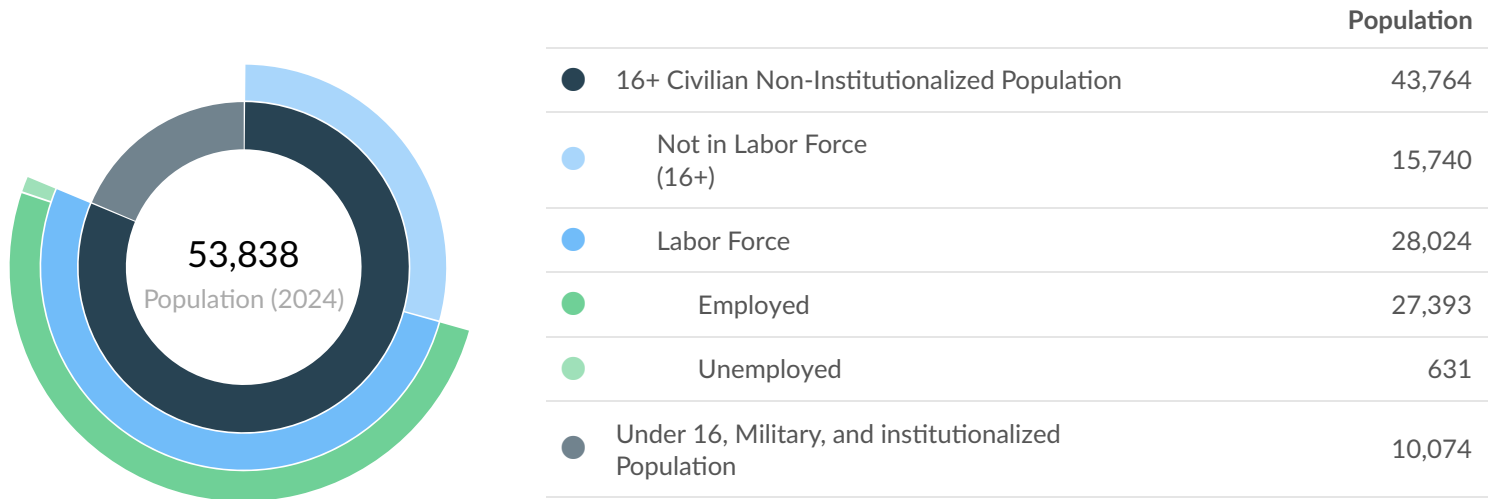

## Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 7.4%** since 2019, growing by 3,726. Population is expected to **increase by 5.1%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 2,731.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 11.6%** in Calumet County, WI from 16,744 to **18,684**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 7.7%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 69.4% to 64.0% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **23.2% of Calumet County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.8% above the national average), and **14.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Agriculture, Construction, and Mining Machinery Manufacturing, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.

