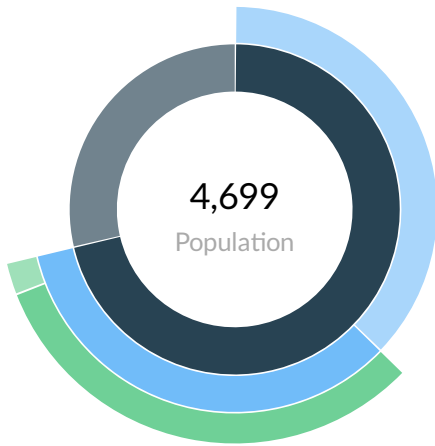
Median household income is **\$16.4K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2014 to 2019, jobs **declined by 2.5%** in Menominee County, WI from 2,439 to **2,378**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.6% by 10.1%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 48.6% to 47.8% between 2014 and 2019**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.0% of Menominee County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.8% below the national average), and **11.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Junior Colleges.

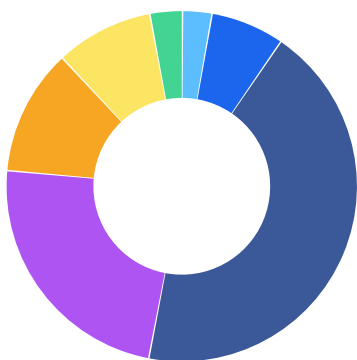

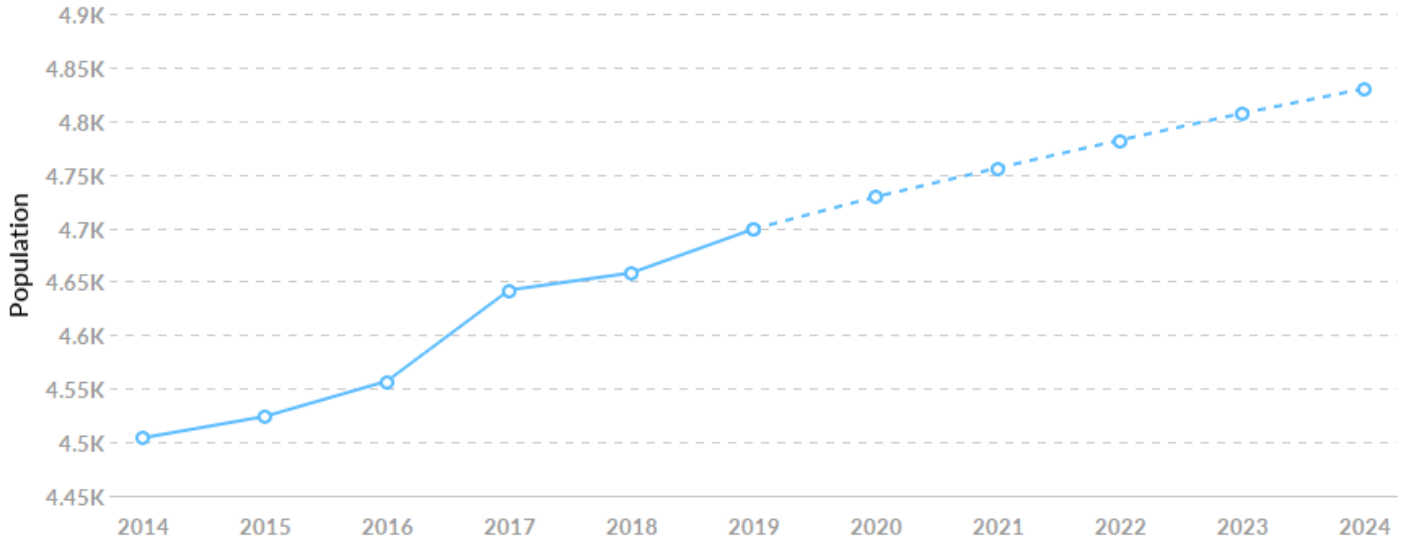

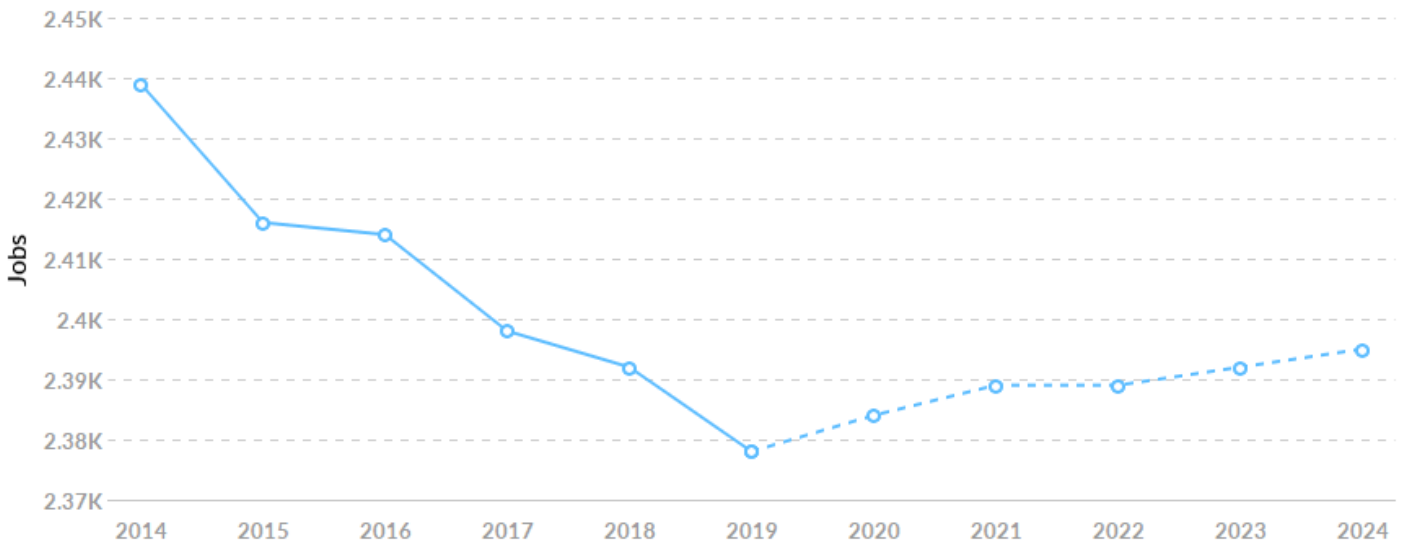

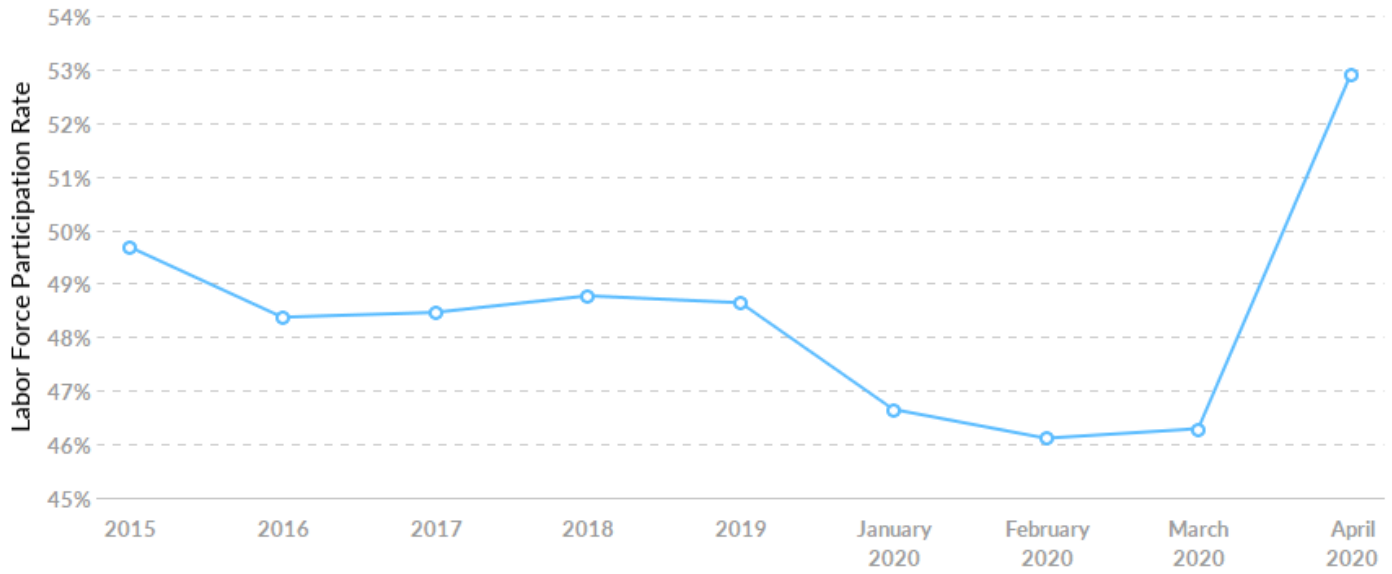
Job Trends

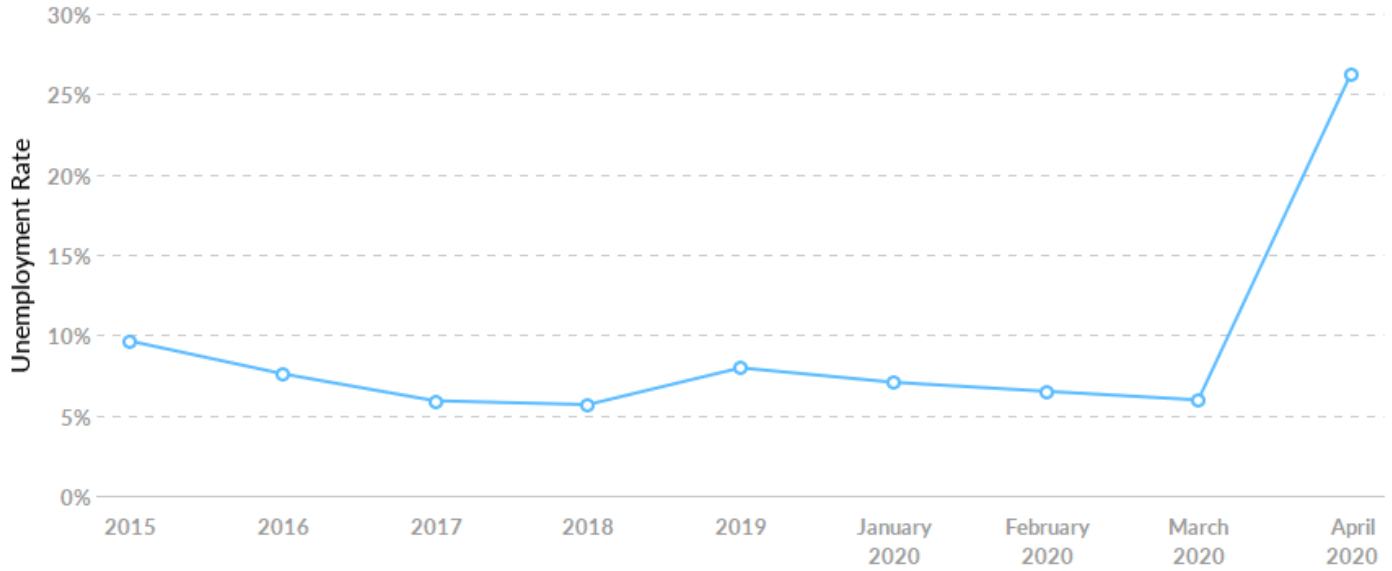

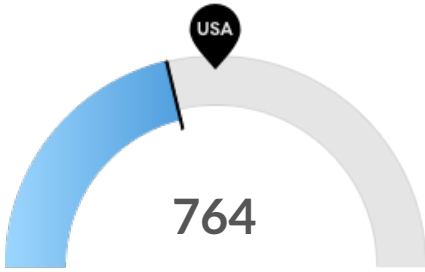
Unemployment Rate Trends

Menominee County, WI had an April 2020 unemployment rate of 26.25%, **increasing from 9.63%** 5 years before.



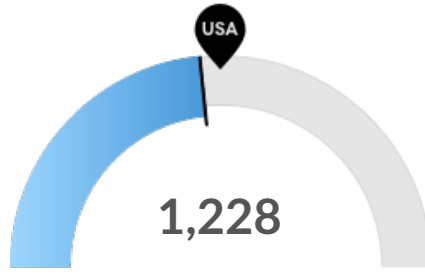

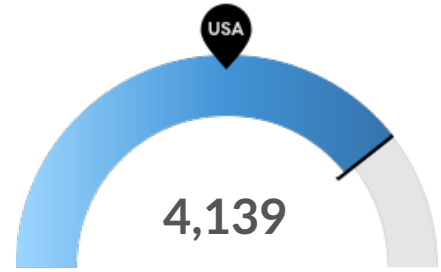
Millennials

Menominee County, WI has 764 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 958.



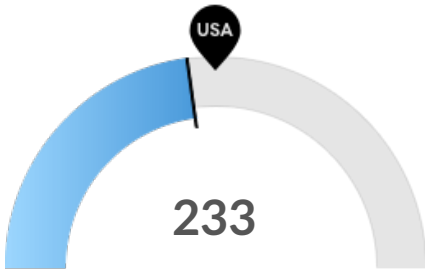
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Menominee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 1,348 people 55 or older, while there are 1,228 here.



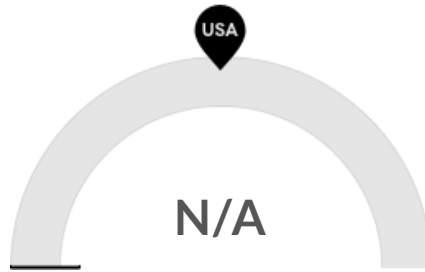
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Menominee County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 1,845 racially diverse people, while there are 4,139 here.



