- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.2% since 2018, growing by 14,498. Population is expected to increase by 2.2% between 2023 and 2028, adding 14,644.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 0.7% in 10 Wisconsin Counties from 347,850 to 345,346. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.9% to 66.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.5% below the national average), and **13.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender












Unemployment Rate Trends












Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




