East Central will consult with the Bureau of Endangered Resources on whether the approval of this permit will affect a listed or endangered species. The presence of listed or endangered species may affect certain aspects of the non-metallic mining site.

SECTION 4 - RECLAMATION PLAN SUBMITTAL

Please submit three (3) **copies** of a **complete** reclamation plan and (1) digital copy which meets the standards of the applicable County's Non-Metallic Mining Reclamation Ordinance (Part II - Standards). The landowner or lessee must also provide signed certification that they concur with the reclamation plan and will allow for its implementation. The Applicant will be required to post an appropriate amount of financial assurance (to be calculated by the applicant and agreed upon by ECWRPC, as required by the NR-135 and the applicable County's Non-Metallic Mining Reclamation Ordinance no later than 15 days prior to approval and issuance of the Reclamation Permit.
