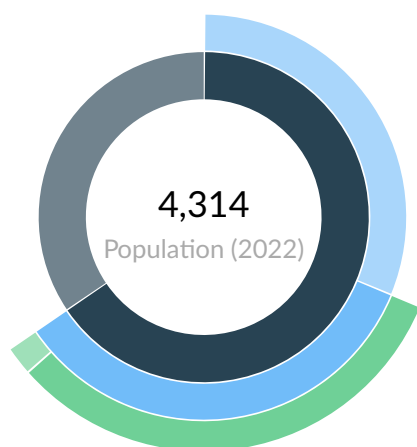

## Takeaways

- As of 2021 the region's population **declined by 5.3%** since 2016, falling by 242. Population is expected to **increase by 4.1%** between 2021 and 2026, adding 177.
- From 2016 to 2021, jobs **increased by 3.3%** in Menominee County, WI from 2,602 to **2,687**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 1.9% by 1.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 49.3% to 51.8% between 2016 and 2021**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.0% of Menominee County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.5% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Gasoline Stations.

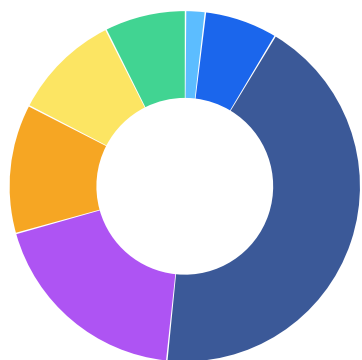

## Educational Attainment

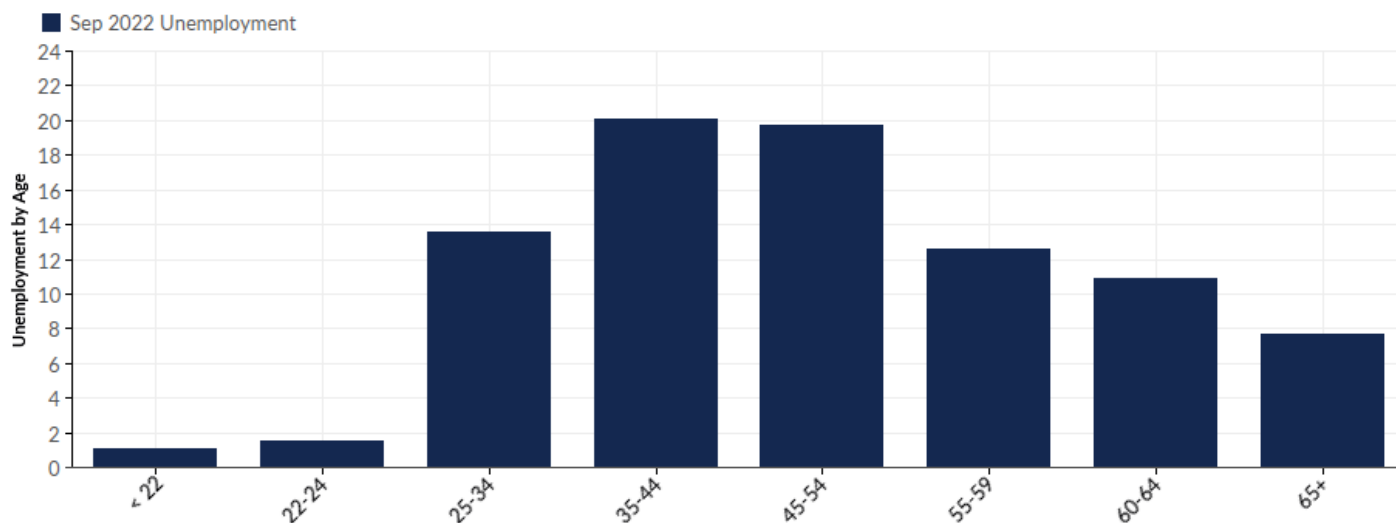

