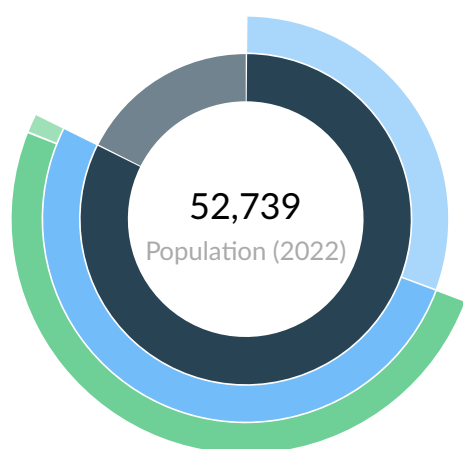

## Takeaways

- From 2016 to 2021, jobs **increased by 12.4%** in Calumet County, WI from 15,222 to **17,103**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 1.9% by 10.5%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 70.6% to 66.0% between 2016 and 2021**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **22.7% of Calumet County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.3% above the national average), and **15.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (6.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Agriculture, Construction, and Mining Machinery Manufacturing, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Animal Production.

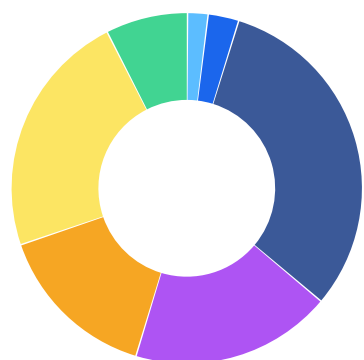

## Educational Attainment

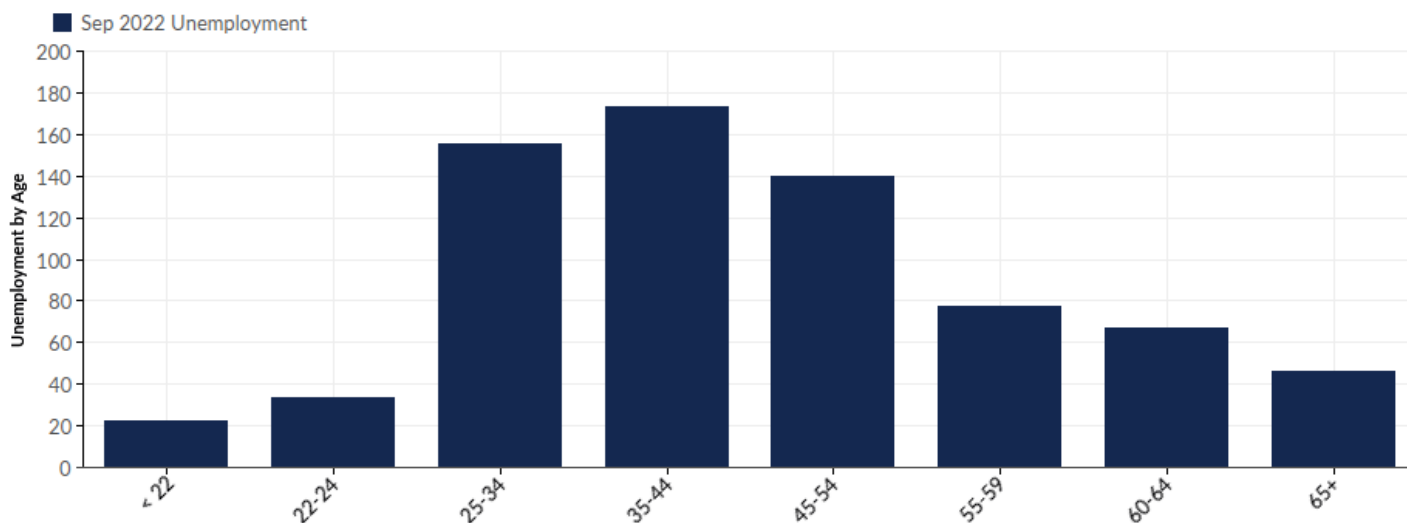

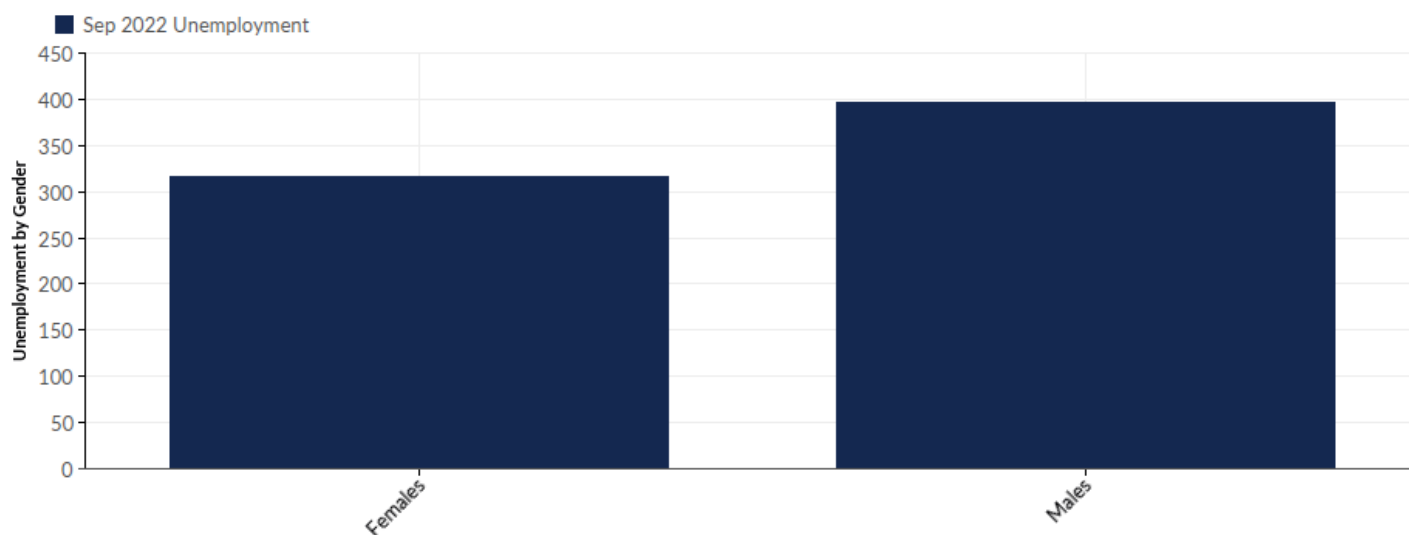

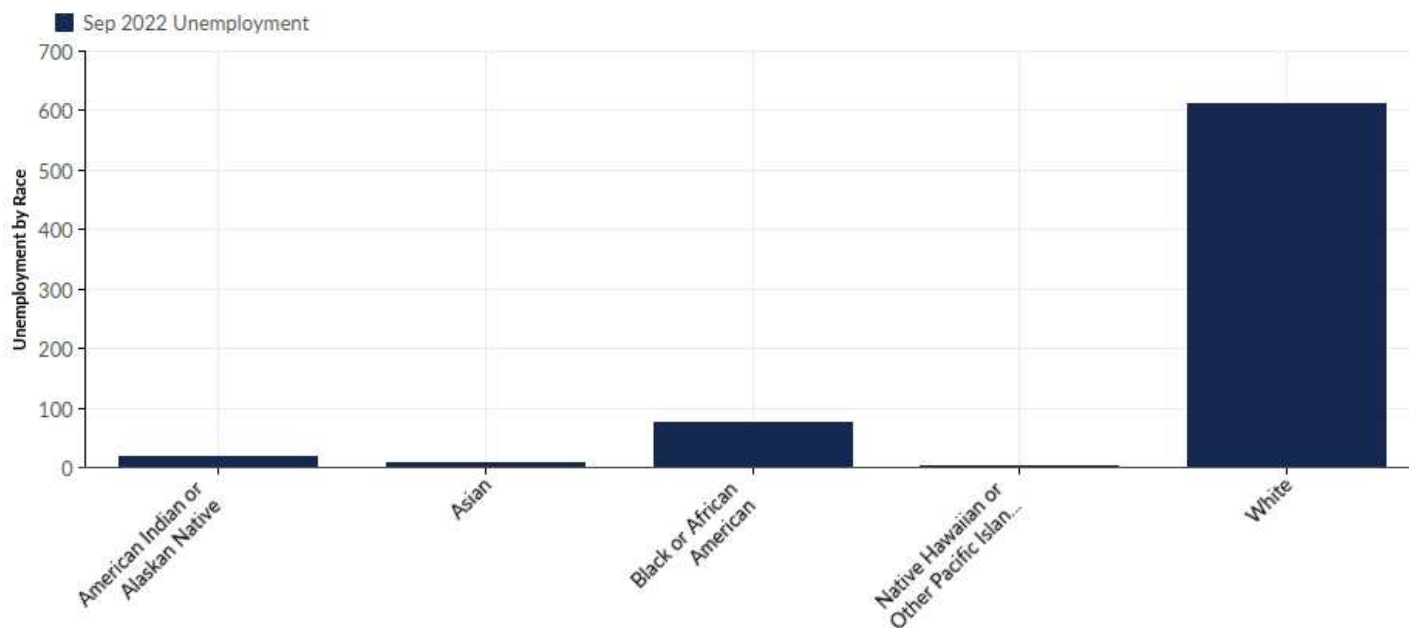

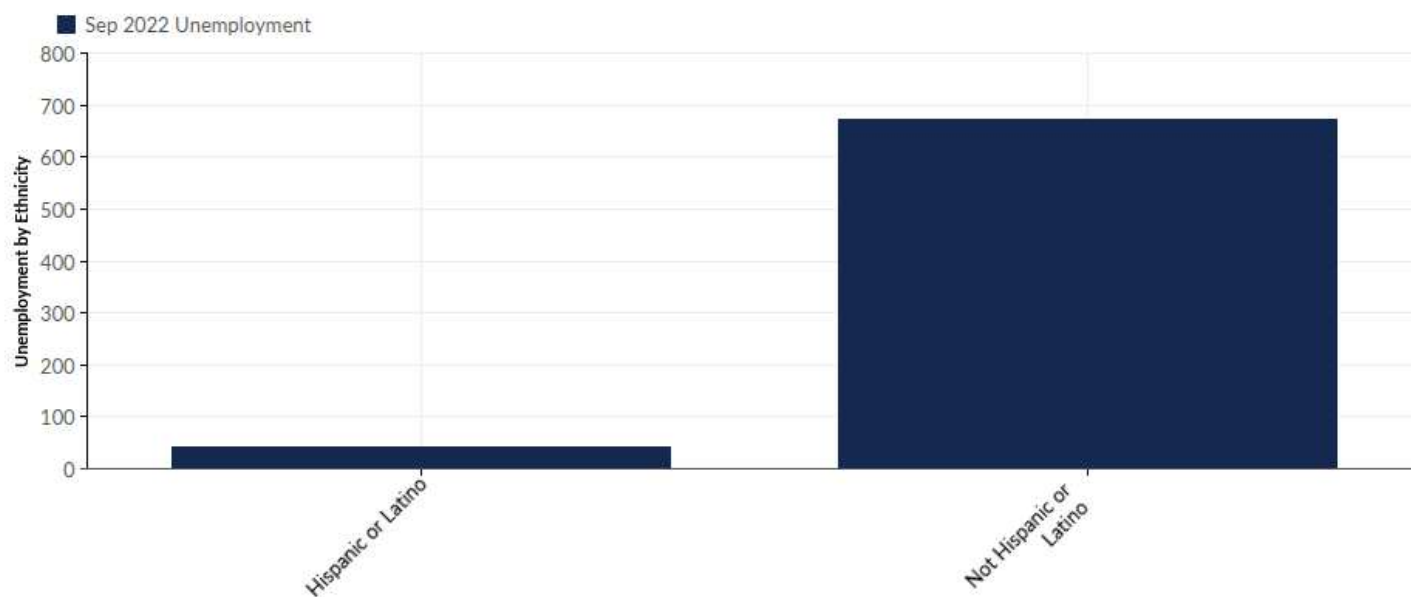

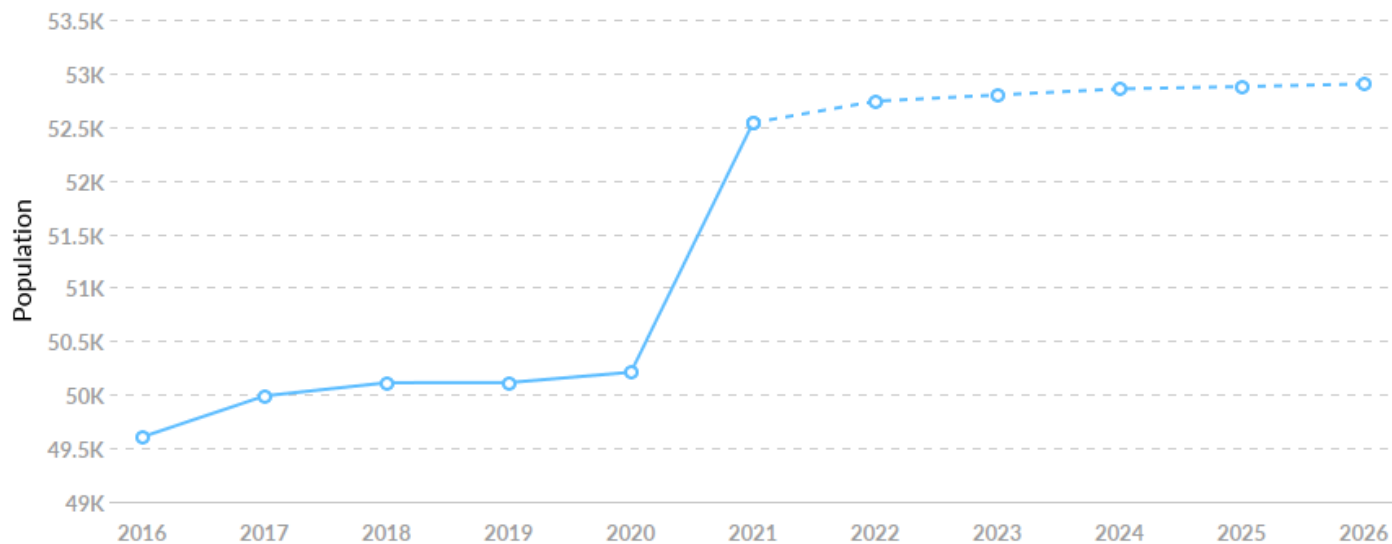

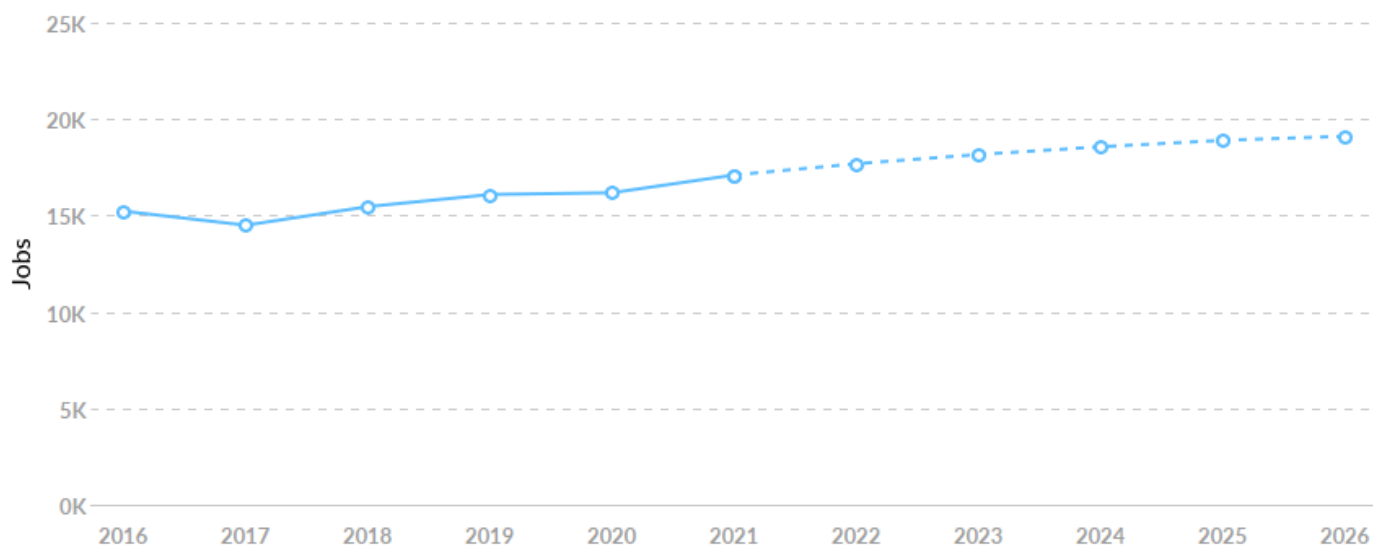

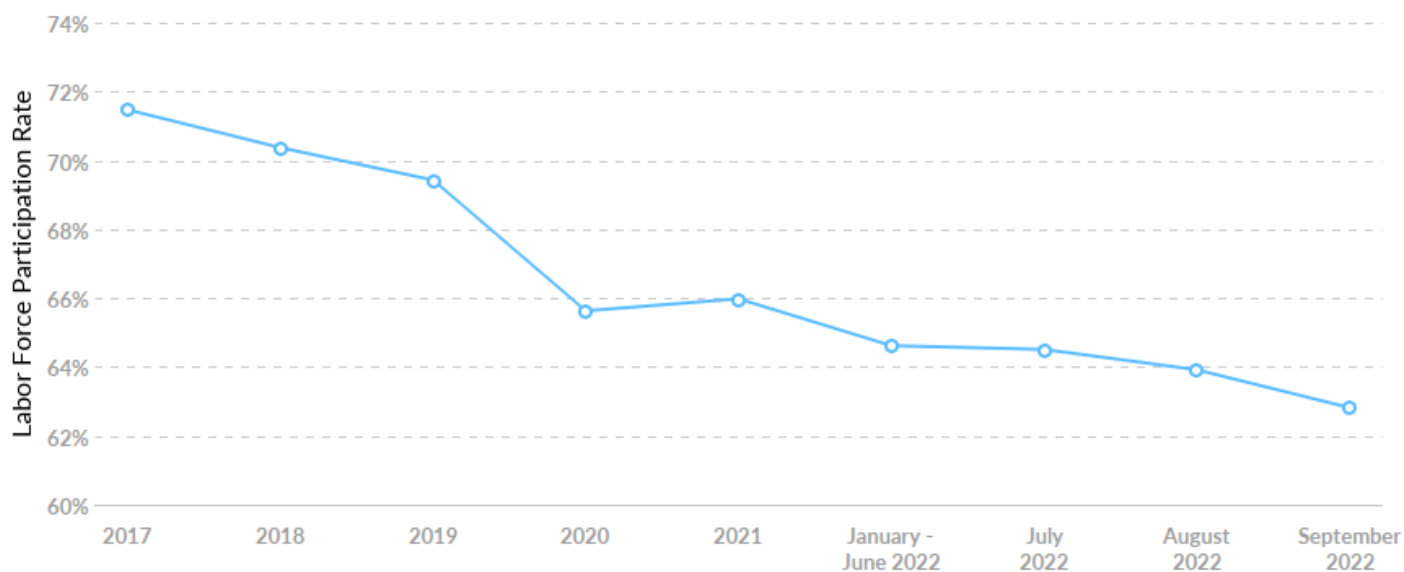
## Job Trends

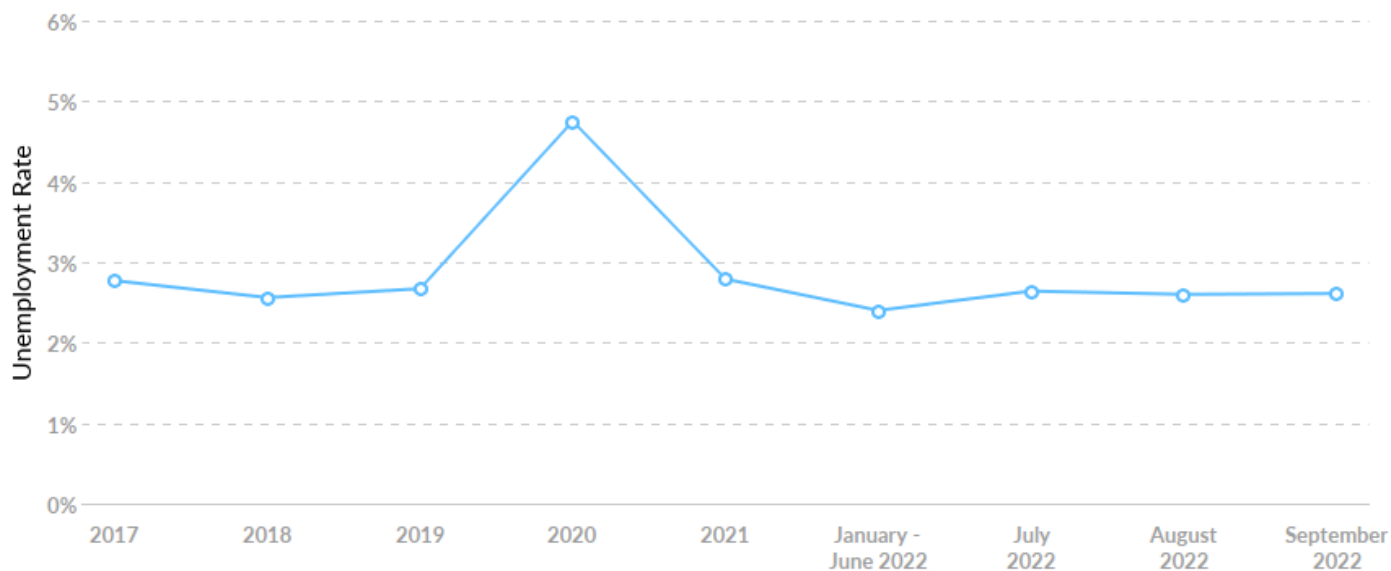

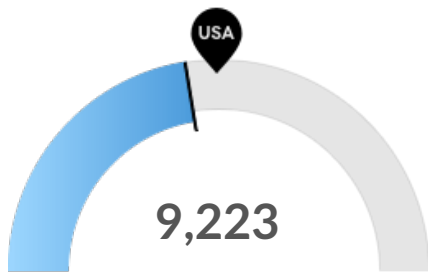