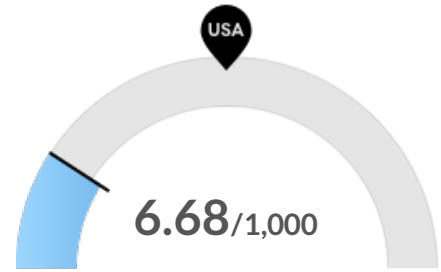
Veterans

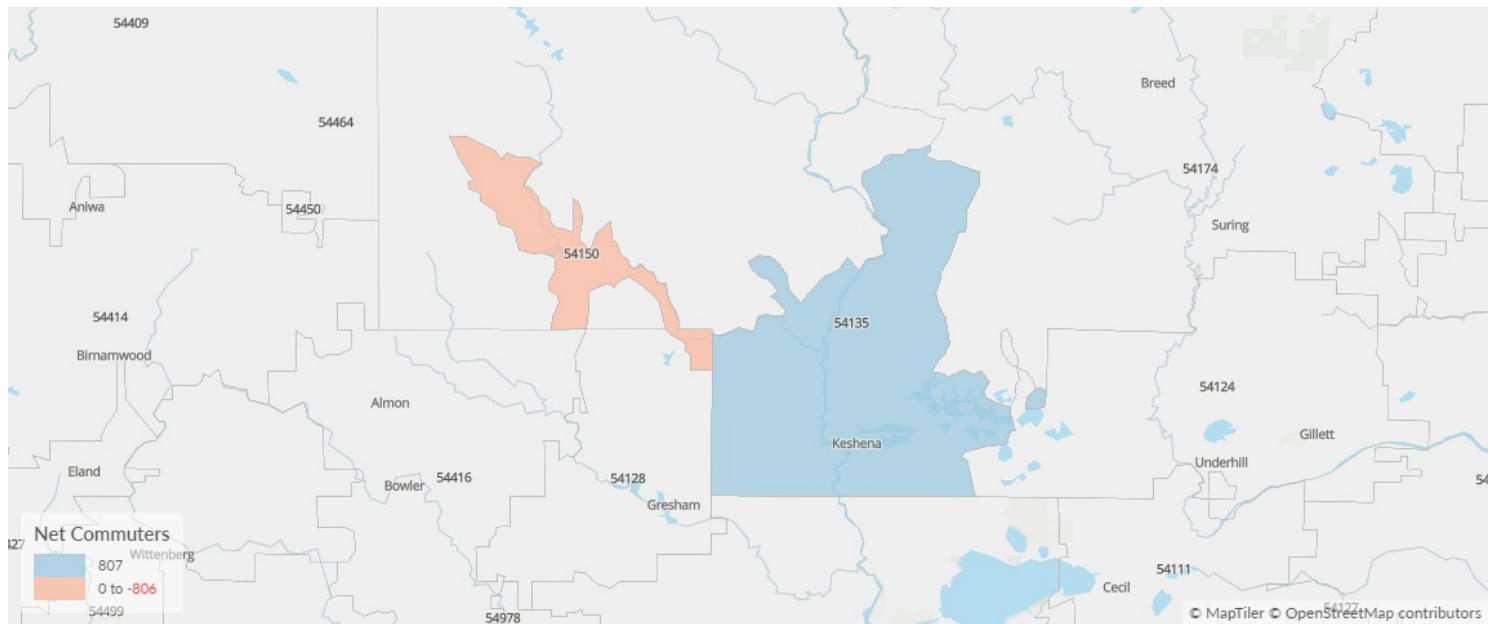