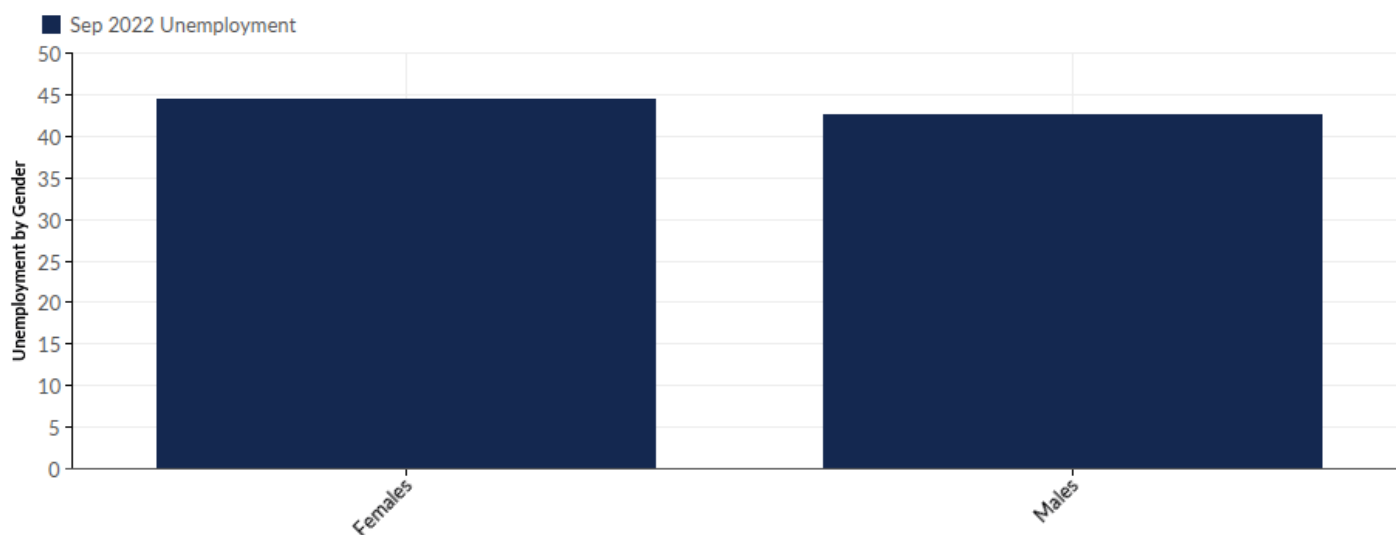

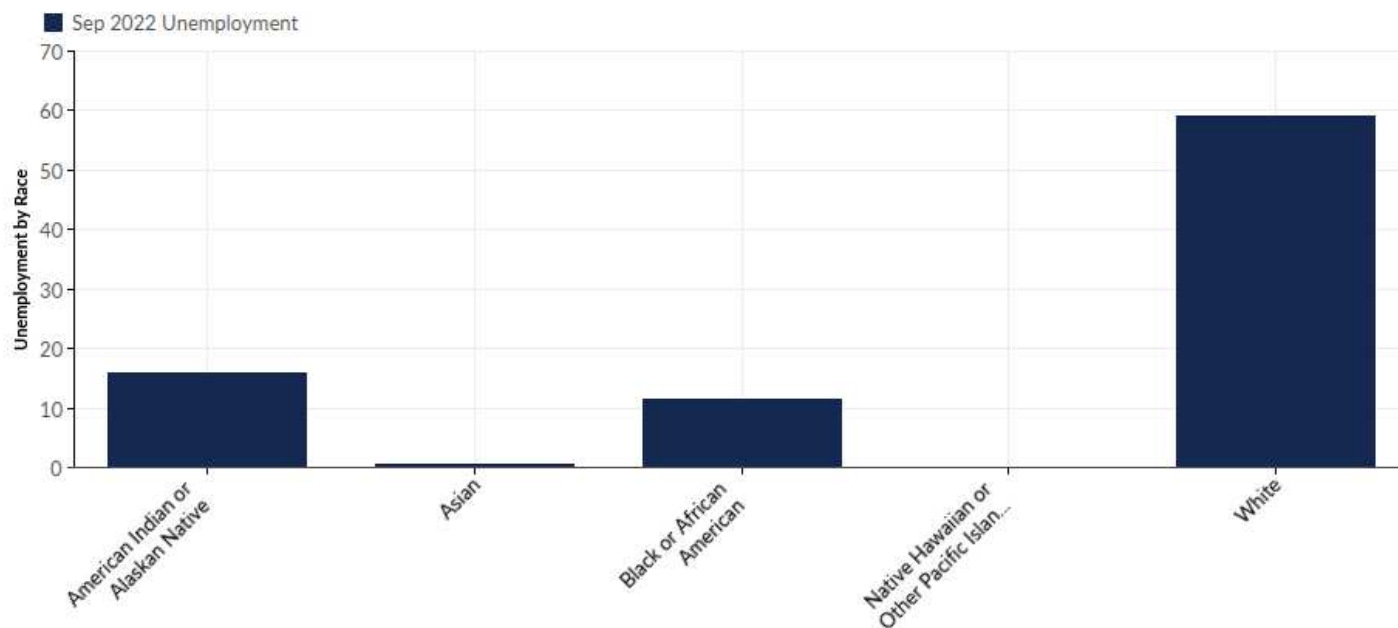

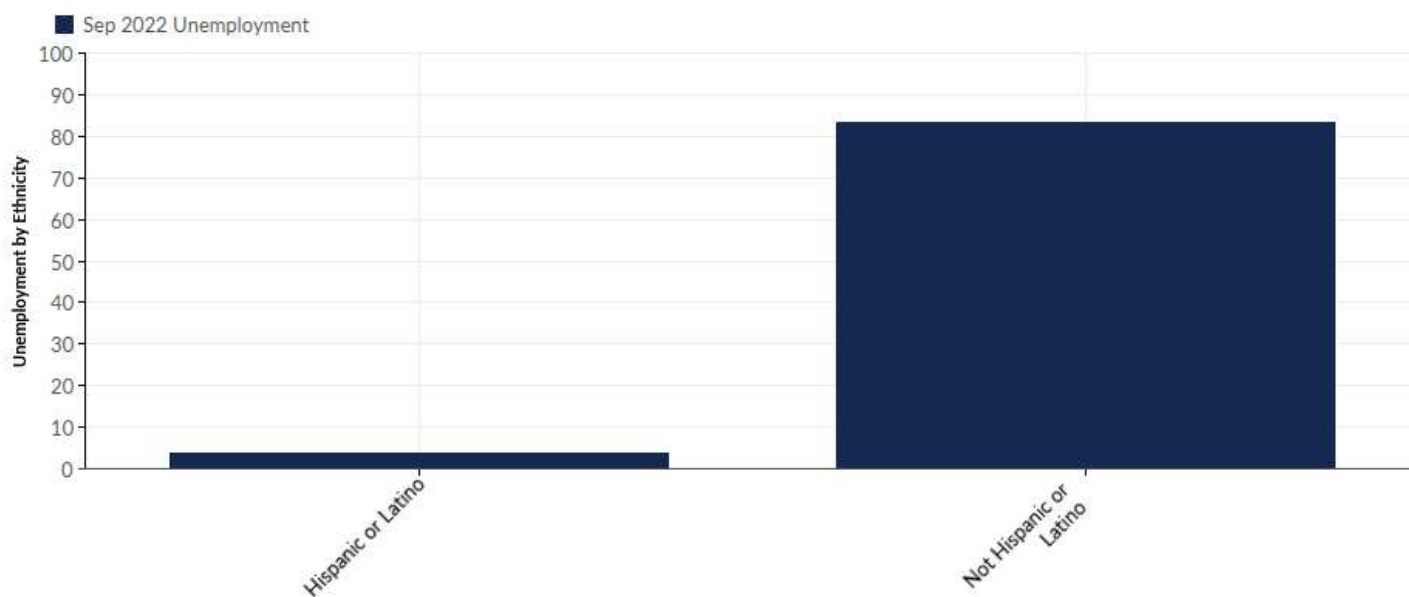

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

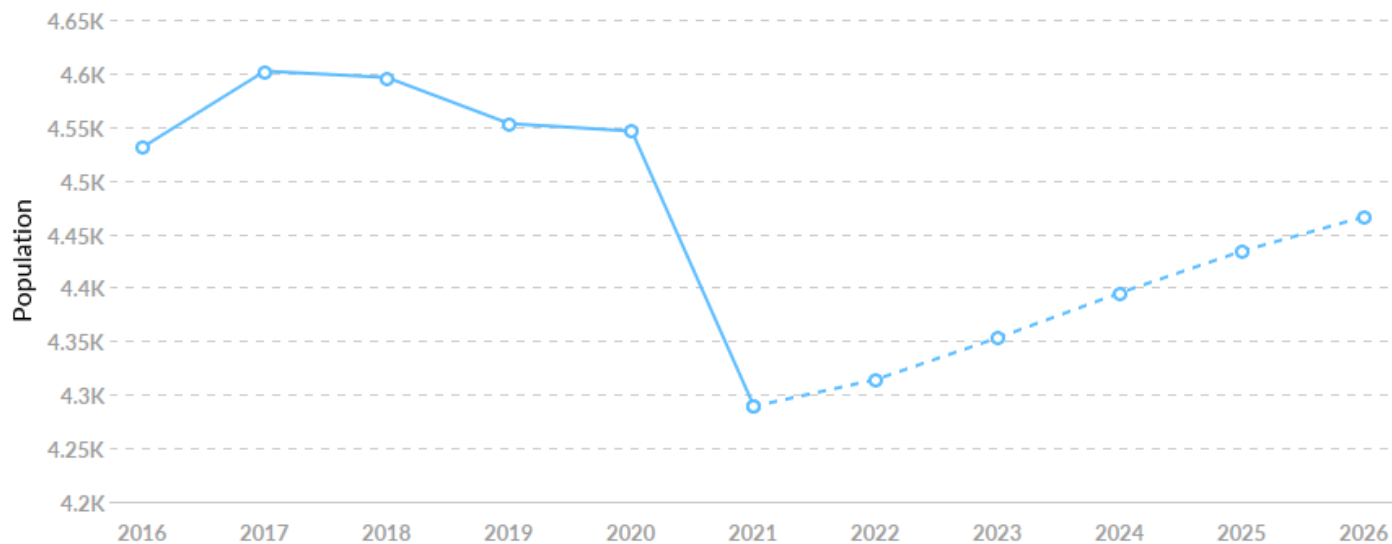

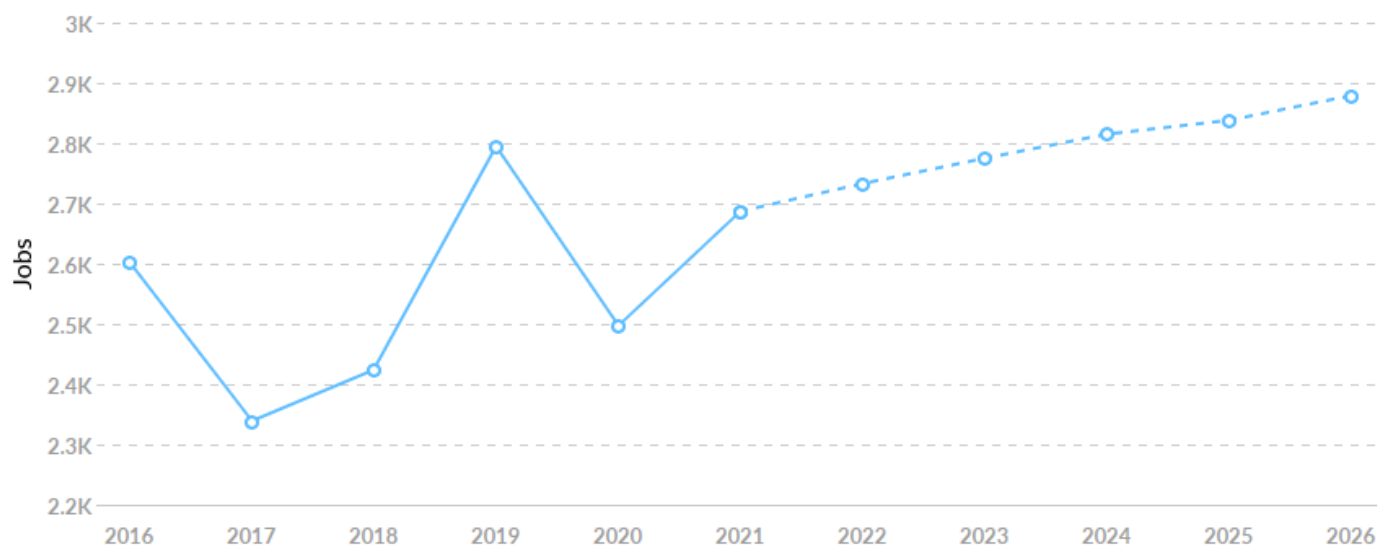

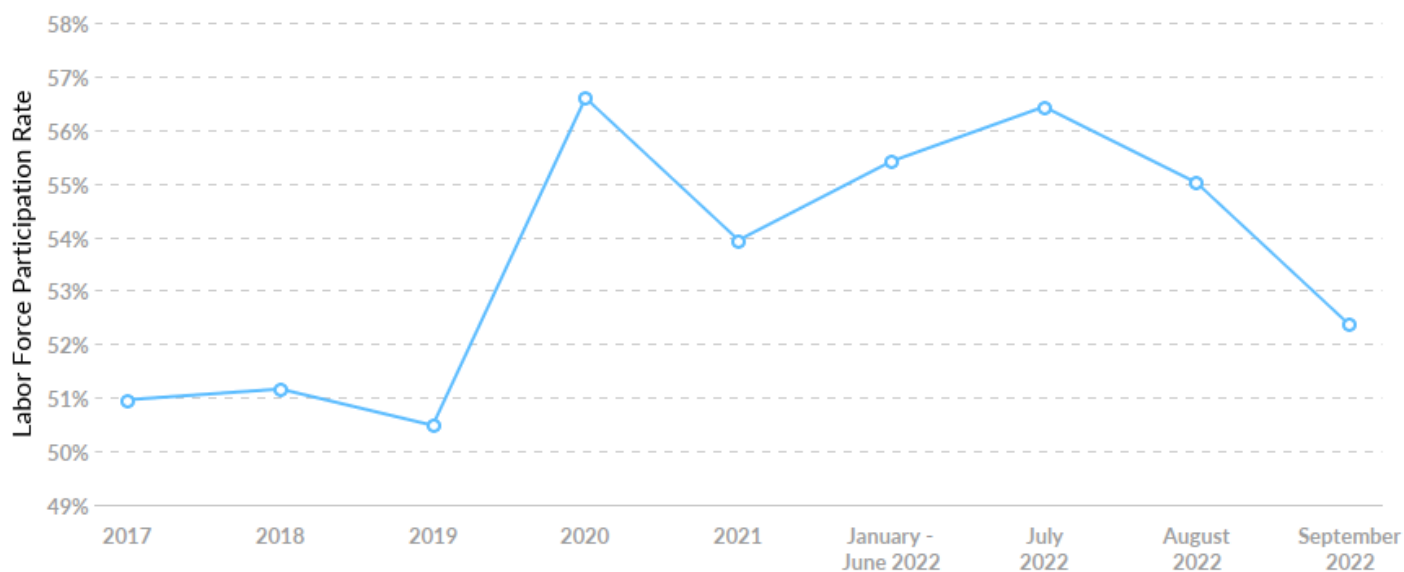
## Job Trends

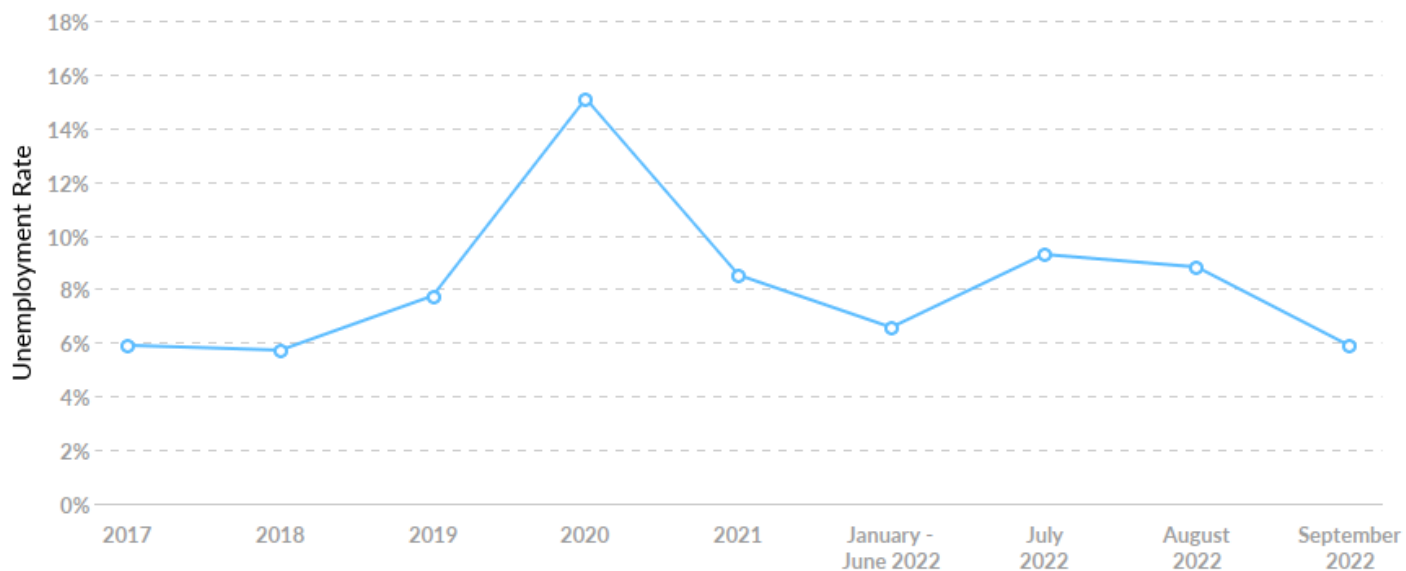

