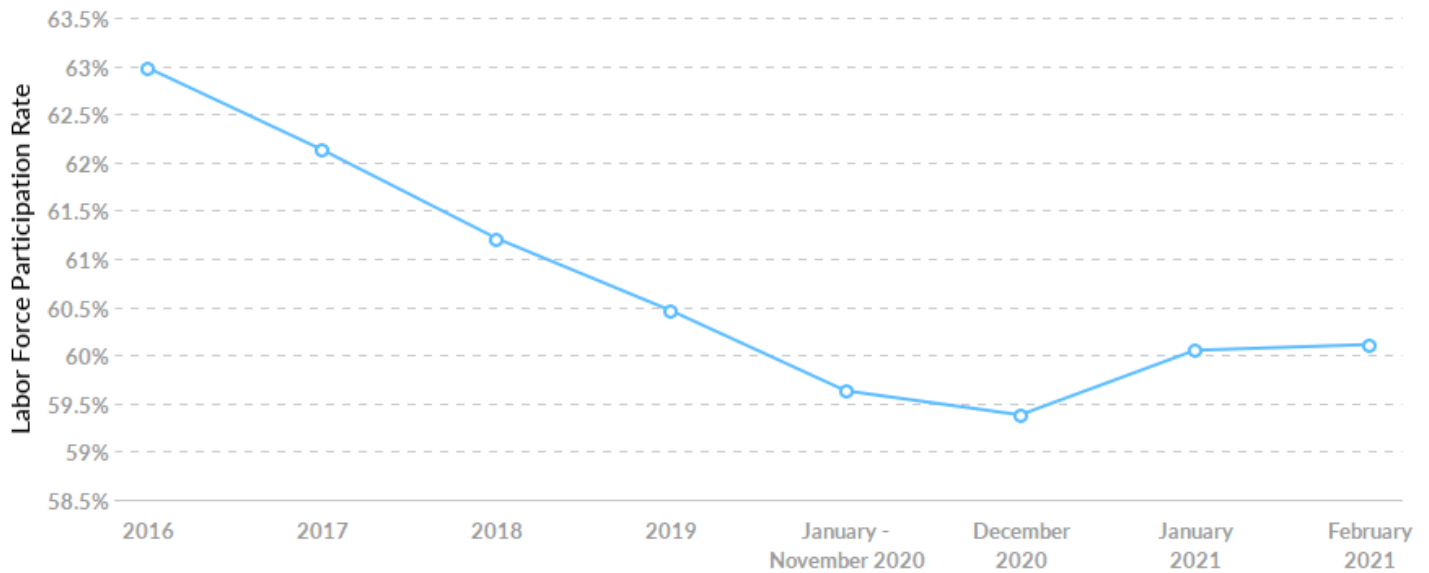
Job Trends

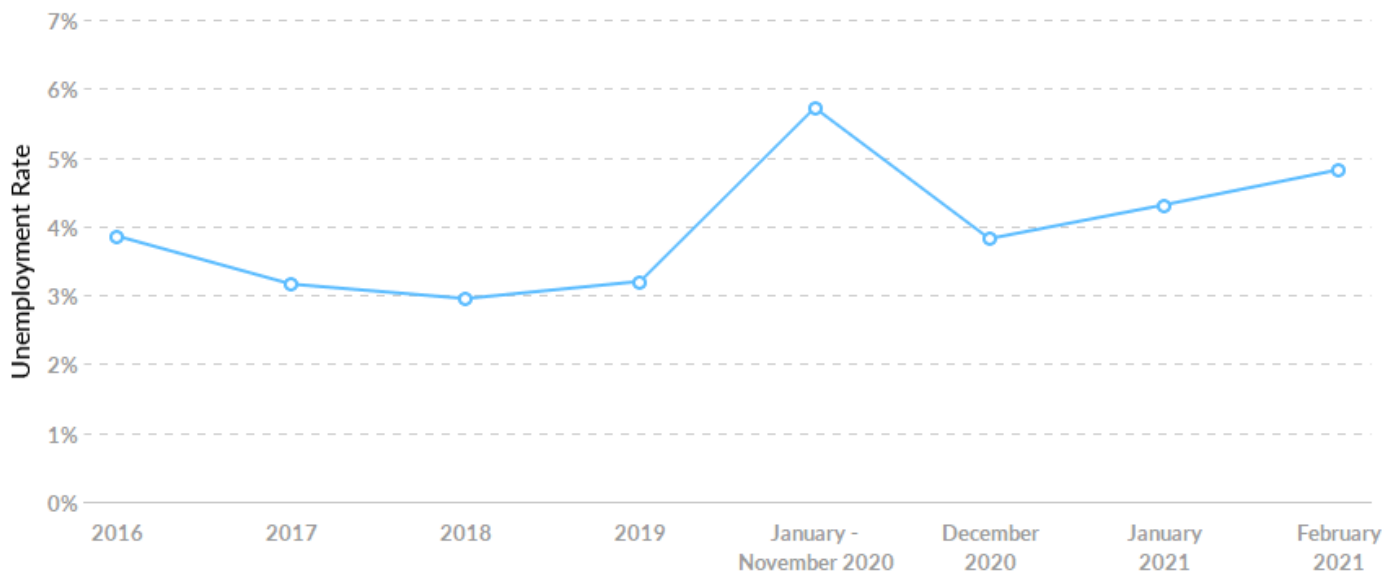

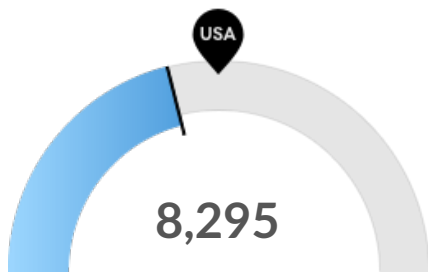
Unemployment Rate Trends

Waupaca County, WI had a February 2021 unemployment rate of 4.82%, **increasing from 3.86%** 5 years before.



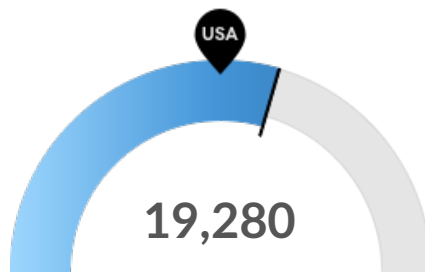

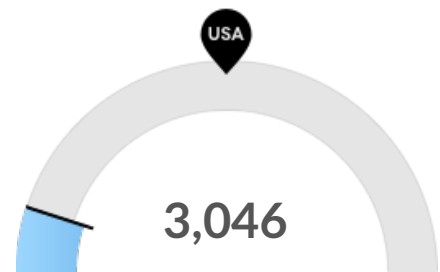
Millennials

Waupaca County, WI has 8,295 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,513.



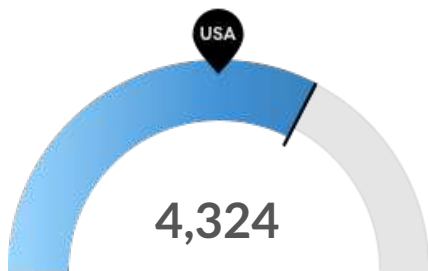
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Waupaca County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 14,992 people 55 or older, while there are 19,280 here.



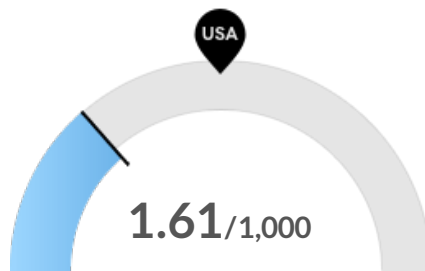
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Waupaca County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 20,339 racially diverse people, while there are 3,046 here.



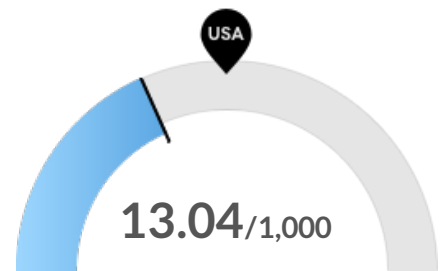
Veterans

Waupaca County, WI has 1.61 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