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Calumet County, WI had a September 2022 unemployment rate of 2.61%, **decreasing from 2.77%** 5 years before.



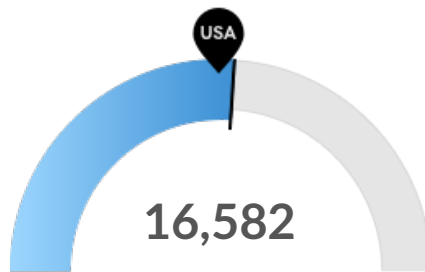

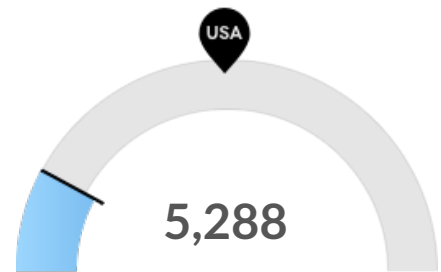
**Millennials**

Calumet County, WI has 9,223 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,732.



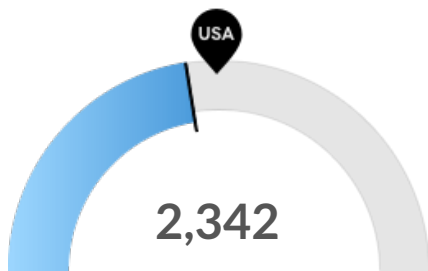
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Calumet County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 15,617 people 55 or older, while there are 16,582 here.