Property Crime

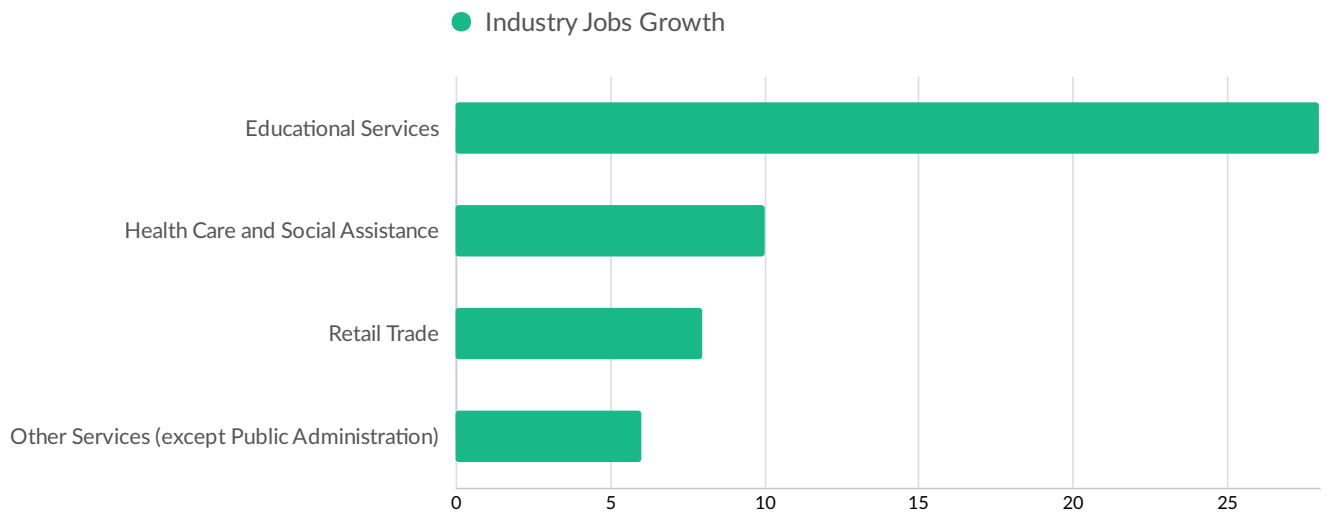

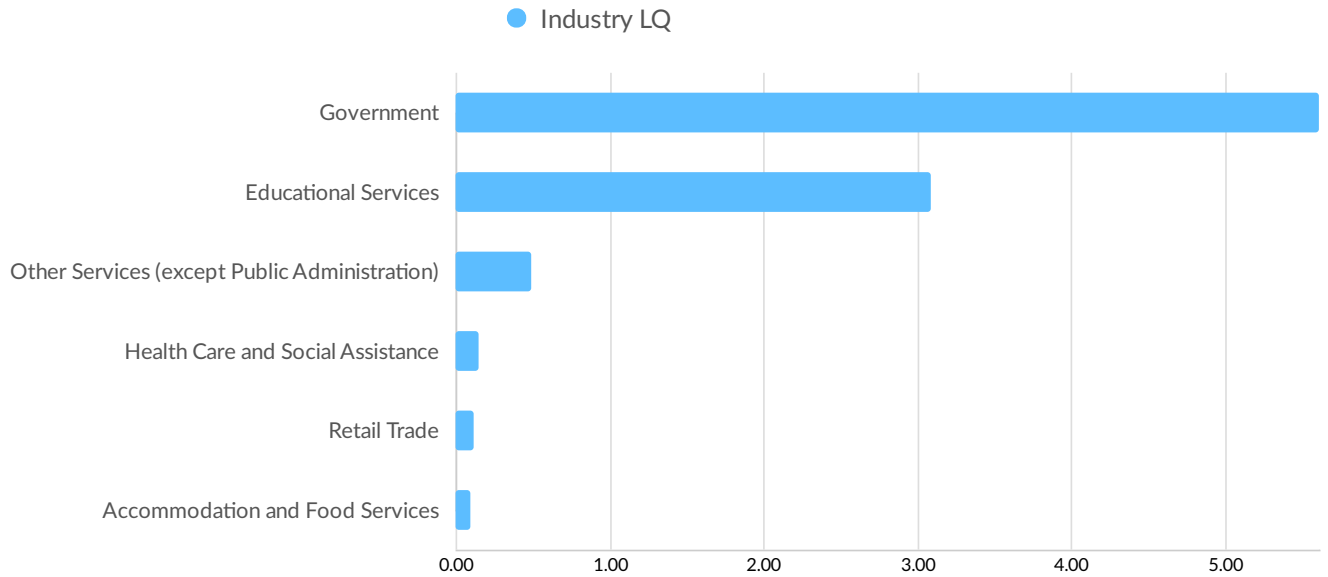