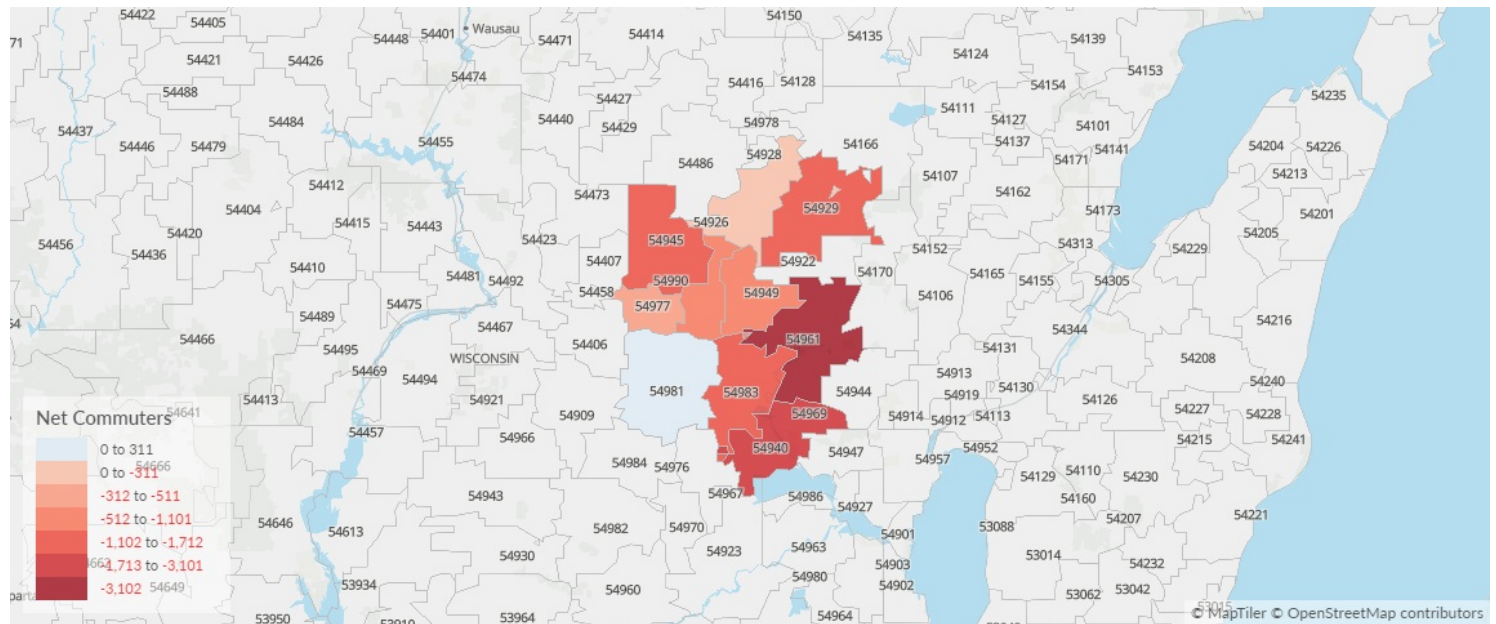


Property Crime