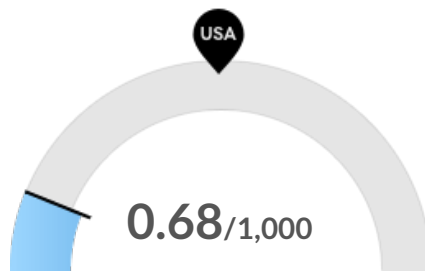
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Calumet County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 21,380 racially diverse people, while there are 5,288 here.



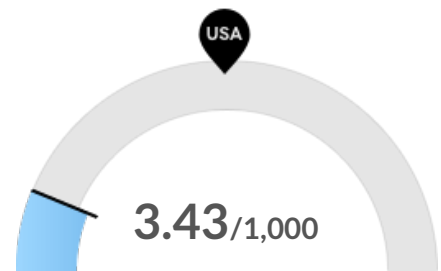
**Veterans**

Calumet County, WI has 0.68 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.

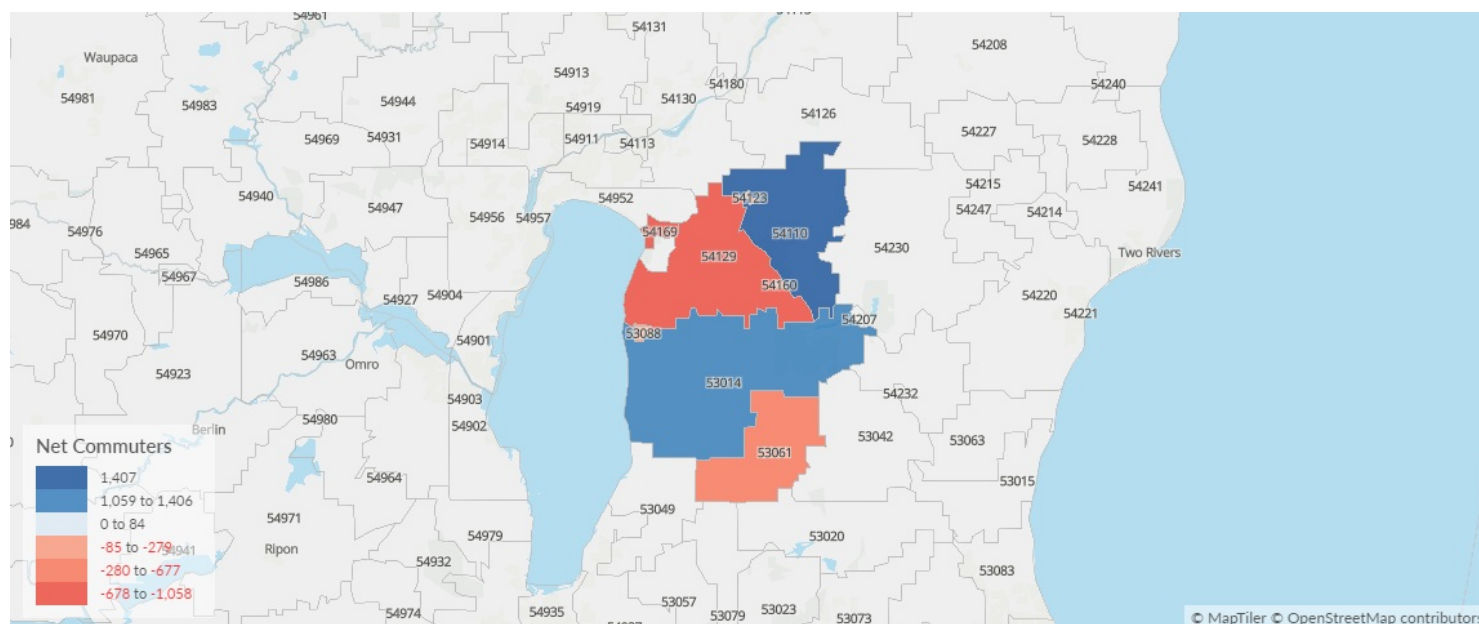