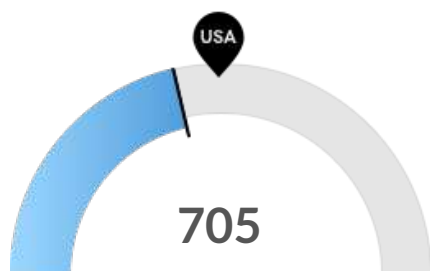
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Menominee County, WI had a September 2022 unemployment rate of 5.89%, **decreasing from 5.90%** 5 years before.



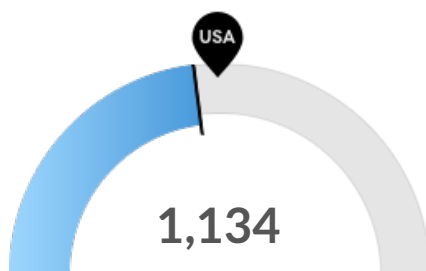

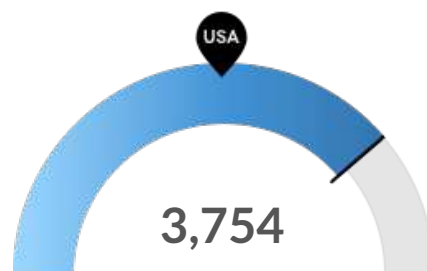
**Millennials**

Menominee County, WI has 705 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 876.