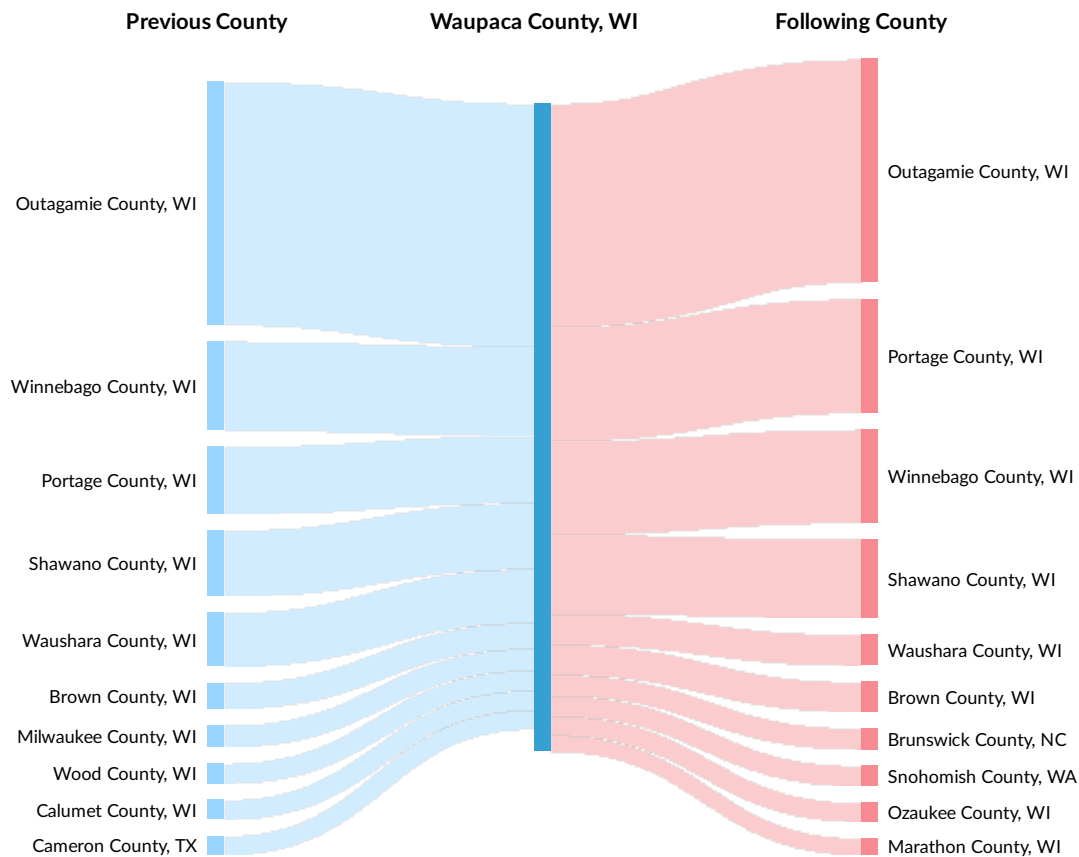