**Property Crime**

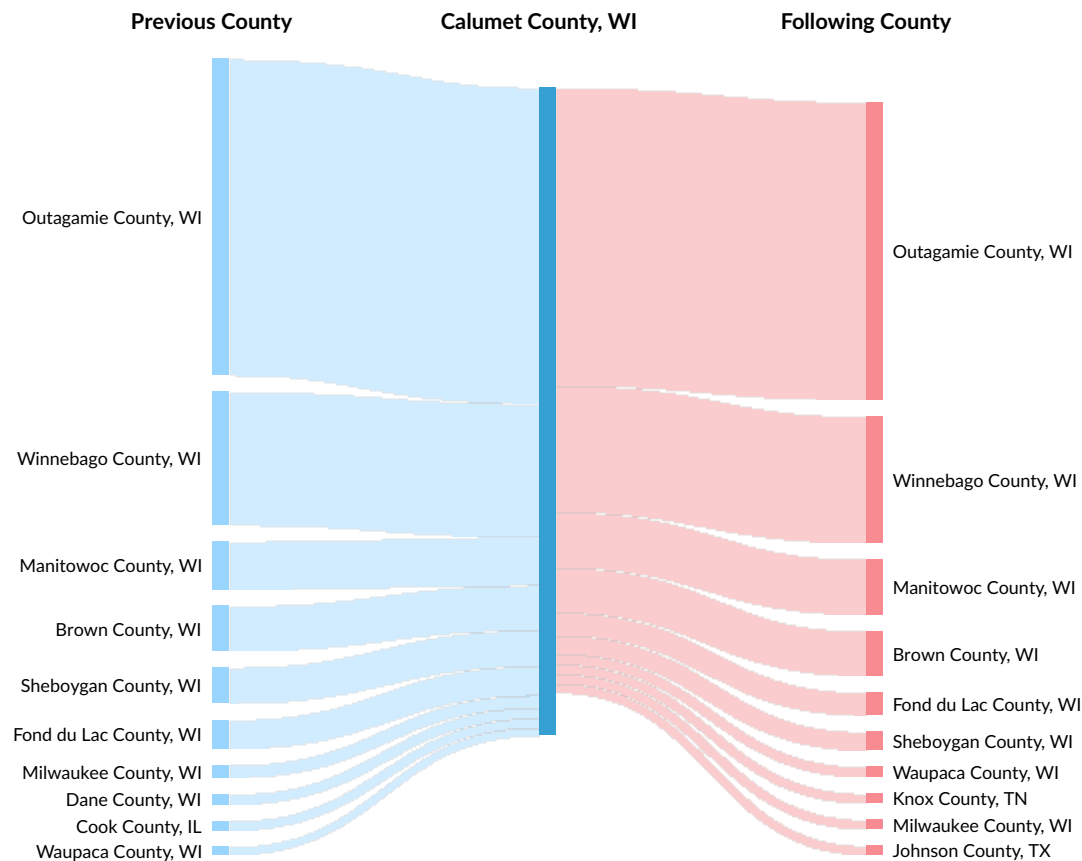

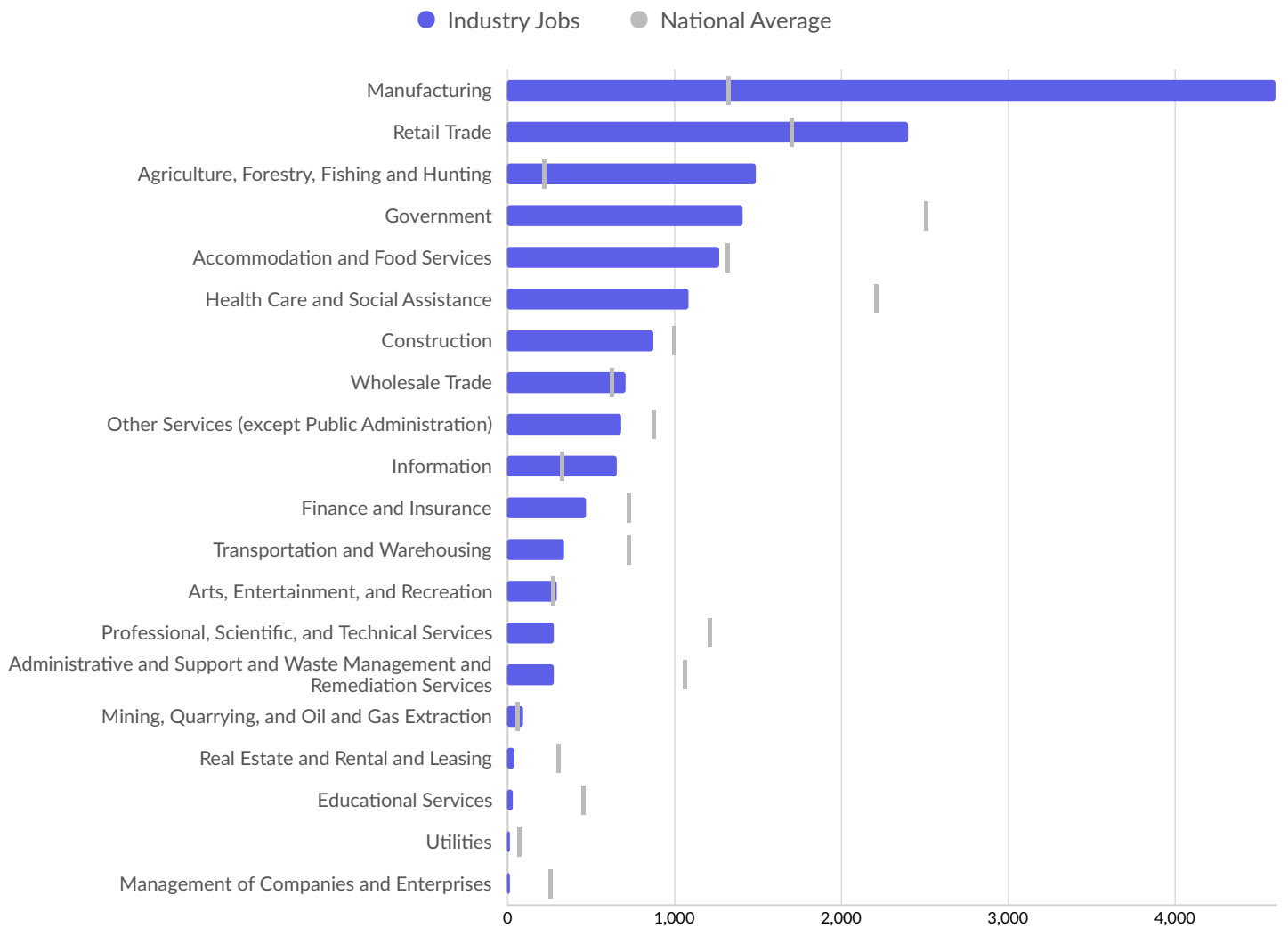

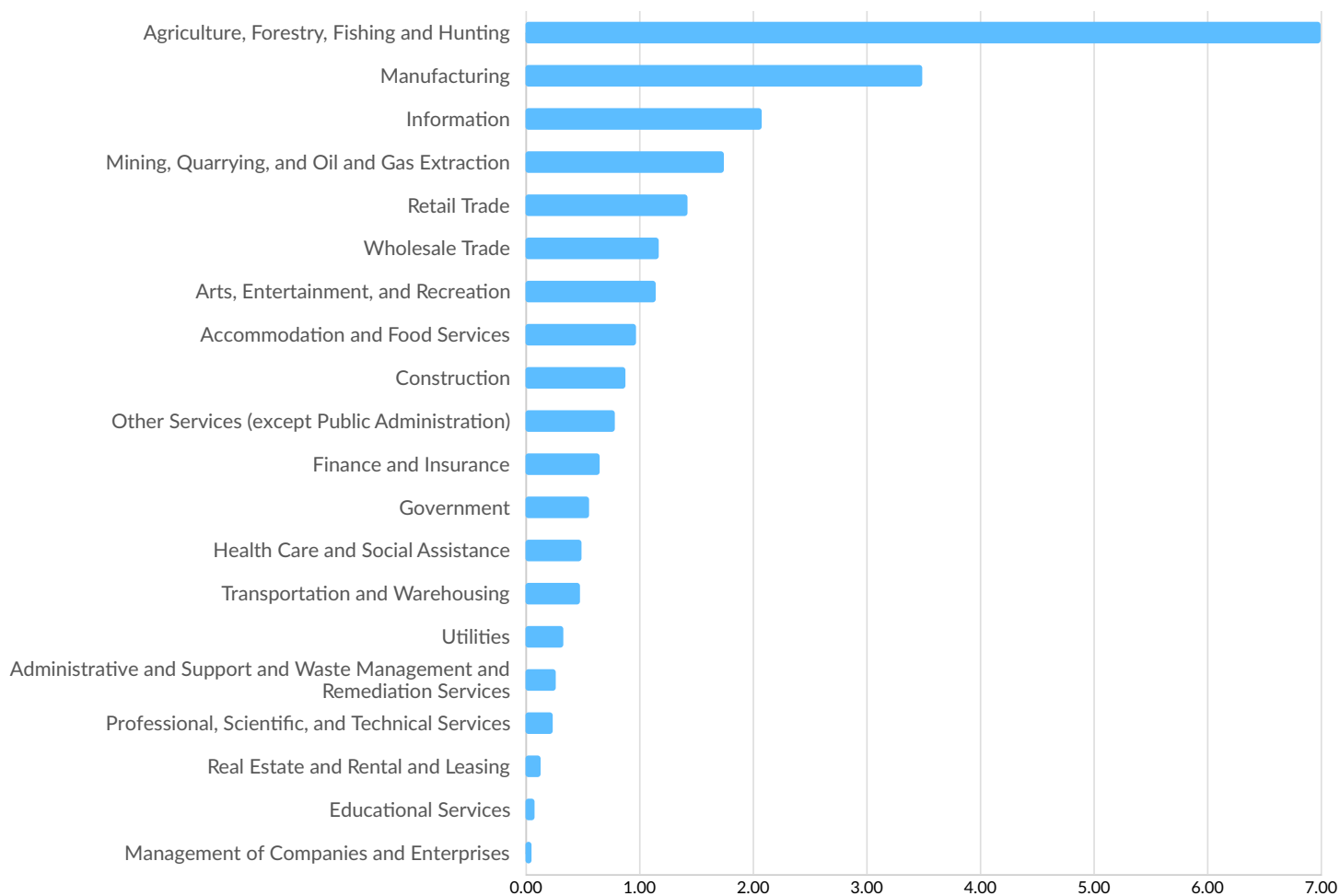

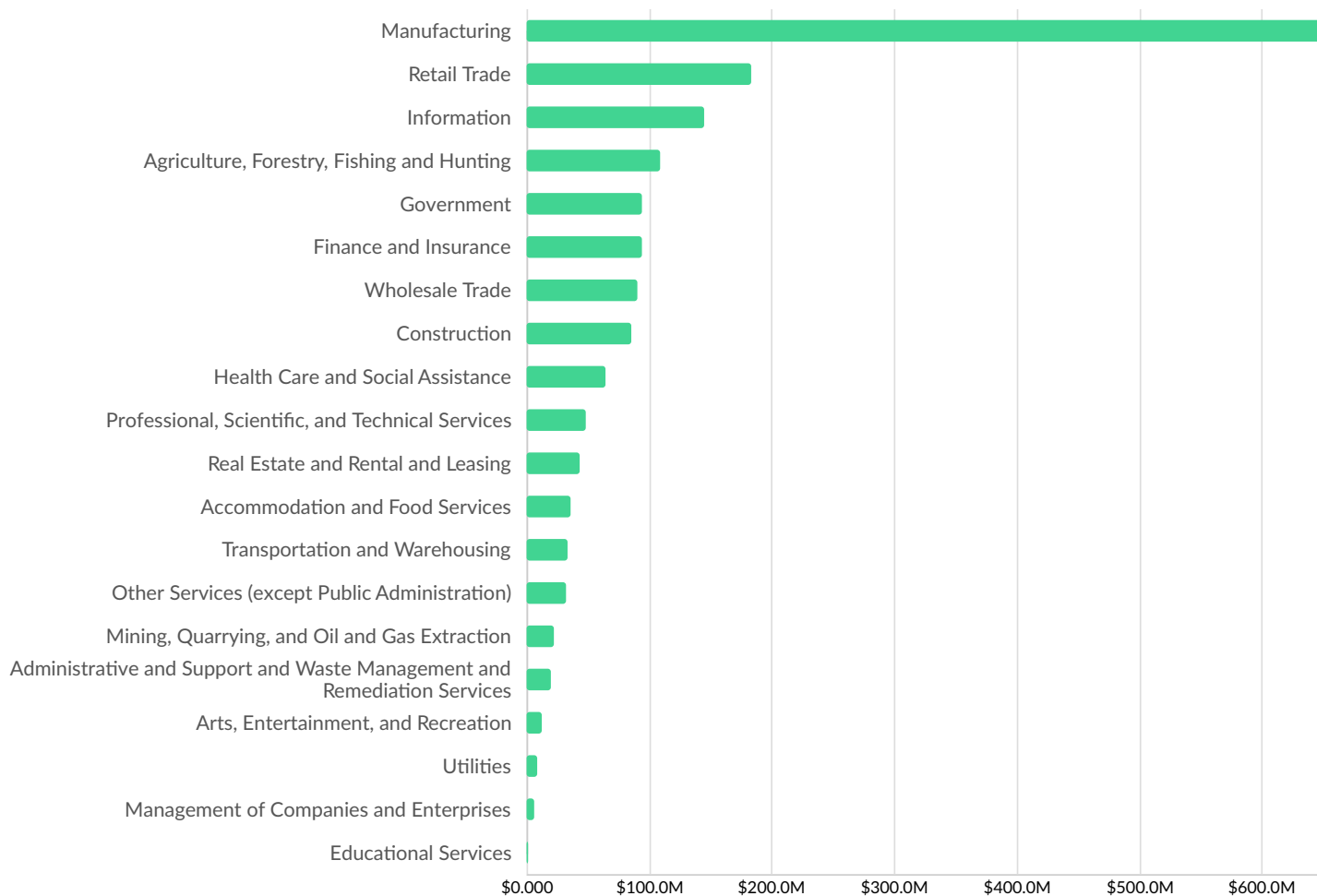