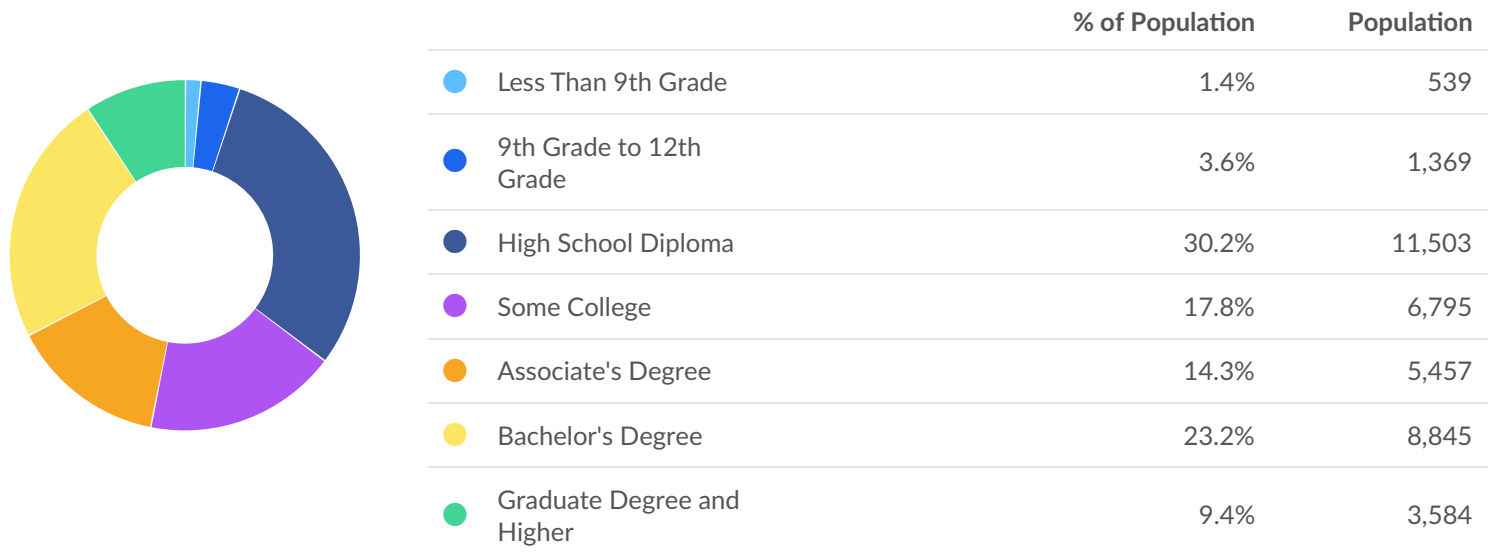

## Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



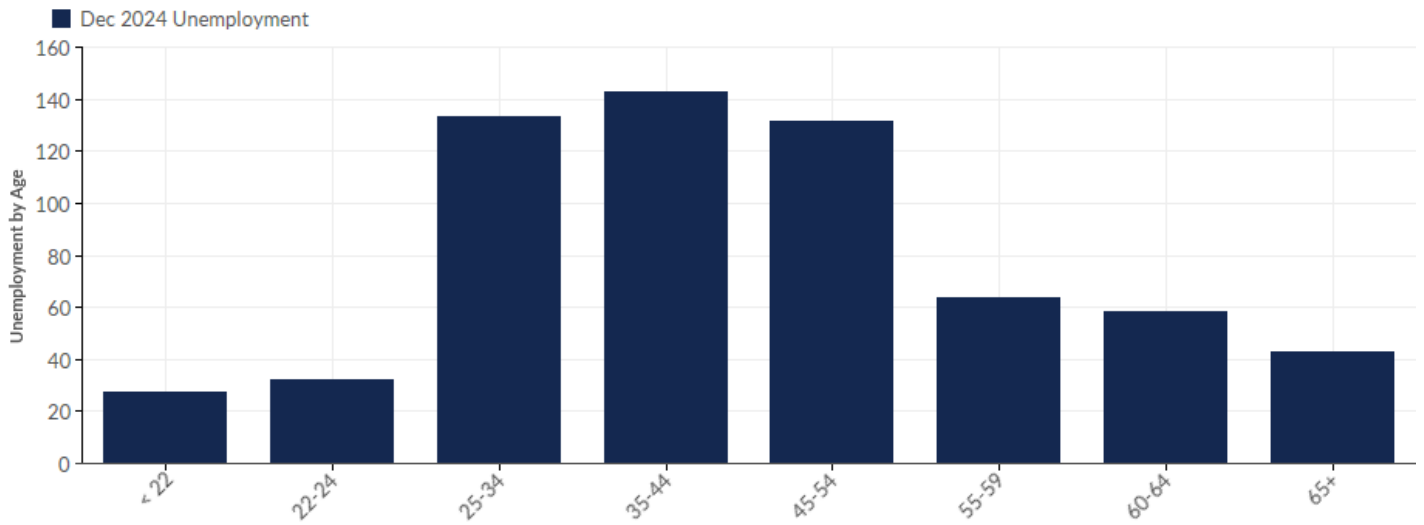
## Educational Attainment

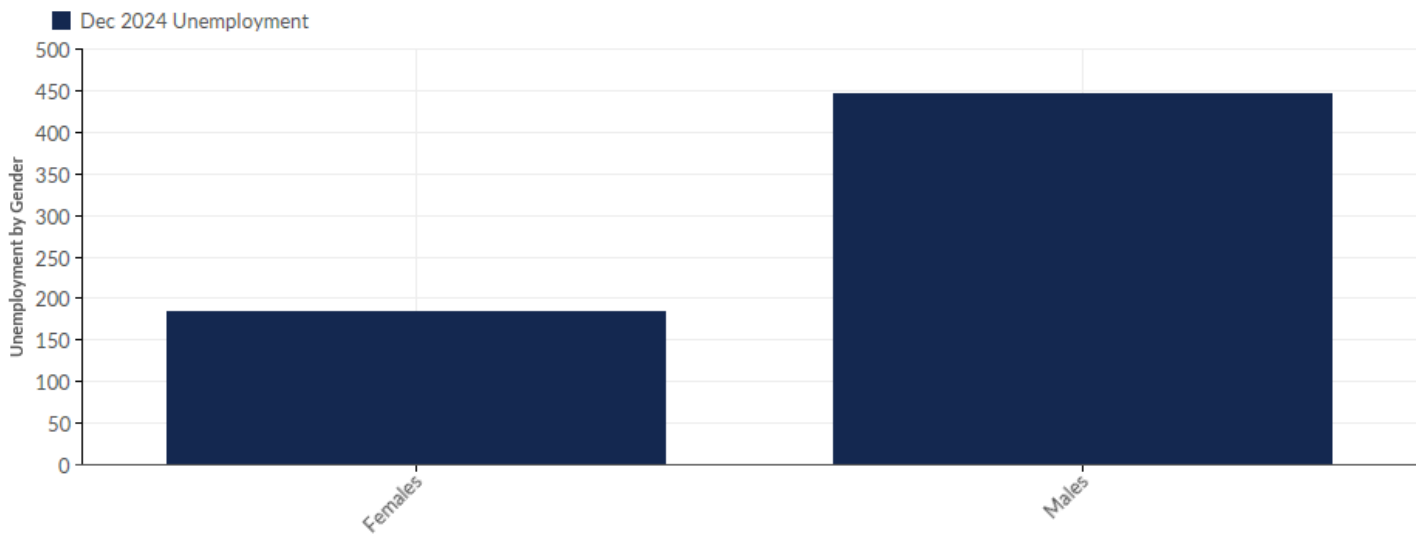

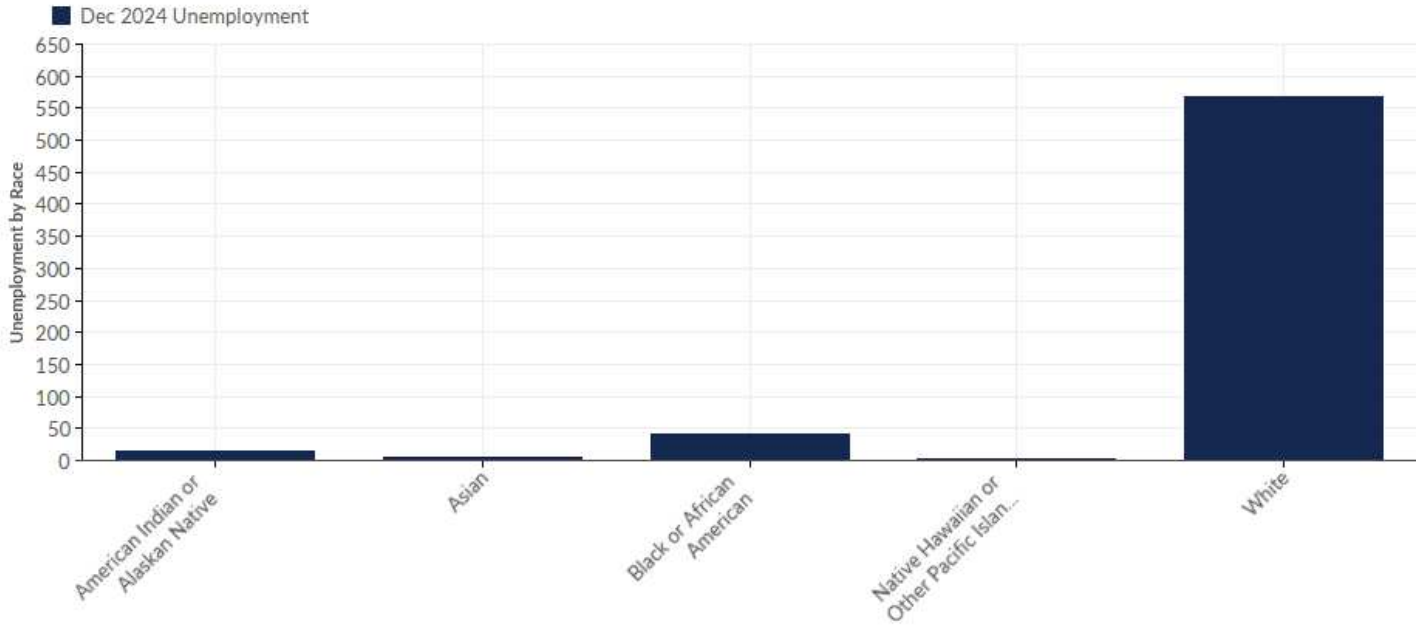

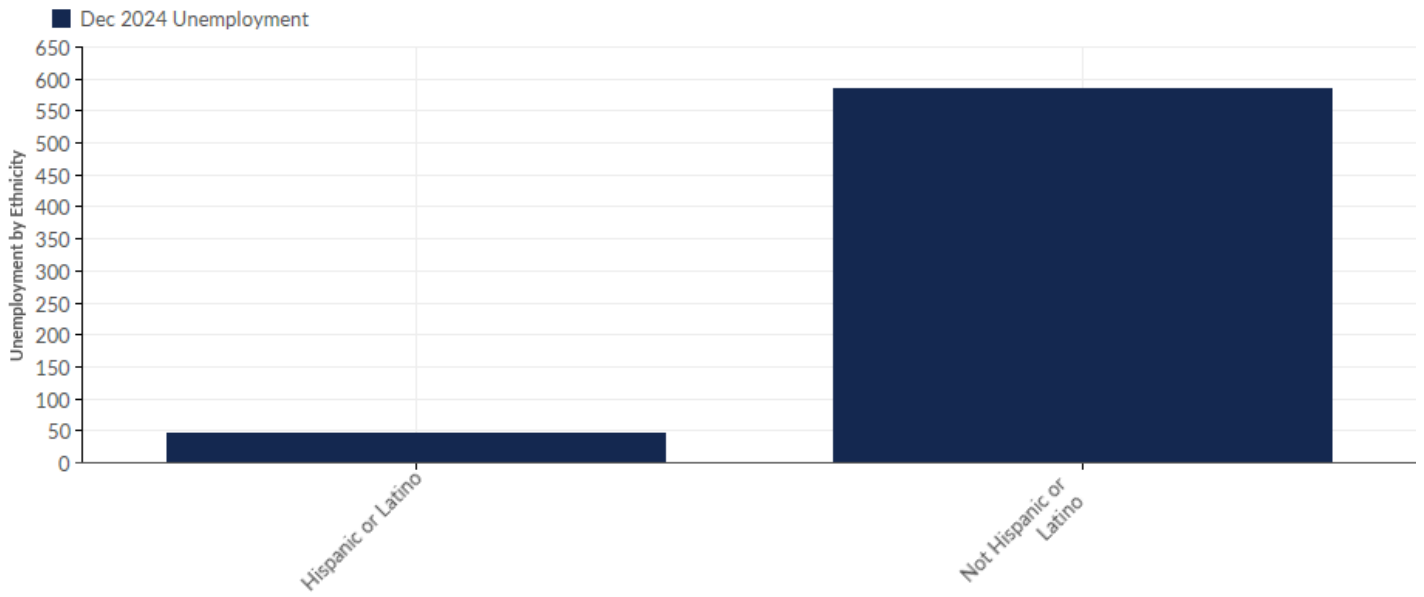

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