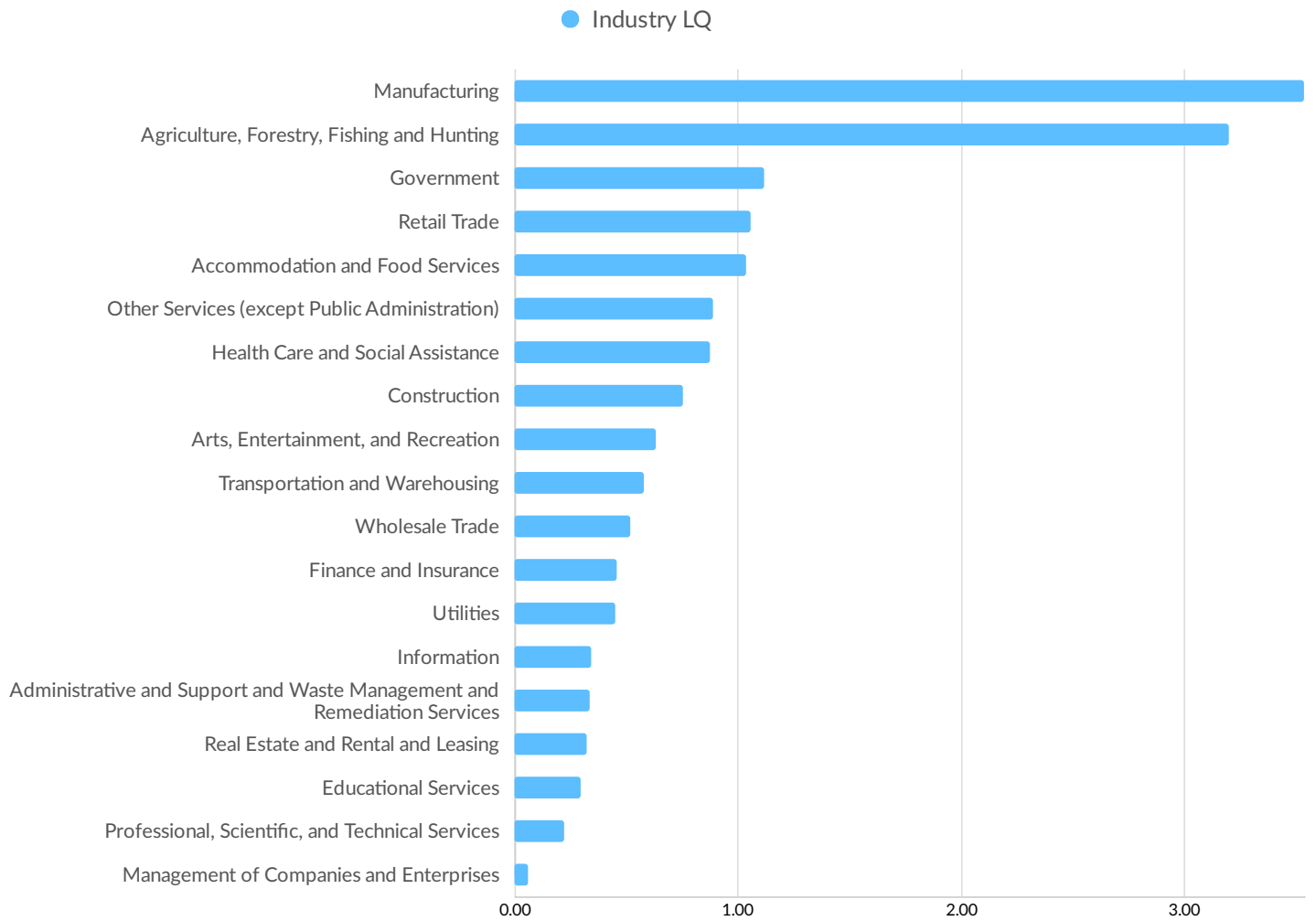

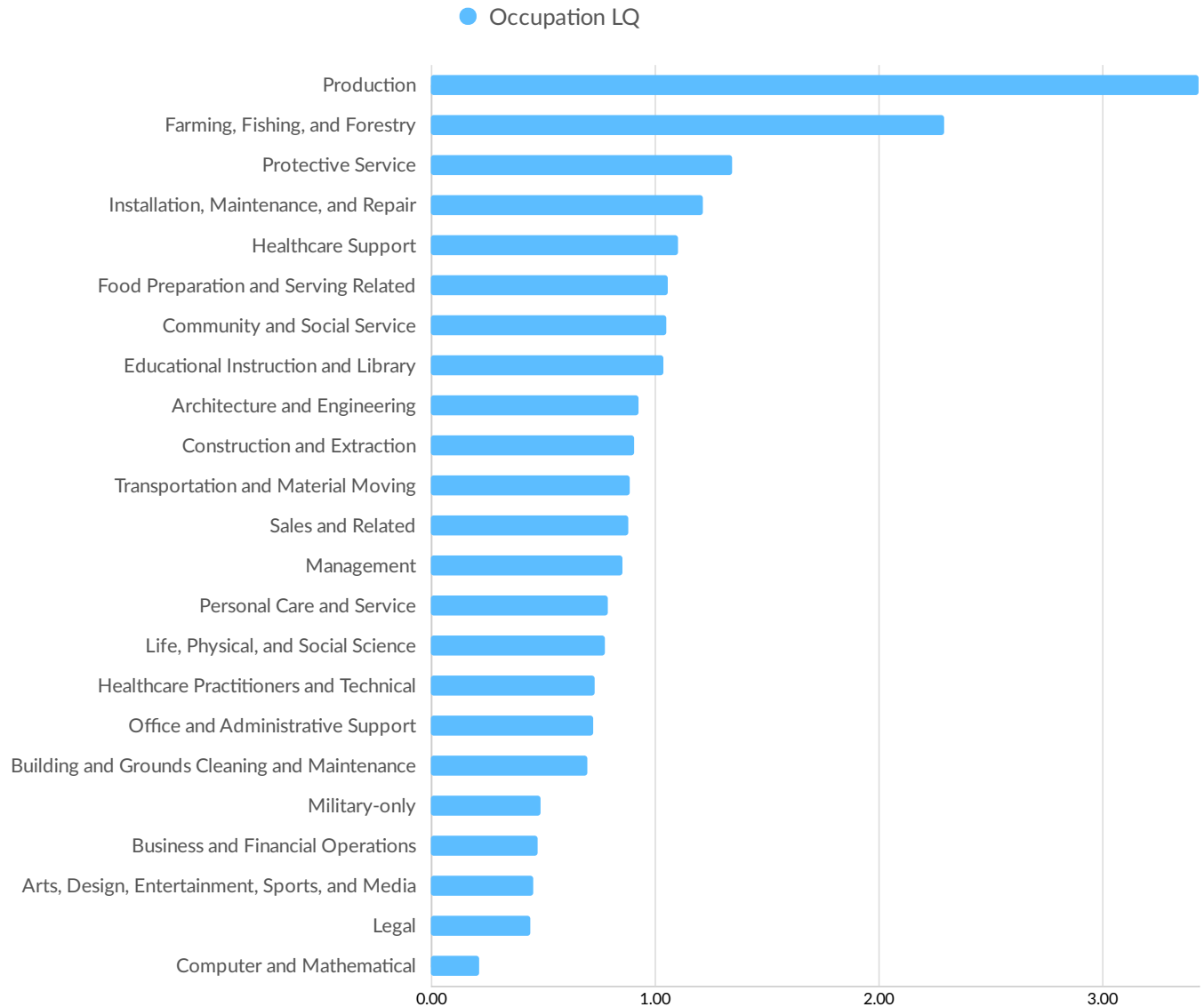