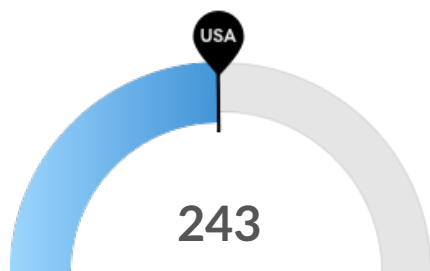
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is low in Menominee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 1,275 people 55 or older, while there are 1,134 here.



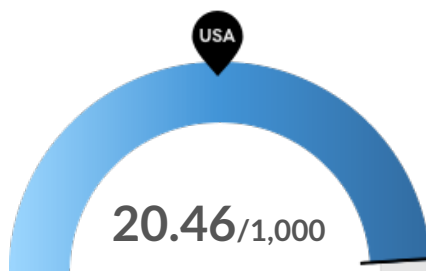
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is high in Menominee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 1,745 racially diverse people, while there are 3,754 here.



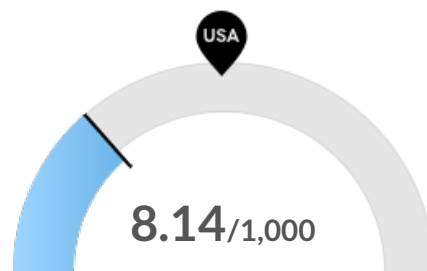
**Veterans**

**Property Crime**

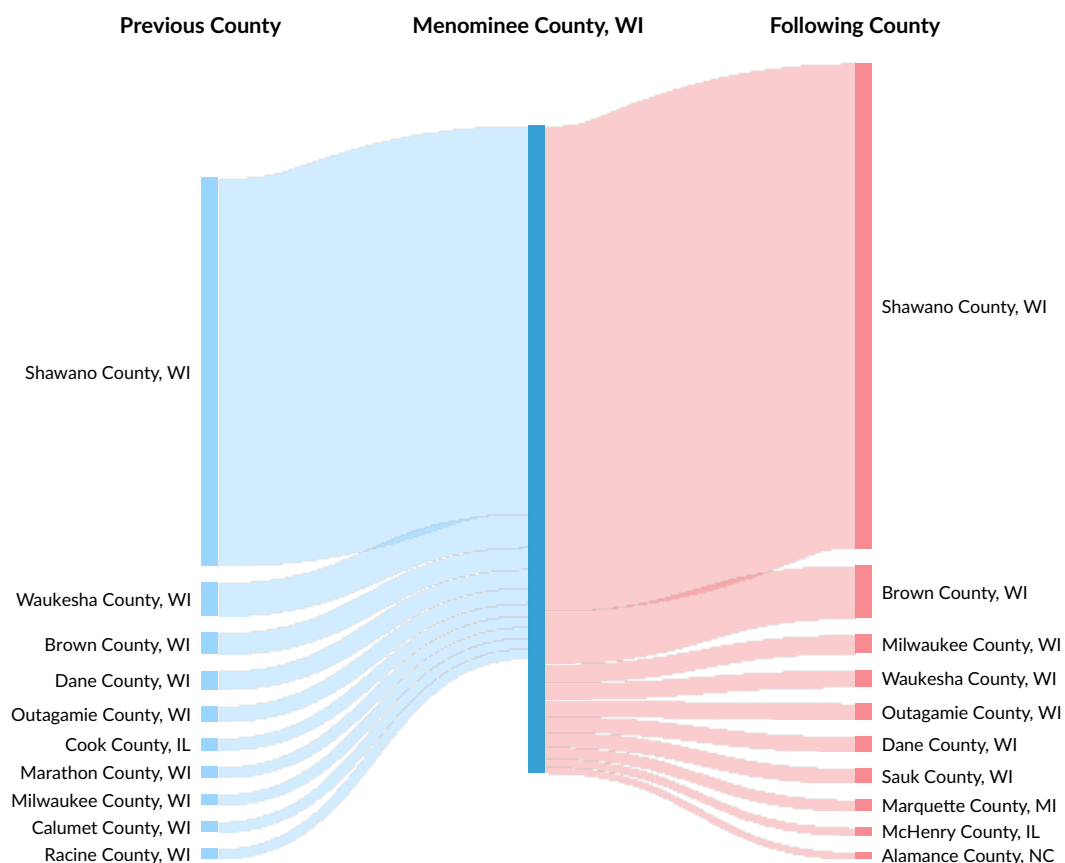
Menominee County, WI has 8.14 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 17.91 per 1,000 people.