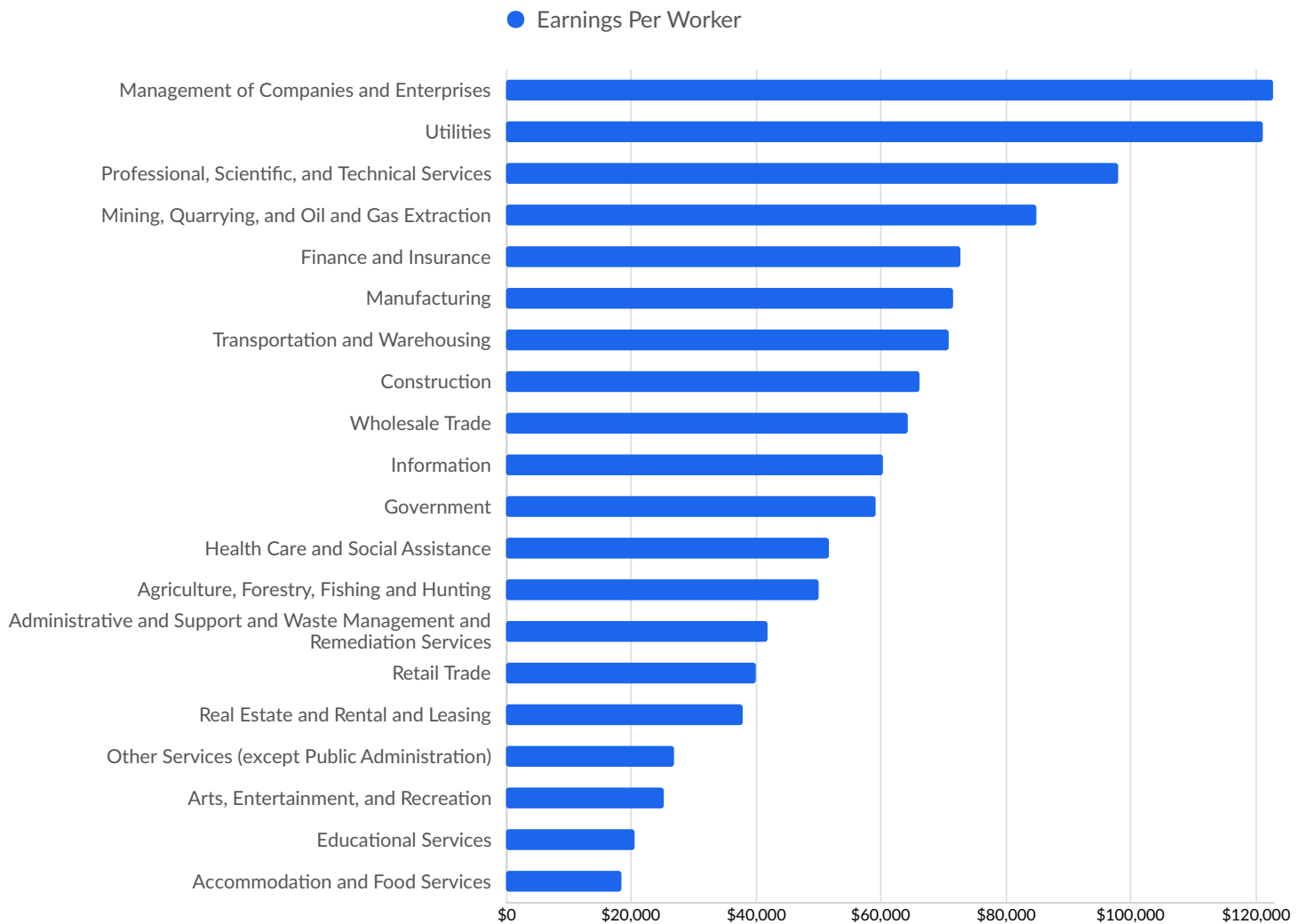


## Top Industry GRP

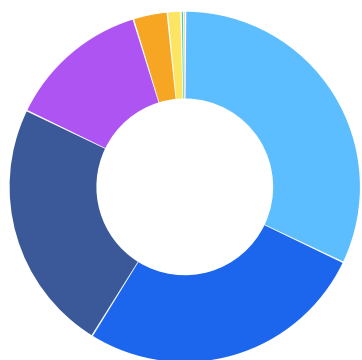

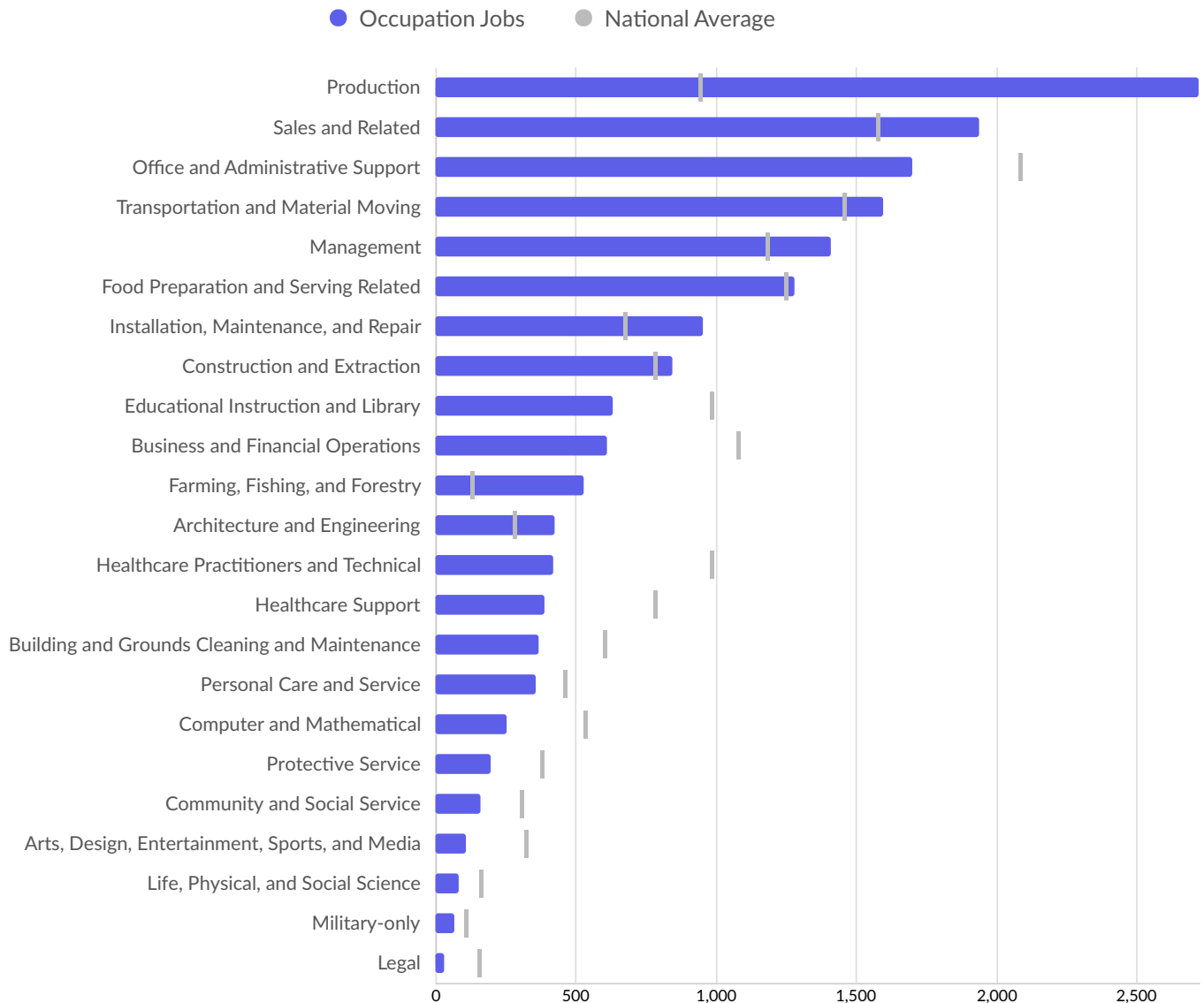

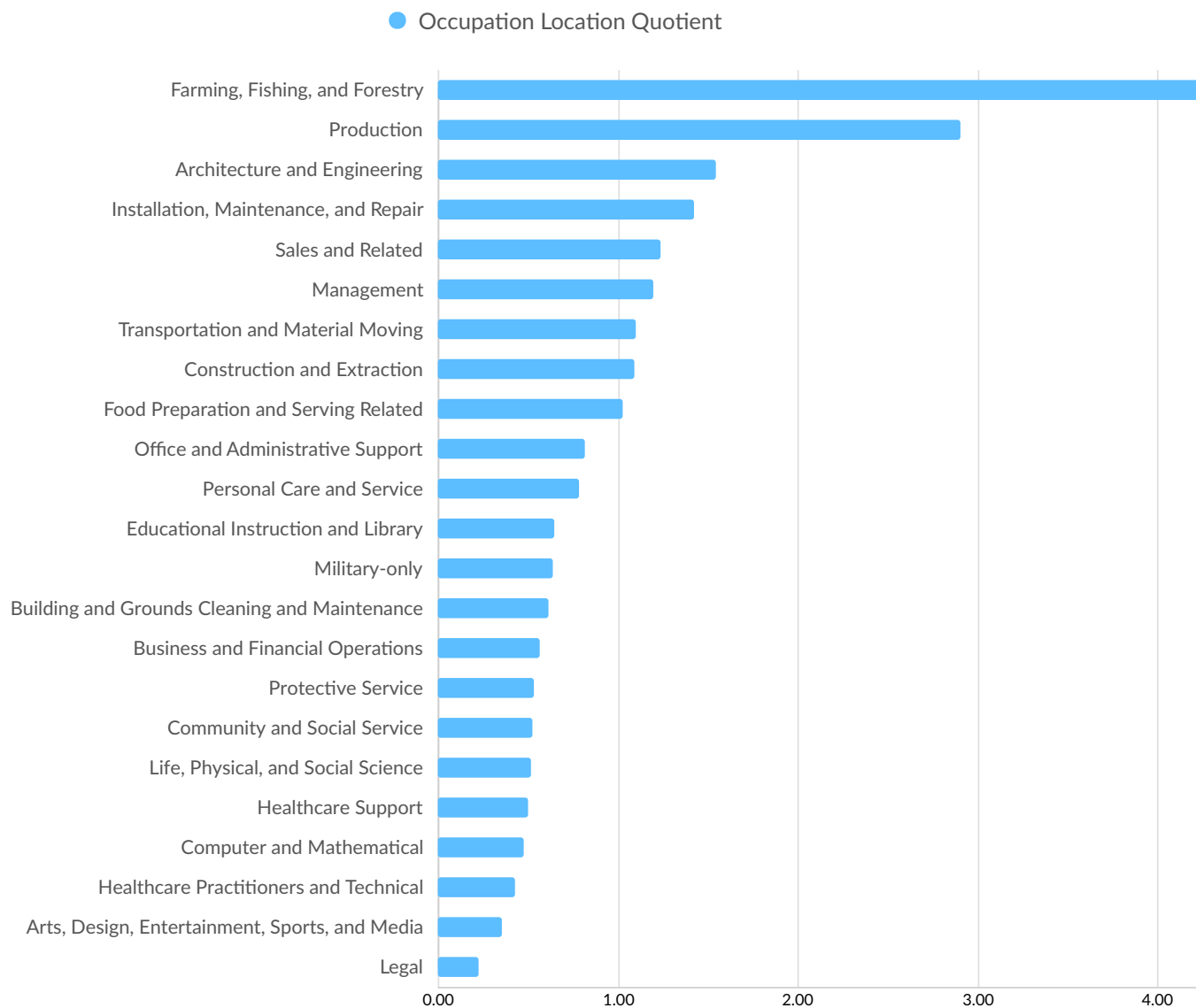