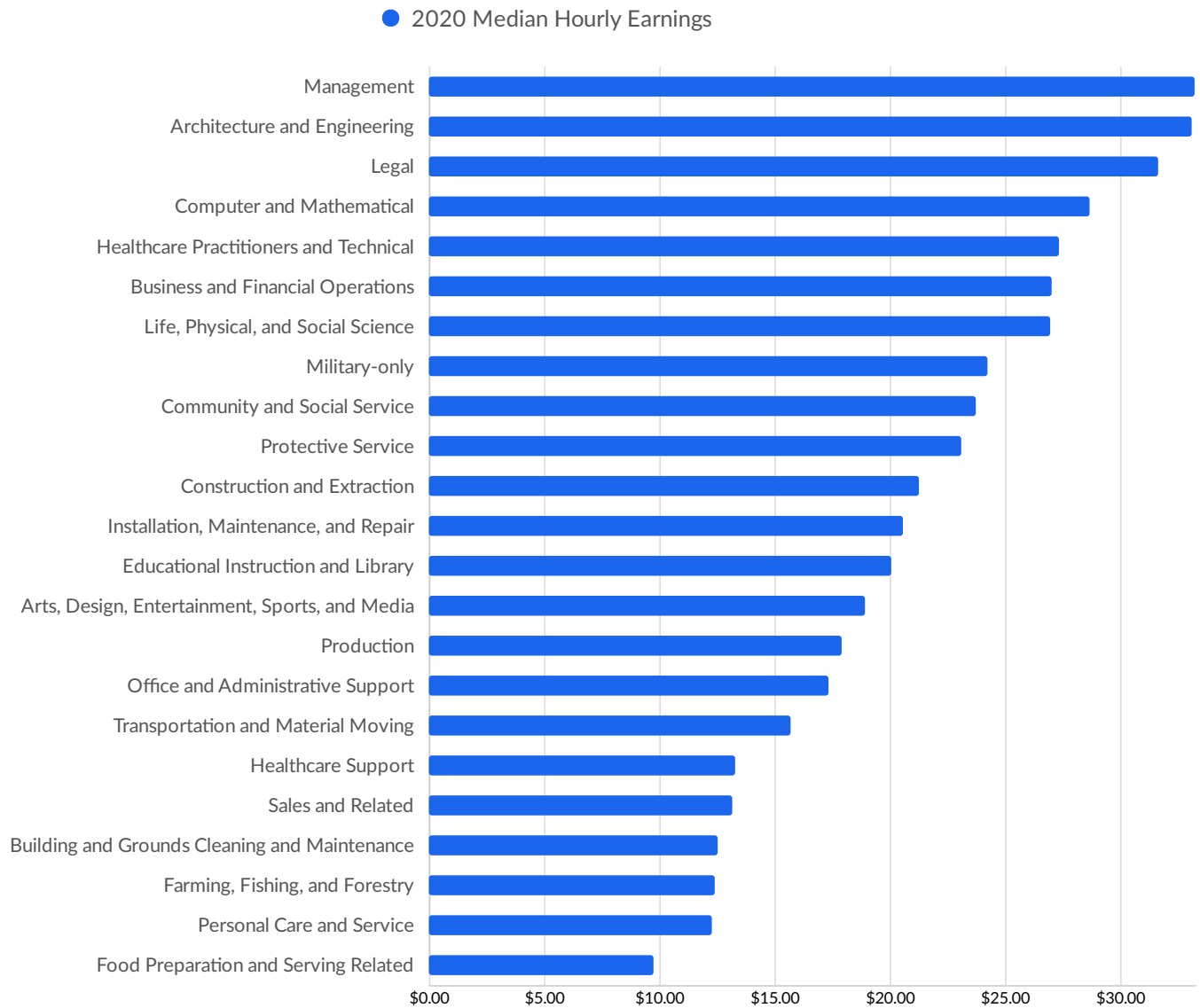