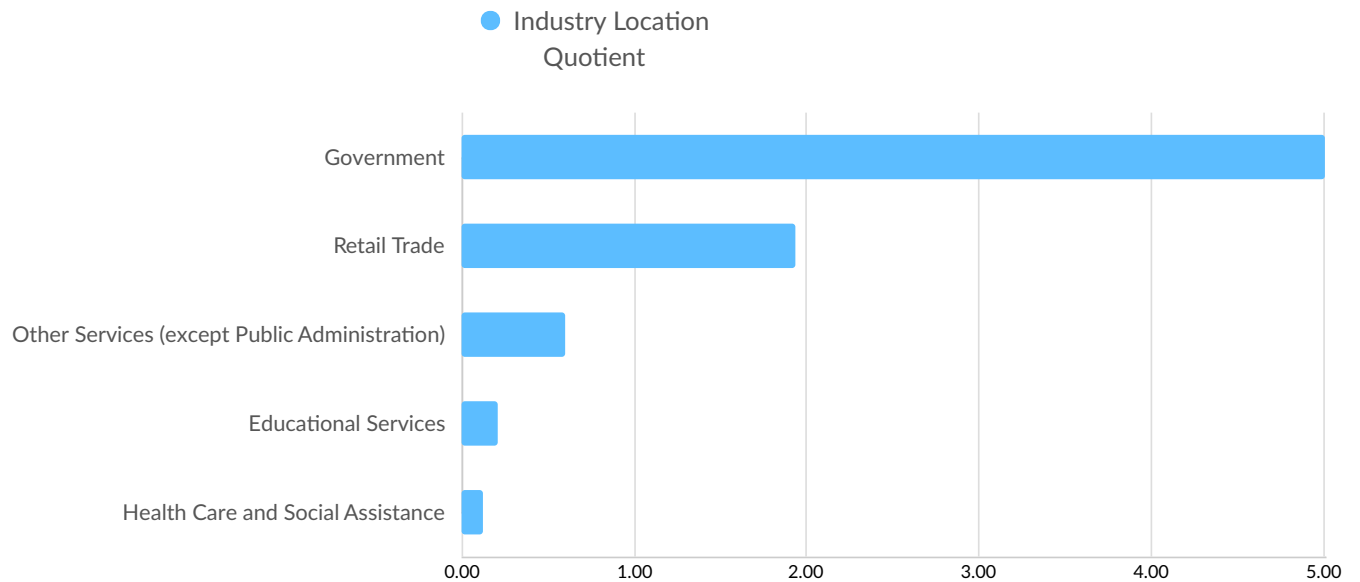

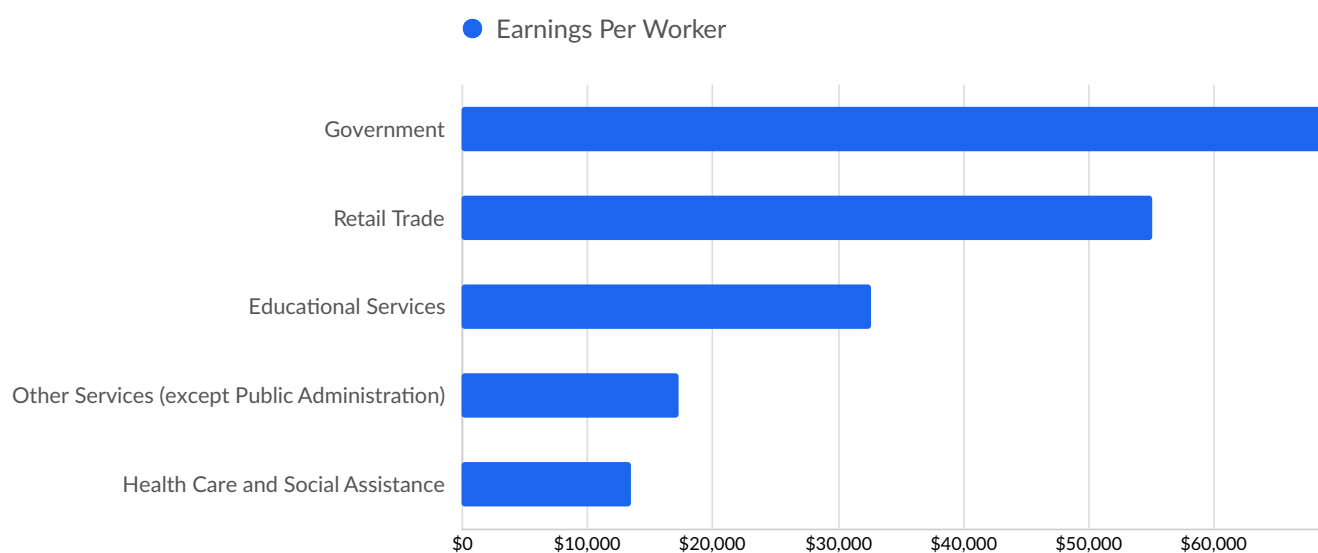
## Top Industry Location Quotient