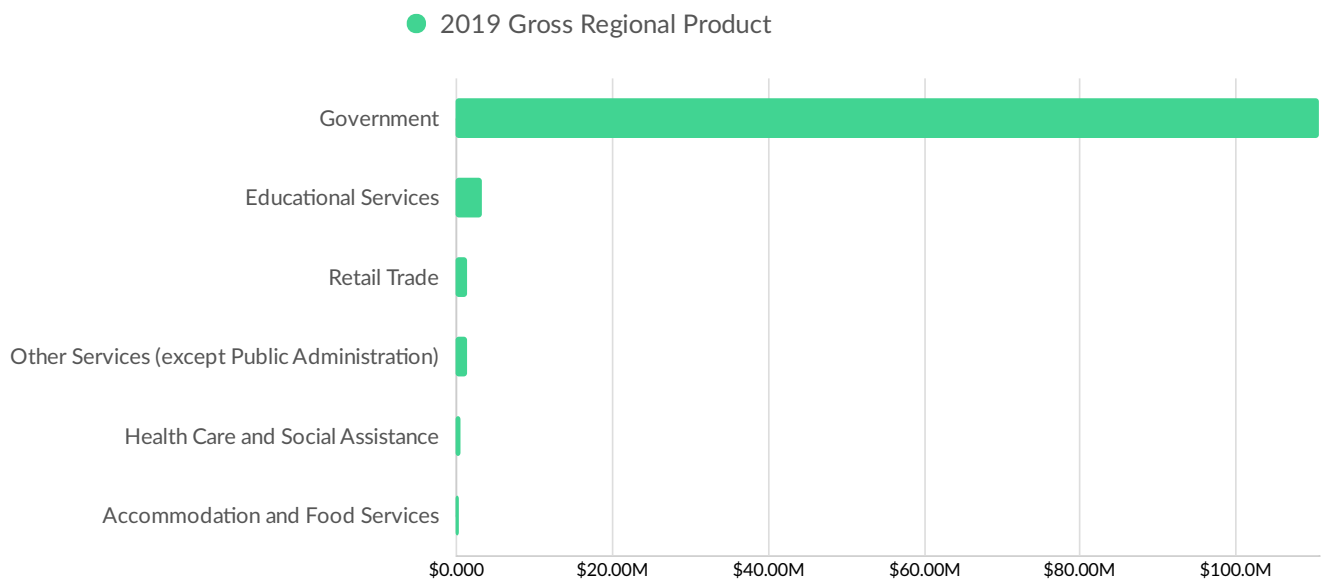

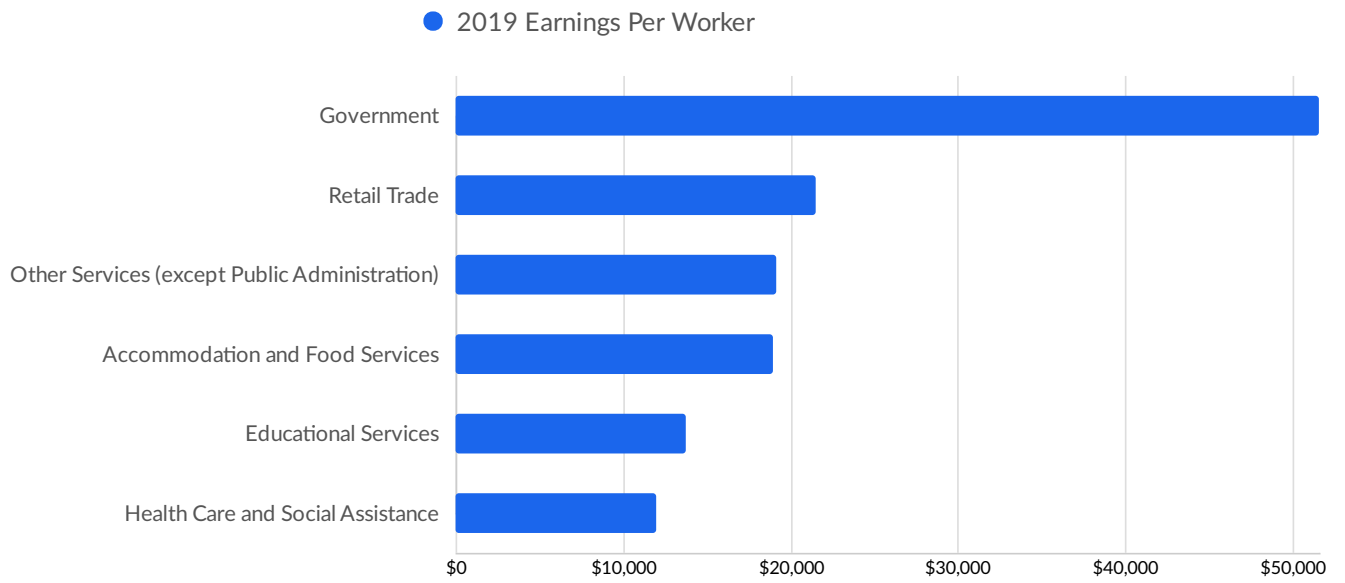

