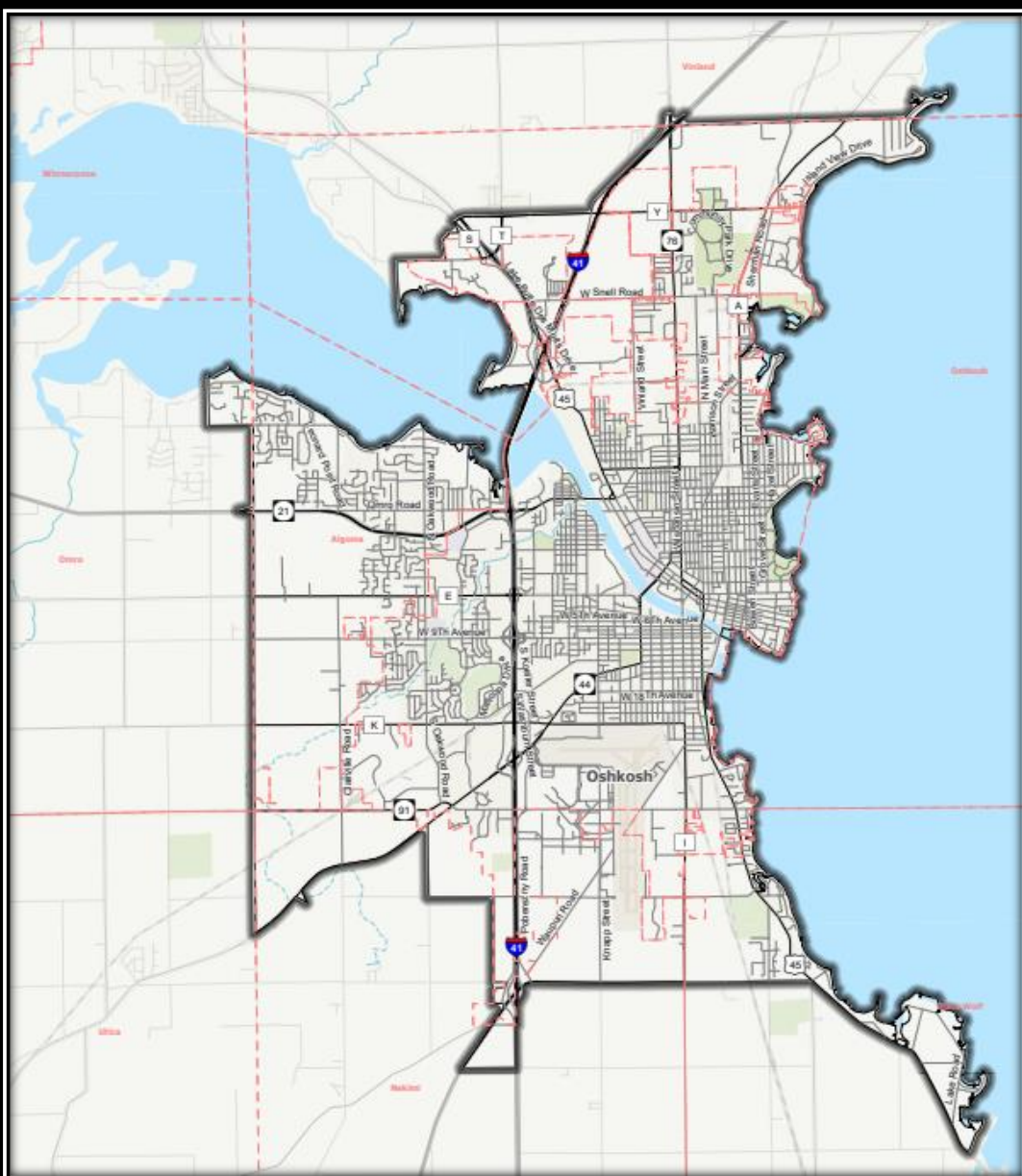

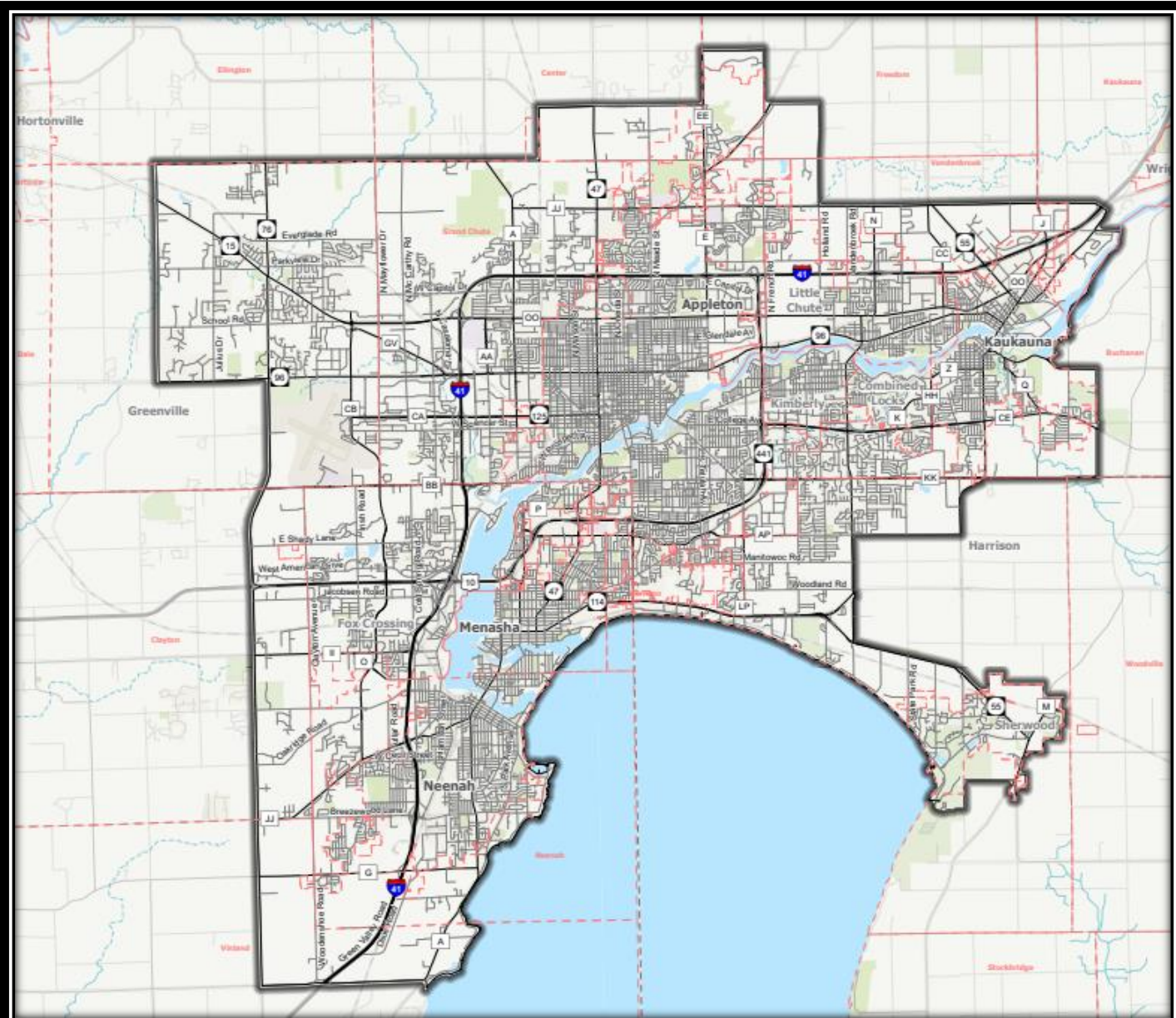

# Application scoring rubric


Application Response Topic	Scoring Considerations	Points
Location	Clearly defined location, corridor or area that needs technical assistance.	10
Requested Assistance	Clear description of the sort(s) of planning assistance that ECWRPC is being requested to provide.	15
Transportation Challenge(s)	Indication of how the transportation challenges are related to safety, mobility, preservation, and/or other local transportation goals.	25
Prior Analysis	Clear description of prior analysis, actions taken because of the analysis, or reasons why analysis wasn't conducted in the past.	15
Underserved Communities	Clear demonstration of how technical assistance will address transportation needs of disadvantaged and/or underserved populations.	15
Community Support and Engagement	Indication of community support for the project OR description of why or how community engagement would be needed as part of the project. Letters of support will be considered.	20