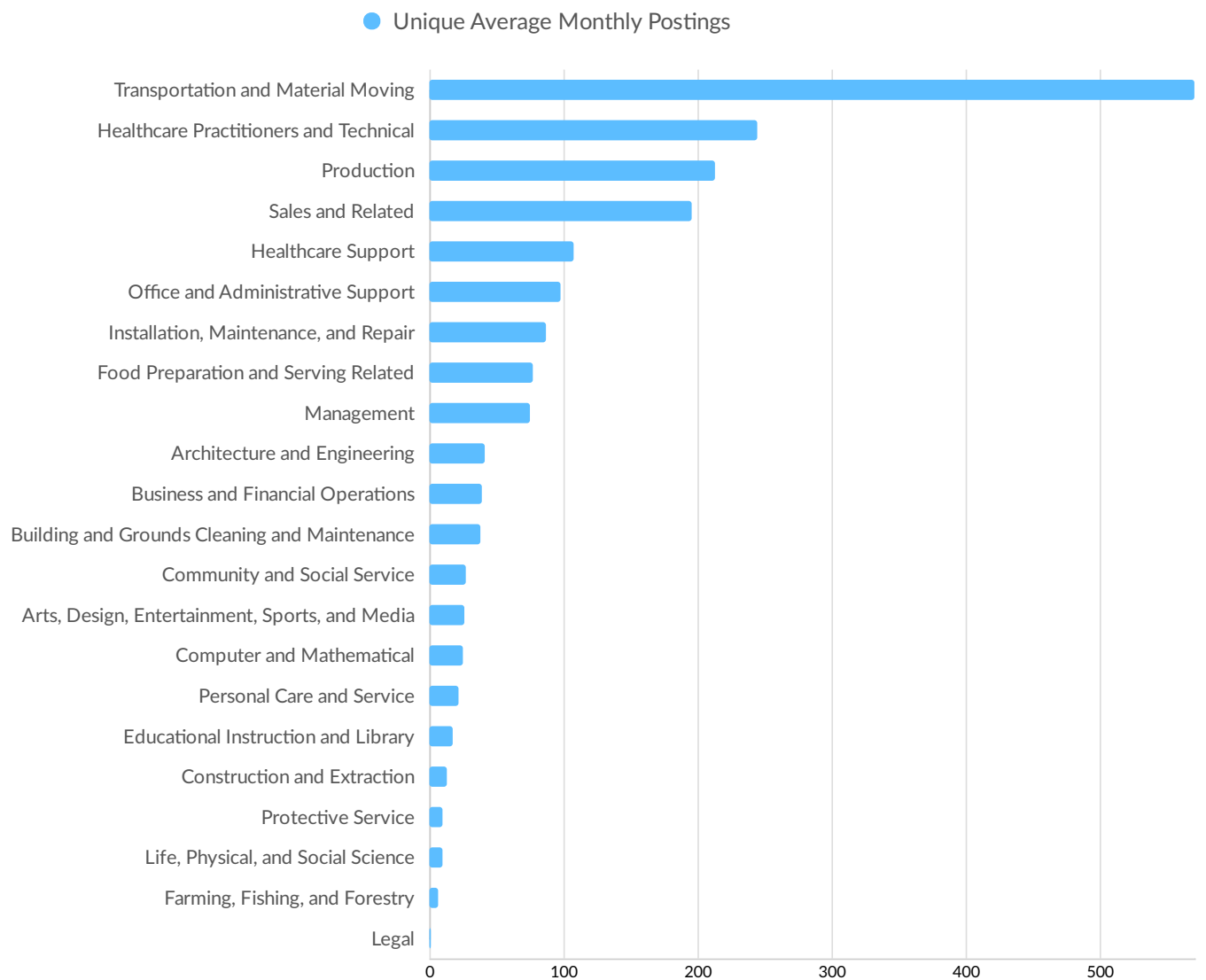

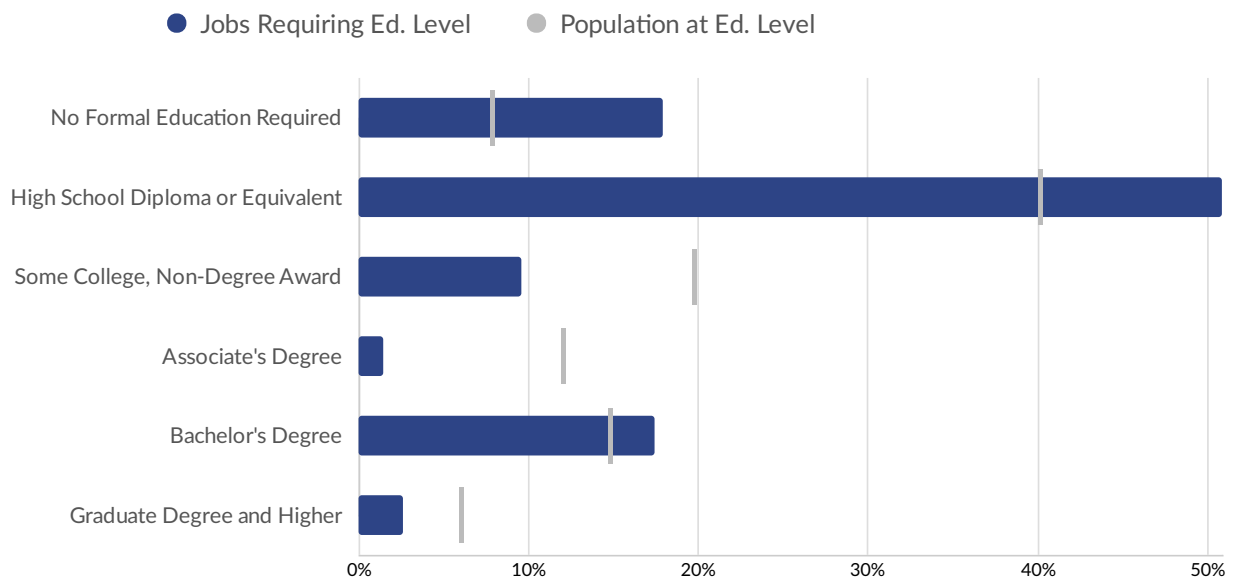