## Largest Occupations



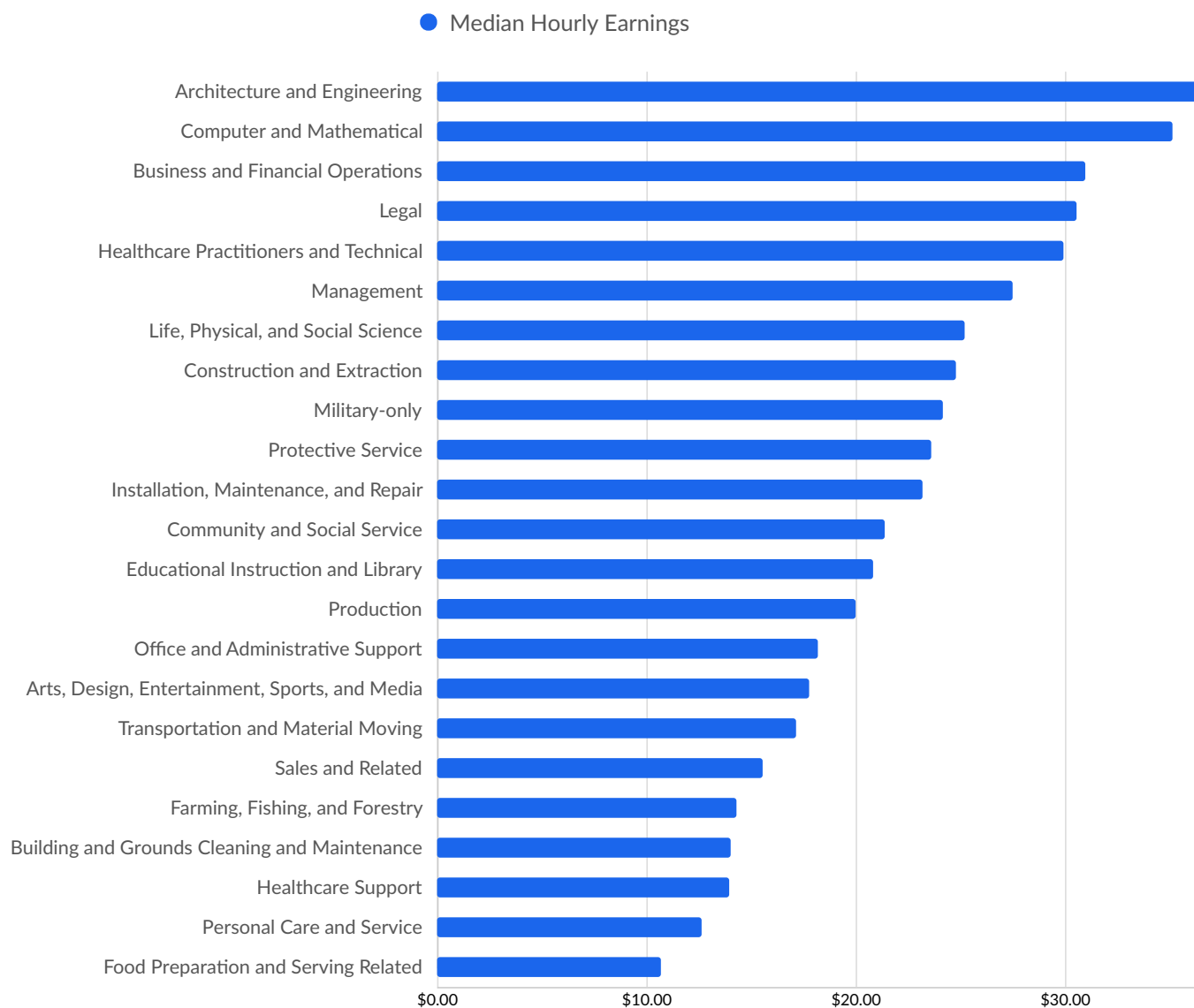
## Top Growing Occupations



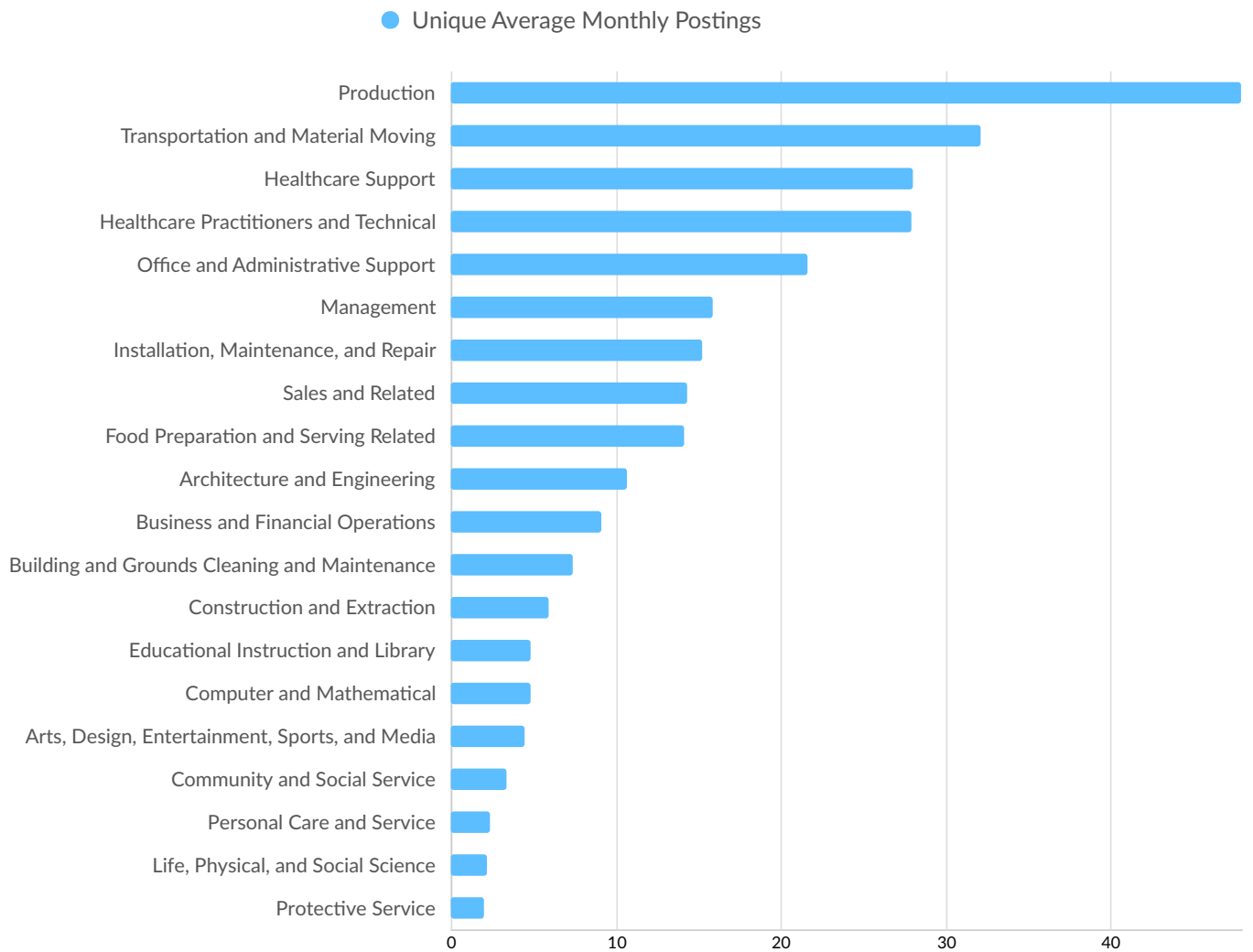
## Top Occupation Location Quotient



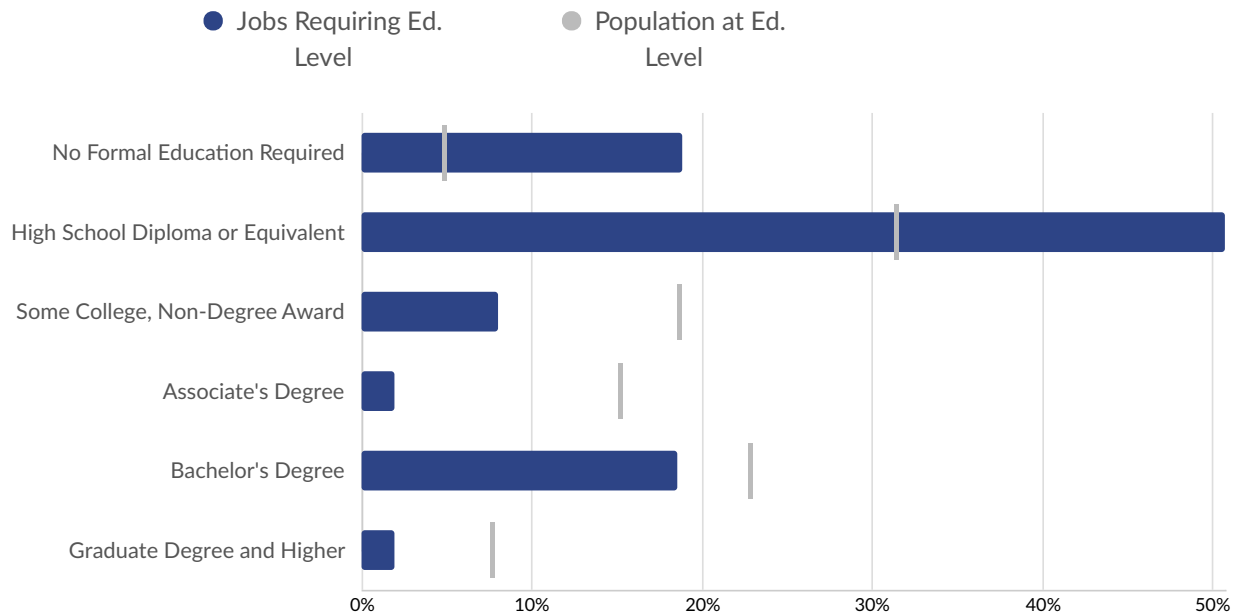