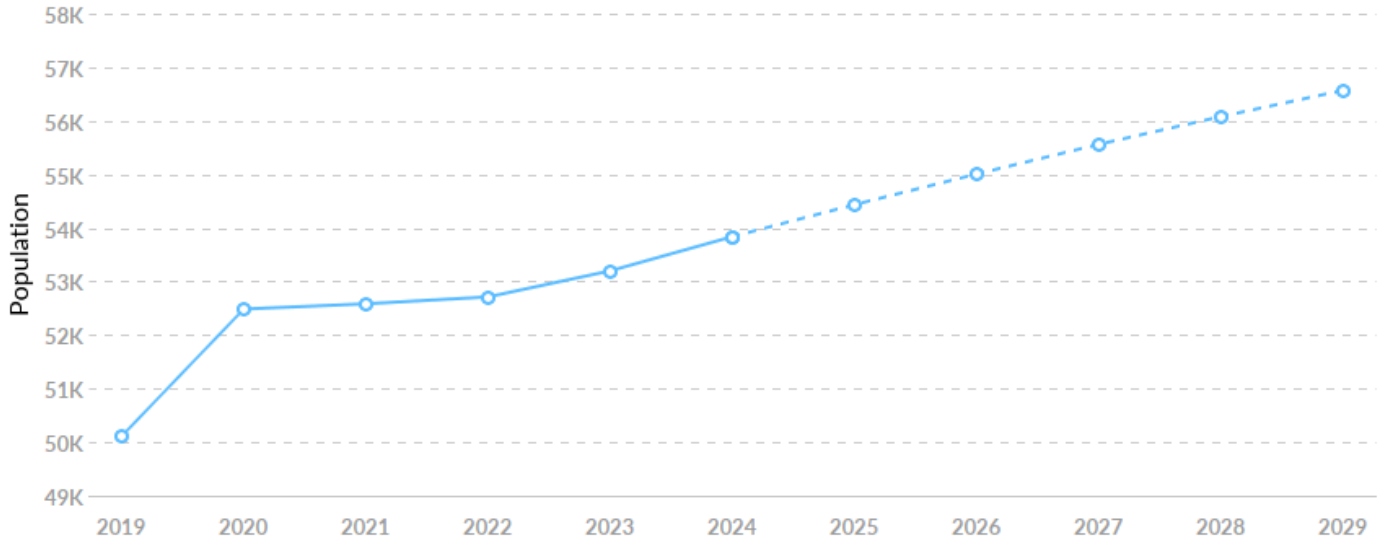

## Population Trends

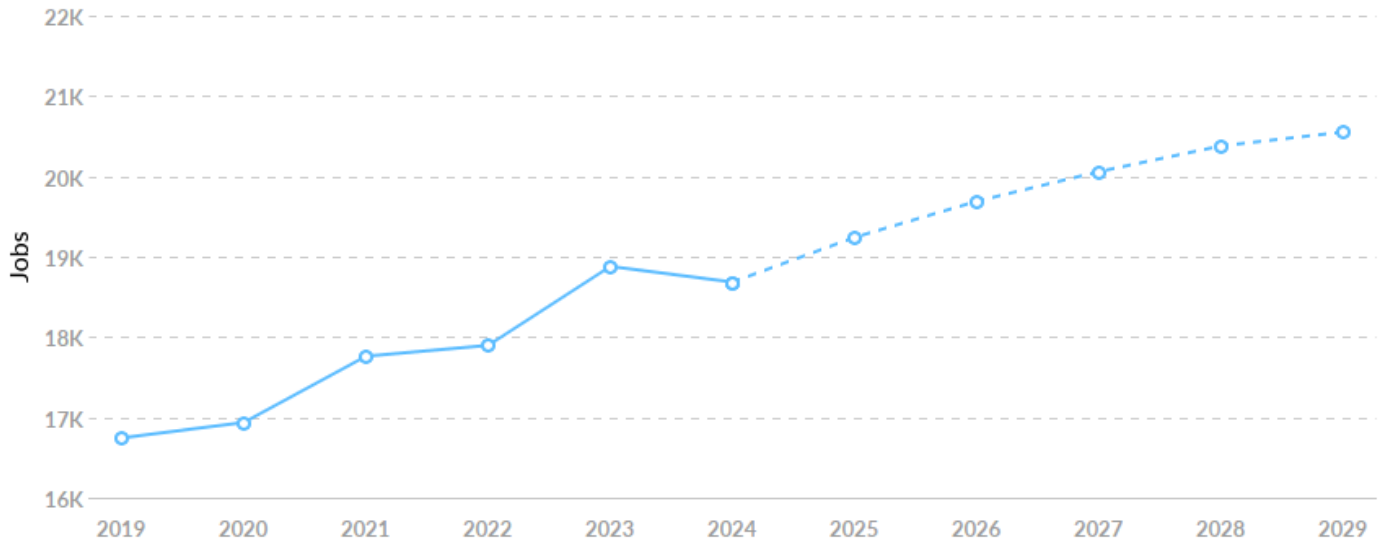

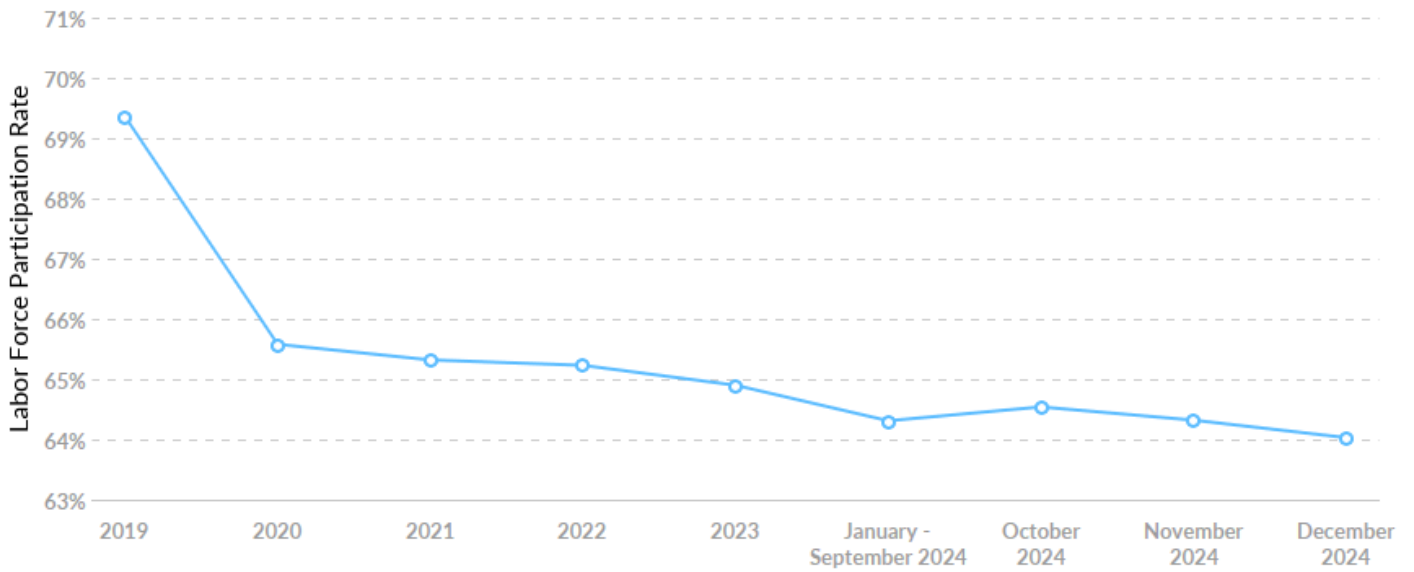
## Job Trends

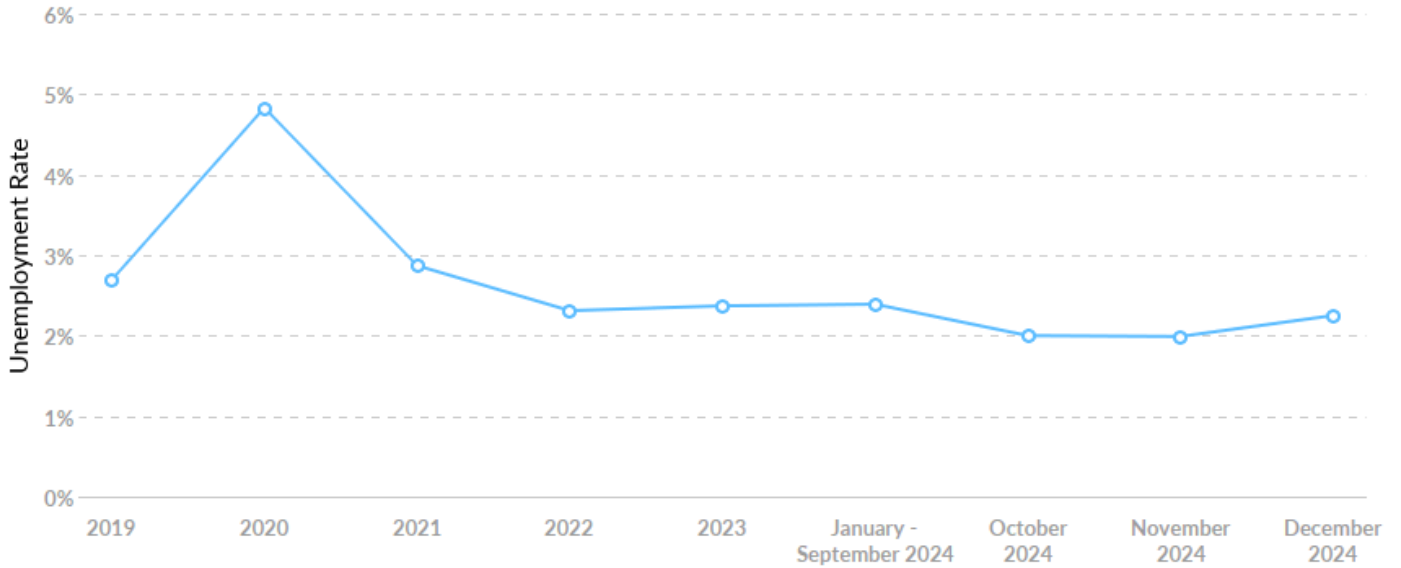

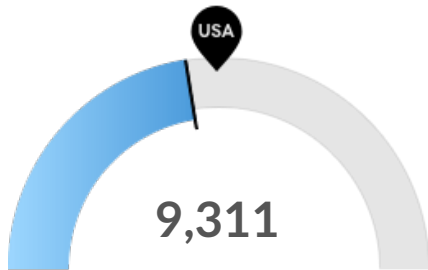
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Calumet County, WI had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 