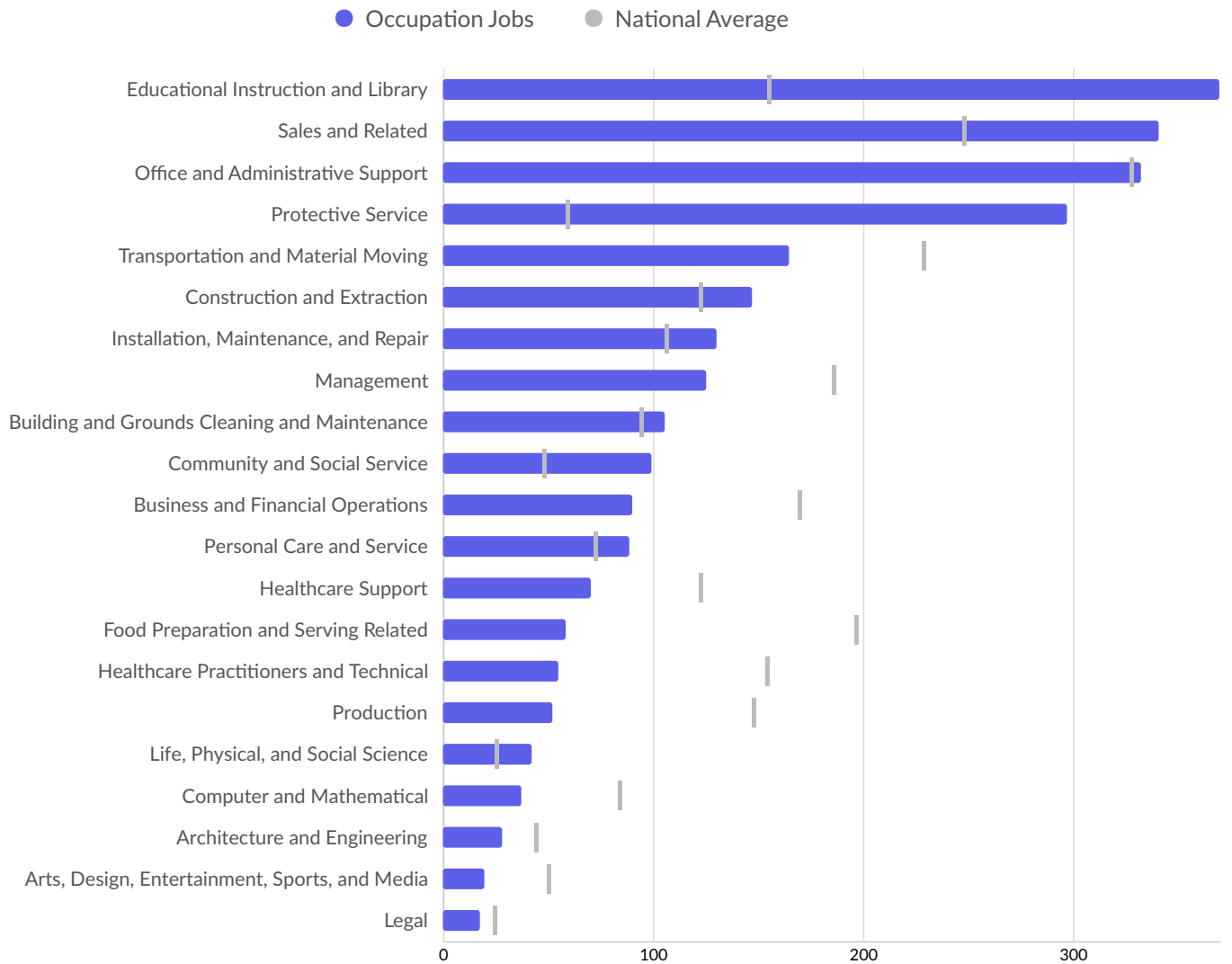

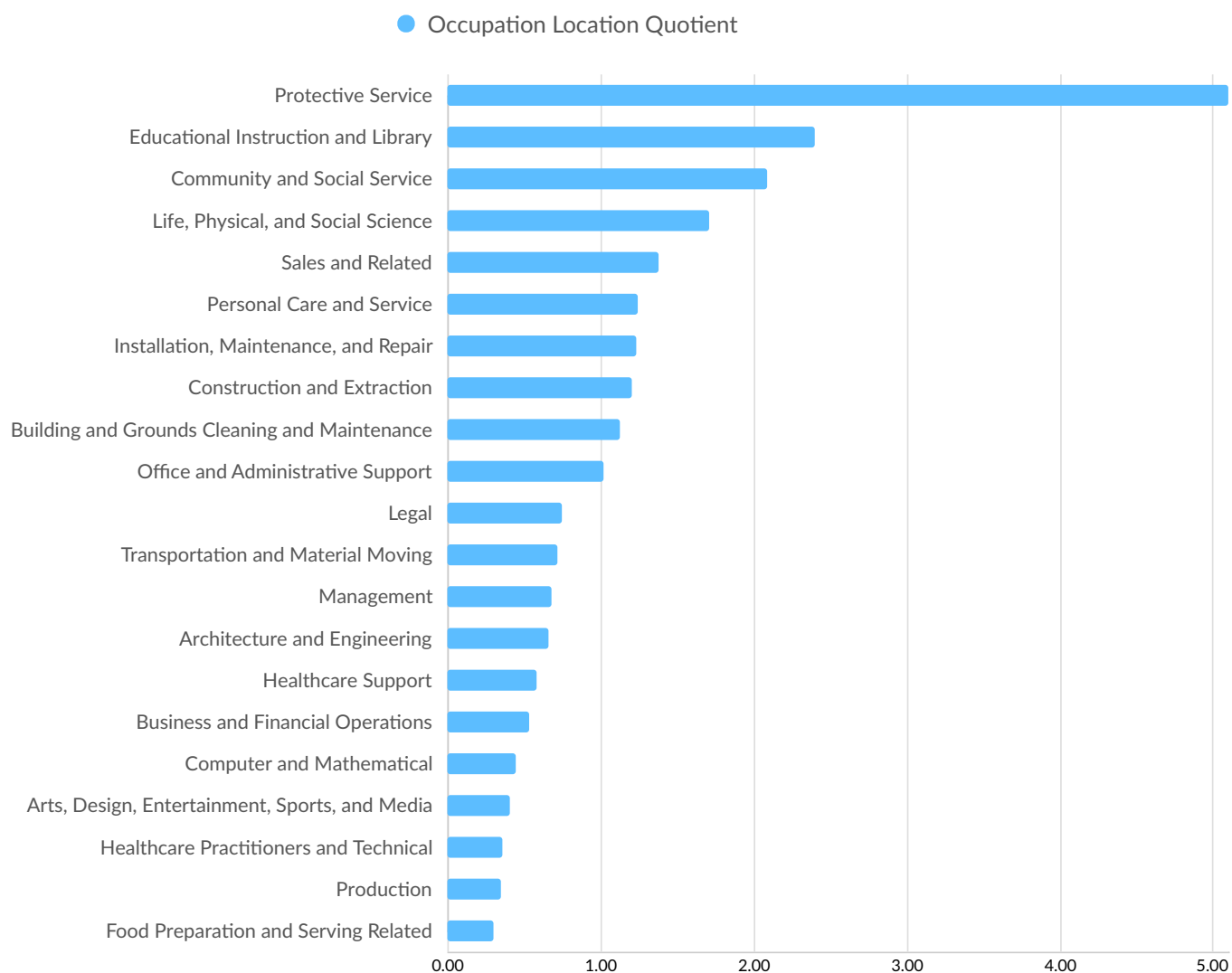

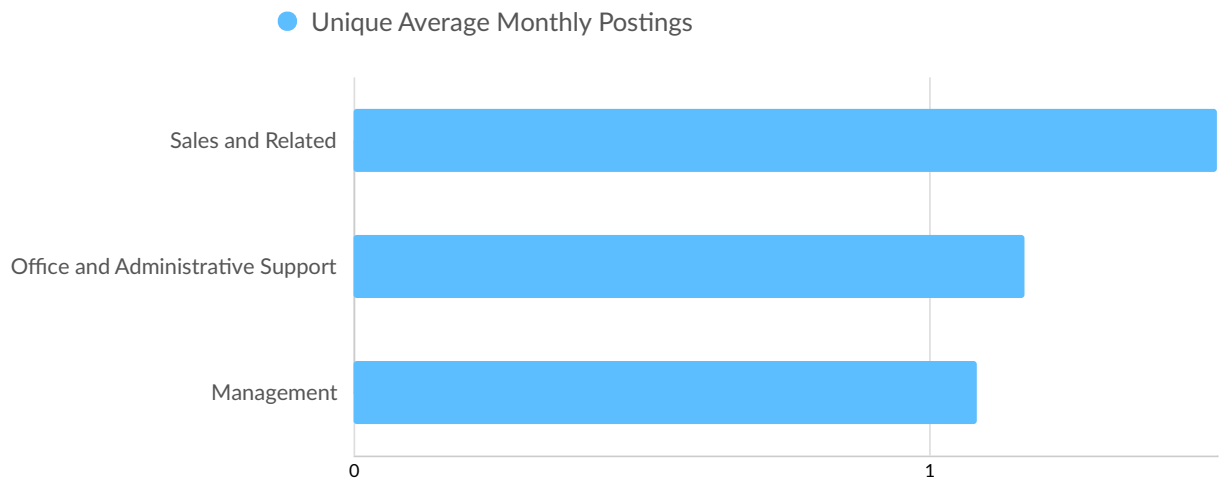
