

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 4.1% since 2015, growing by 624. Population is expected to increase by 3.7% between 2020 and 2025, adding 586.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 4.3% in Marquette County, WI from 4,673 to 4,873. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 1.3% by 3.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.4% to 58.2% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.8% of Marquette County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.3% below the national average), and **11.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Other General Purpose Machinery Manufacturing, and Crop Production.









## **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 4.1% since 2015, growing by 624. Population is expected to increase by 3.7% between 2020 and 2025, adding 586.







Marquette County, WI had a February 2021 unemployment rate of 6.78%, increasing from 4.96% 5 years before.






#### Millennials

Marquette County, WI has 2,198 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,211.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Marquette County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 4,579 people 55 or older, while there are 6,765 here.




#### **Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Marquette County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,212 racially diverse people, while there are 1,080 here.




#### **Veterans**

Marquette County, WI has 0.71 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**








#### 2020 Median Hourly Earnings