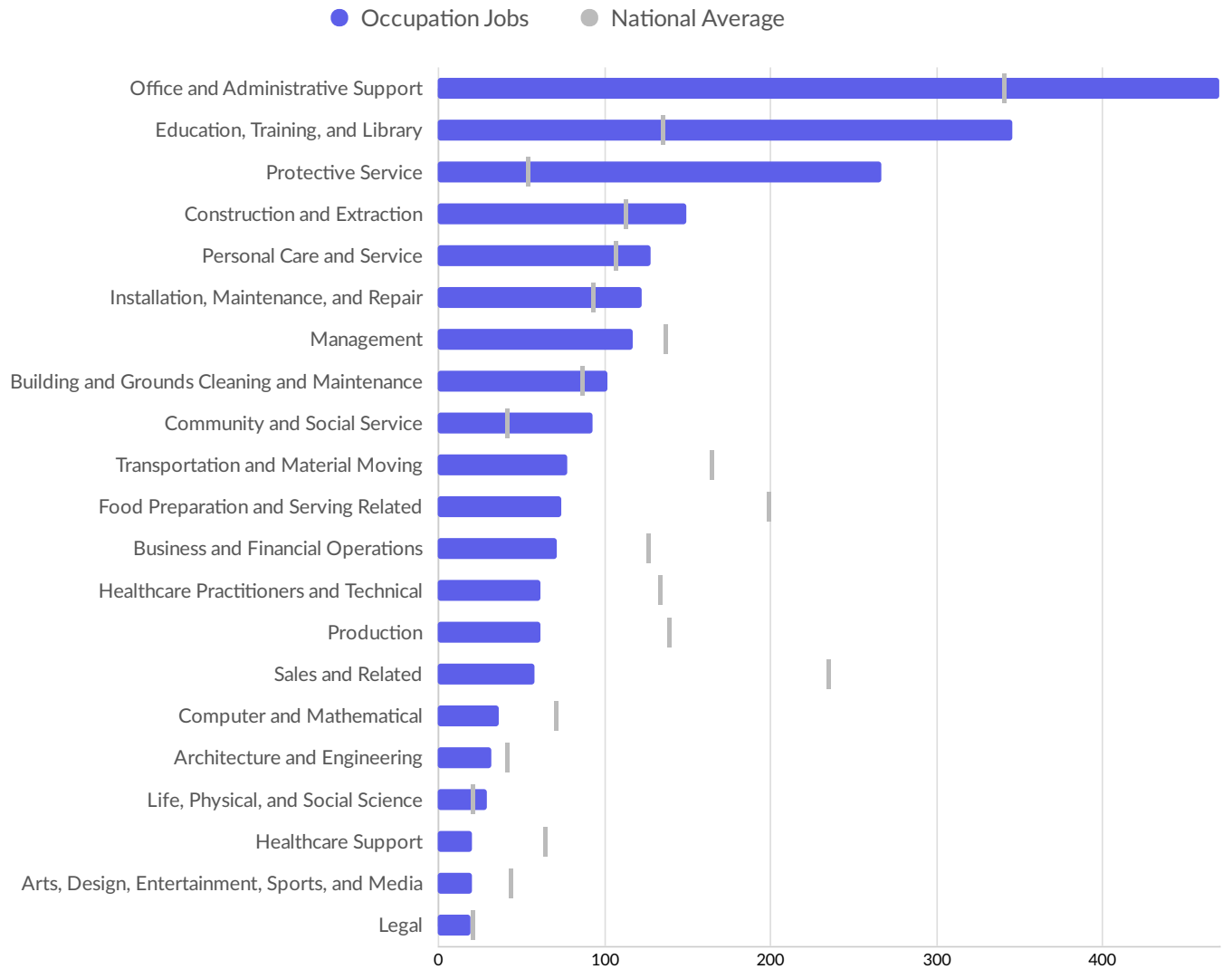

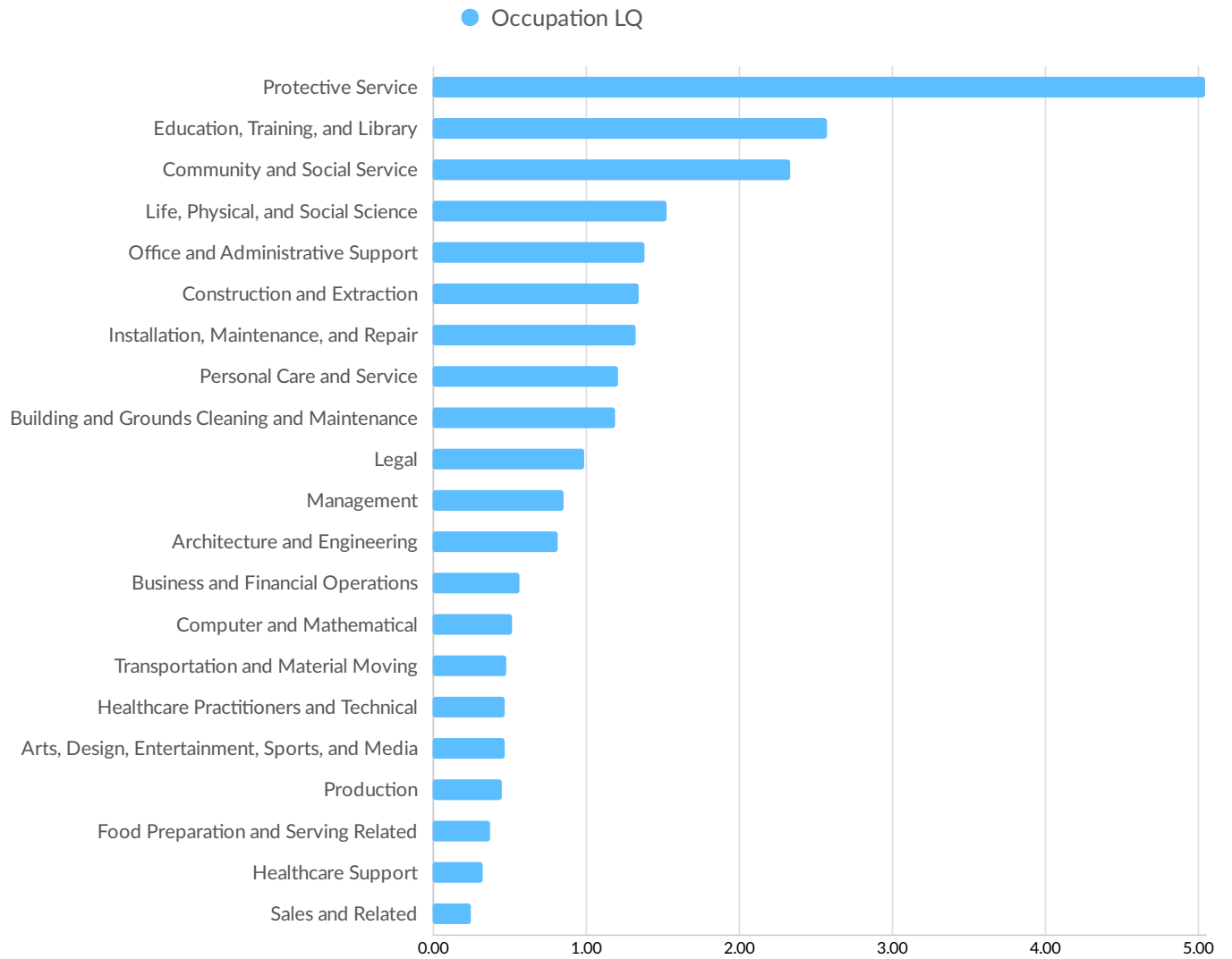

