- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 0.8% since 2018, growing by 316. Population is expected to increase by 1.1% between 2023 and 2028, adding 444.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 3.5% in Shawano County, WI from 14,918 to 14,389. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 7.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.7% to 60.9% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.8% of Shawano County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.3% below the national average), and **14.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Sep 2023 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender







Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population increased by 0.8% since 2018, growing by 316. Population is expected to increase by 1.1% between 2023 and 2028, adding 444.



Job Trends






Shawano County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 3.18%, increasing from 2.99% 5 years before.




Millennials

Shawano County, WI has 6,518 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,314.




Veterans

Shawano County, WI has 2,567 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,143.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Shawano County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 12,253 people 55 or older, while there are 15,606 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Shawano County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 16,814 racially diverse people, while there are 5,926 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