2.25%, decreasing from 2.69% 5 years before.



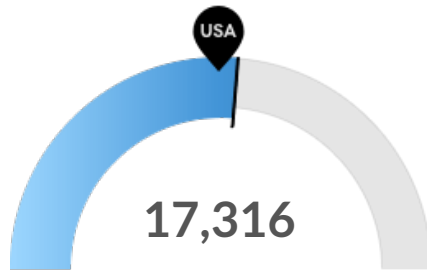

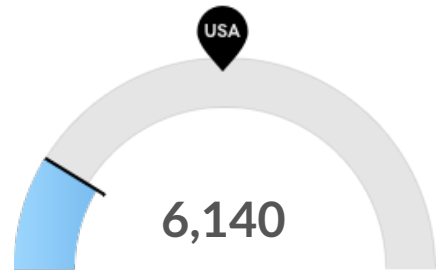
**Millennials**

Calumet County, WI has 9,311 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,809.



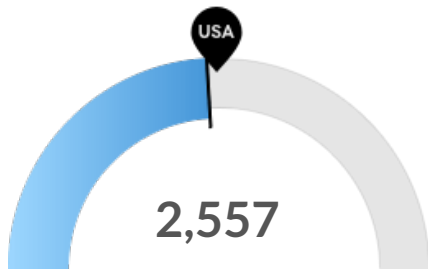
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Calumet County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 16,060 people 55 or older, while there are 17,316 here.



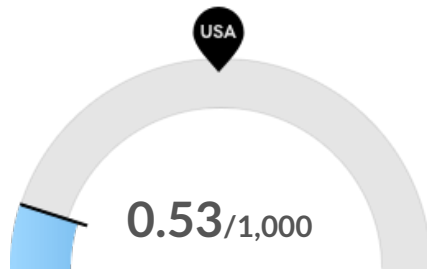
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Calumet County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 22,156 racially diverse people, while there are 6,140 here.