## Top Occupation Location Quotient



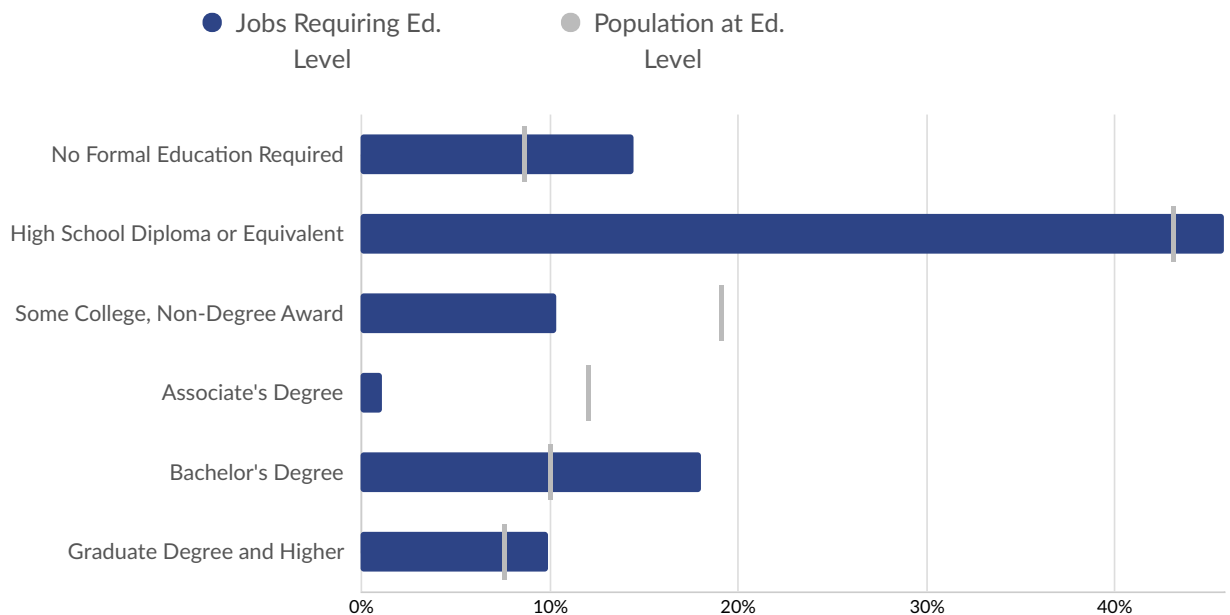

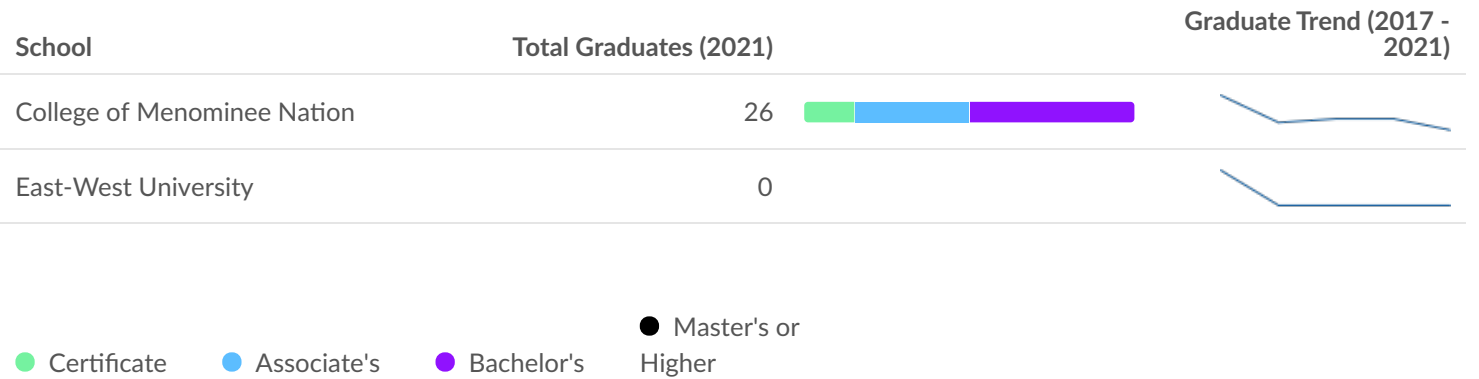
