- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 1.8% since 2015, growing by 338. Population is expected to increase by 2.2% between 2020 and 2025, adding 425.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 9.8% in Green Lake County, WI from 7,444 to 6,718. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 11.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.3% to 58.2% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.3% of Green Lake County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.7% below the national average), and **11.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 1.8% since 2015, growing by 338. Population is expected to increase by 2.2% between 2020 and 2025, adding 425.








Unemployment Rate Trends

Green Lake County, WI had a February 2021 unemployment rate of 6.05%, increasing from 4.77% 5 years before.








Veterans

Green Lake County, WI has 1,228 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,050.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Green Lake County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,561 people 55 or older, while there are 7,365 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Green Lake County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,544 racially diverse people, while there are 1,564 here.




Property Crime








2020 Median Hourly Earnings