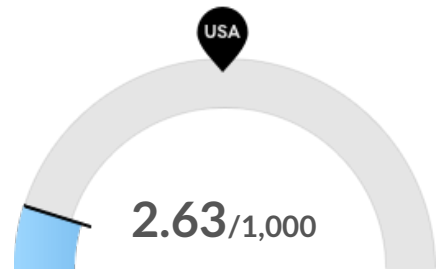
**Veterans**

Calumet County, WI has 0.53 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

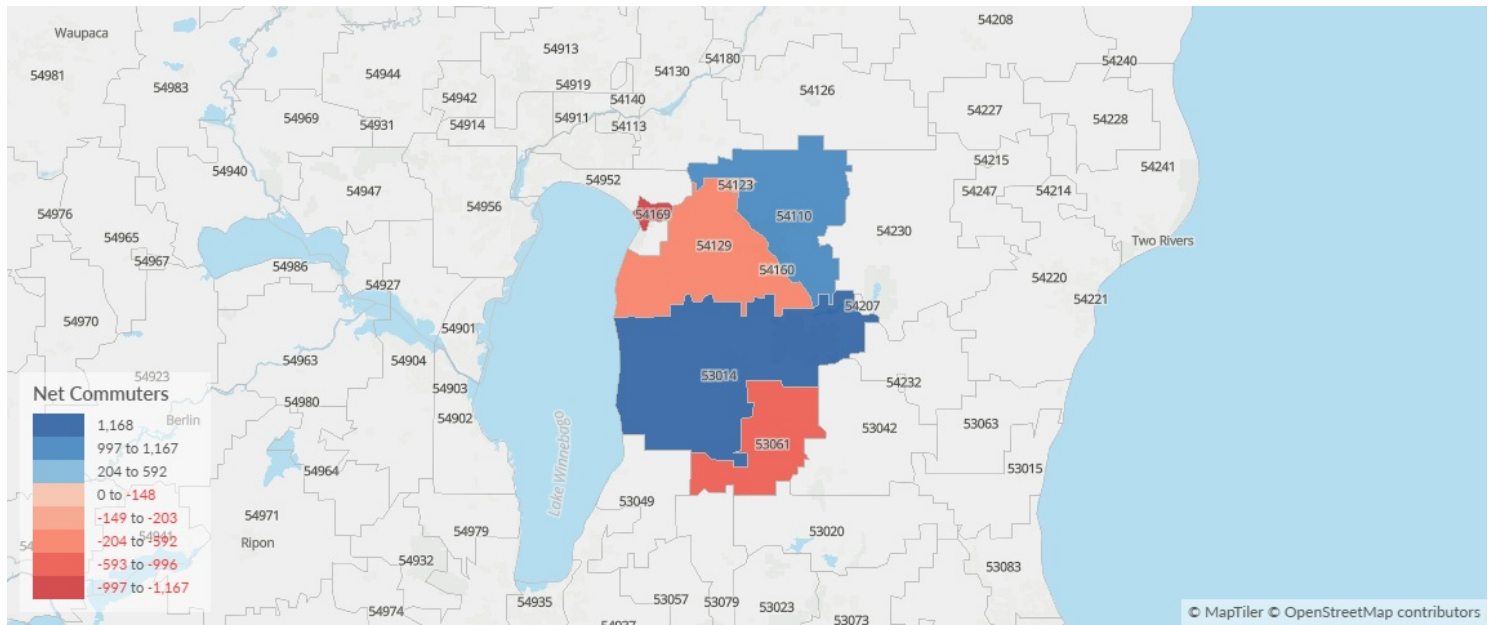


**Property Crime**

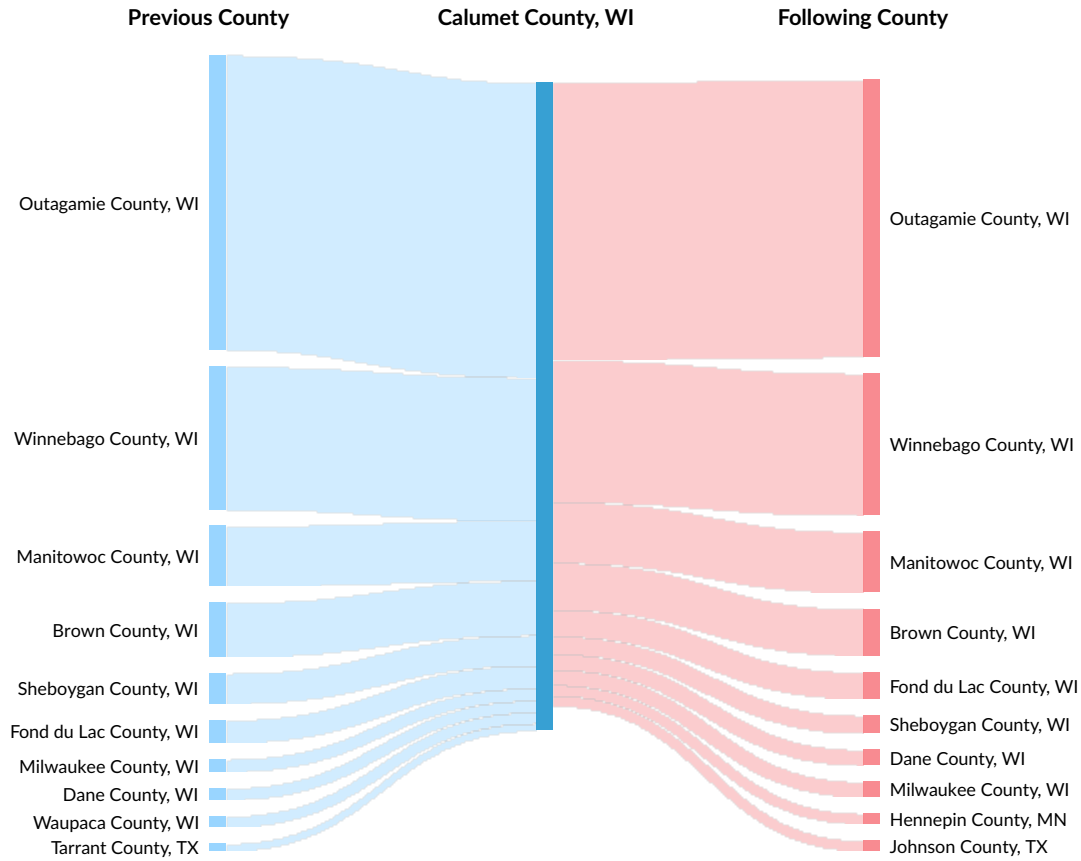