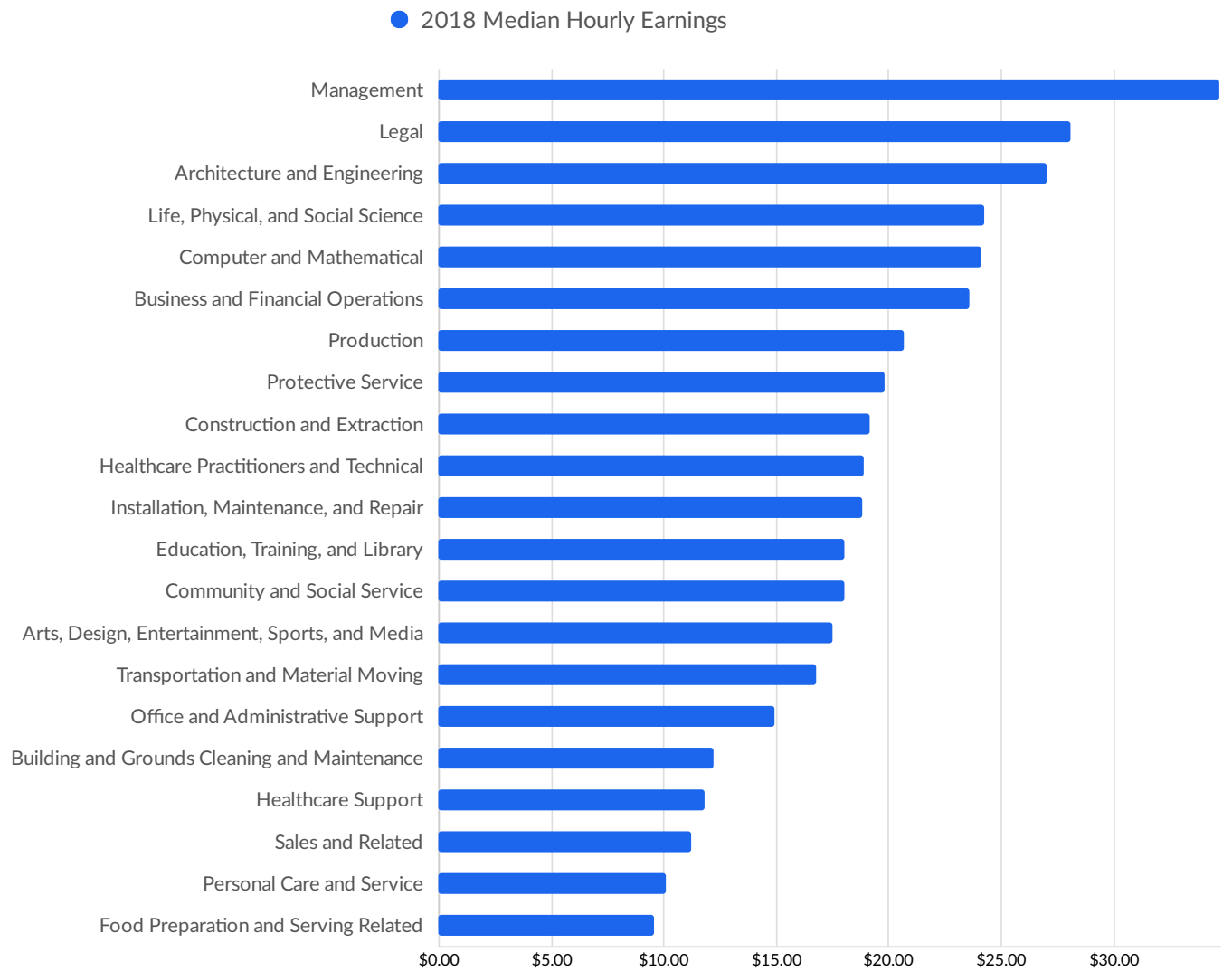

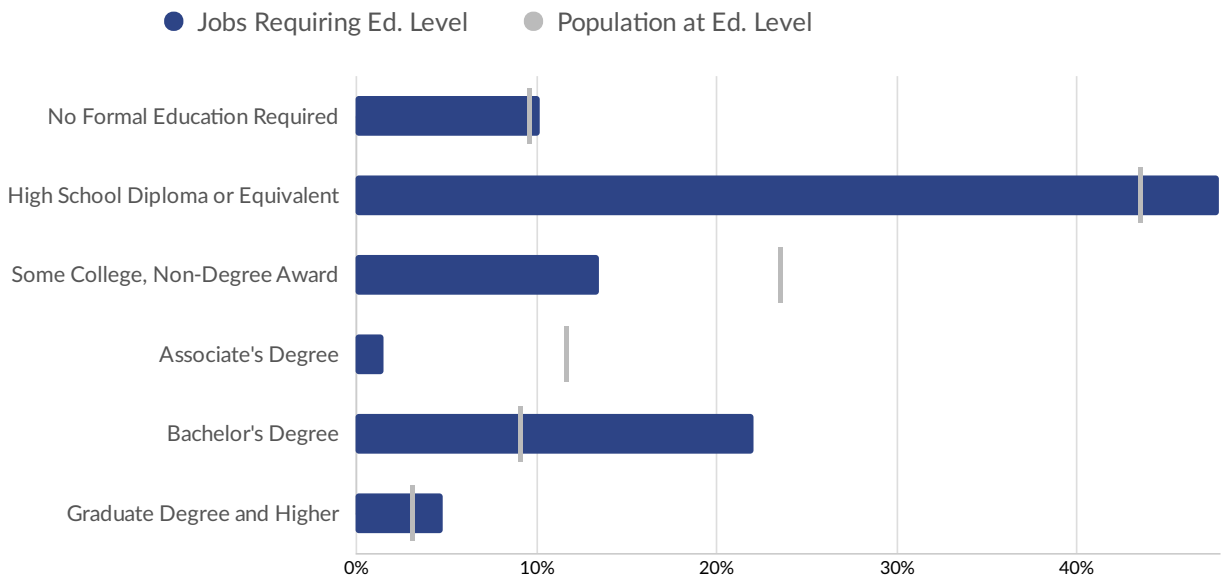