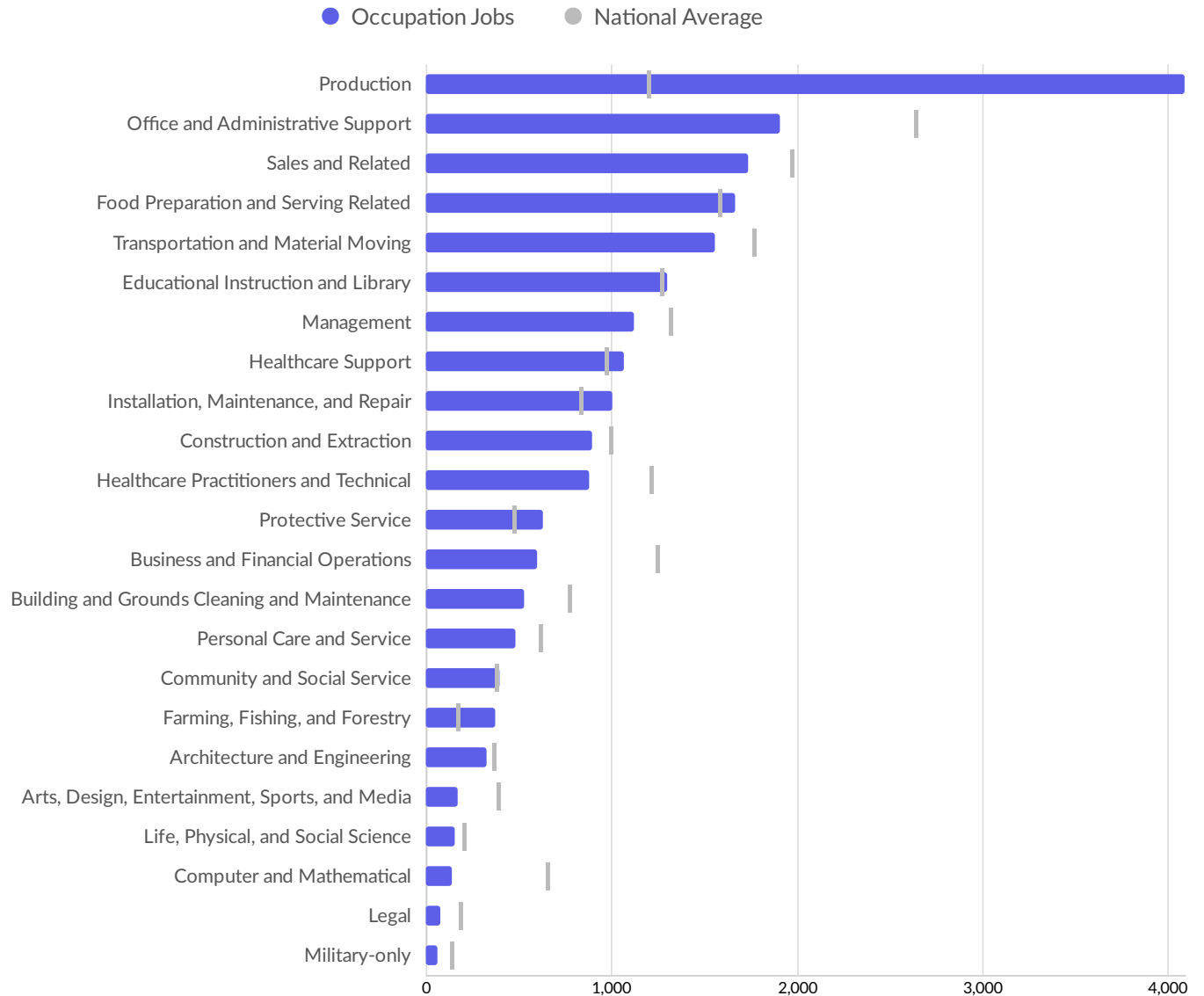