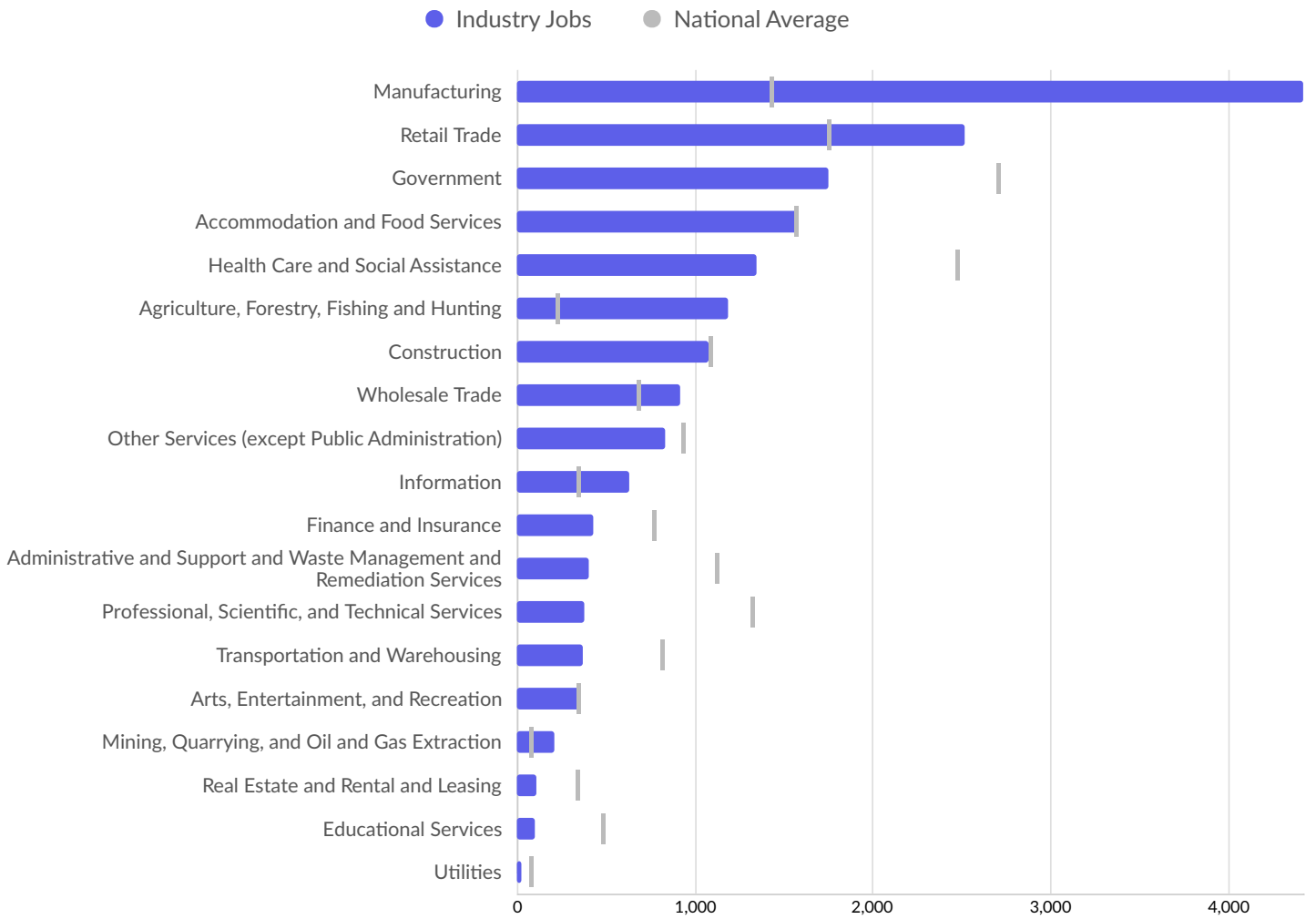

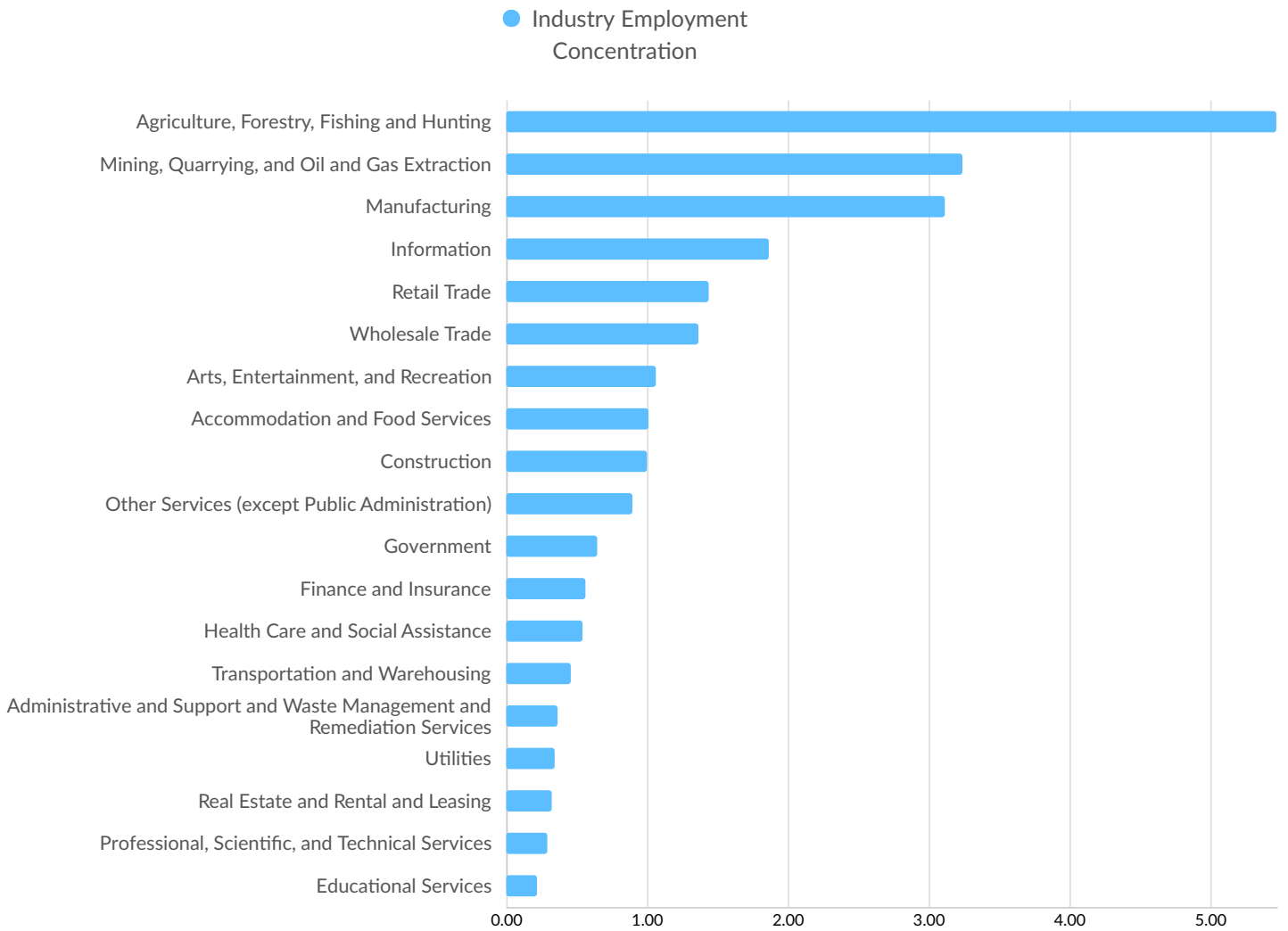

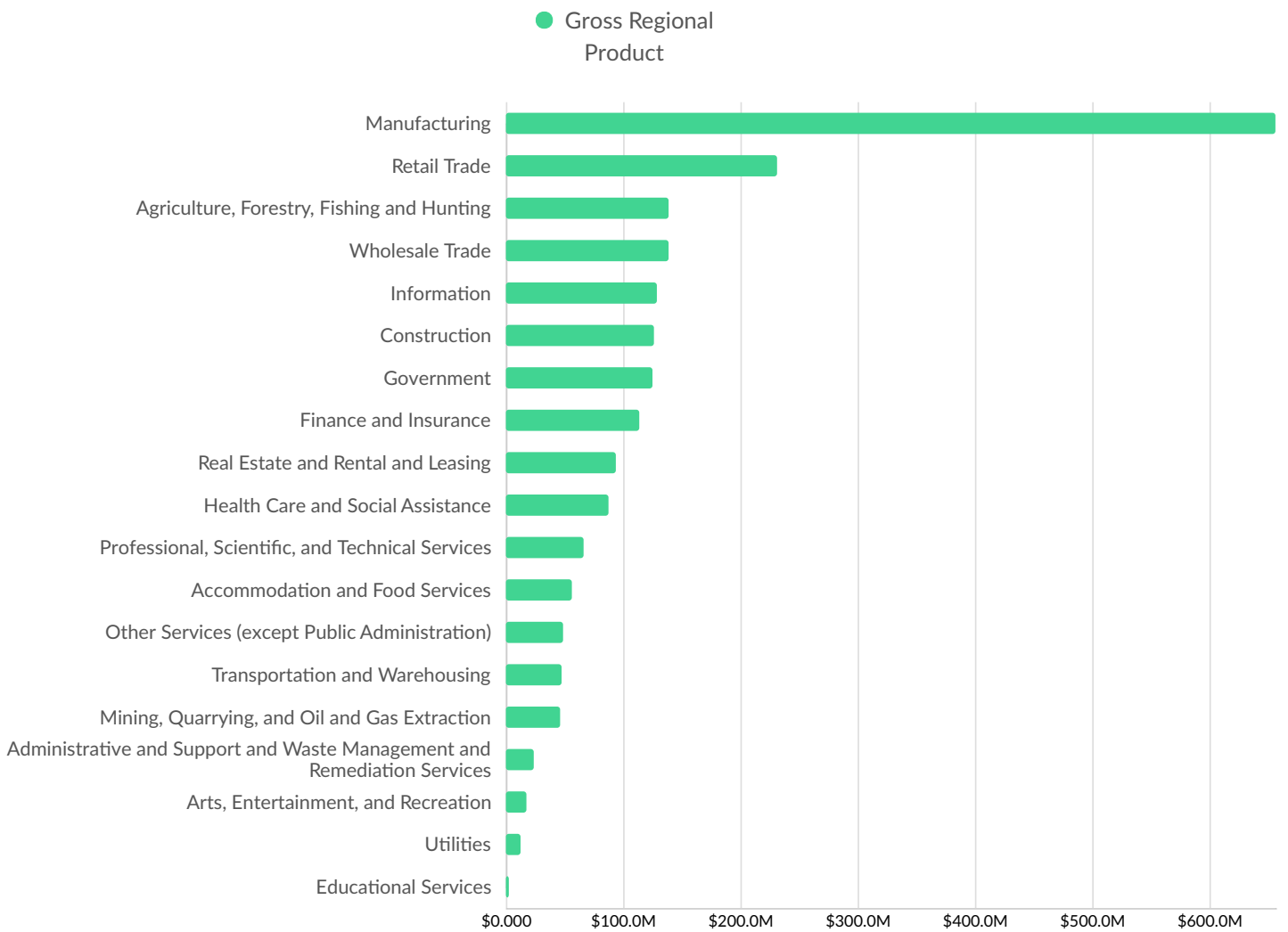

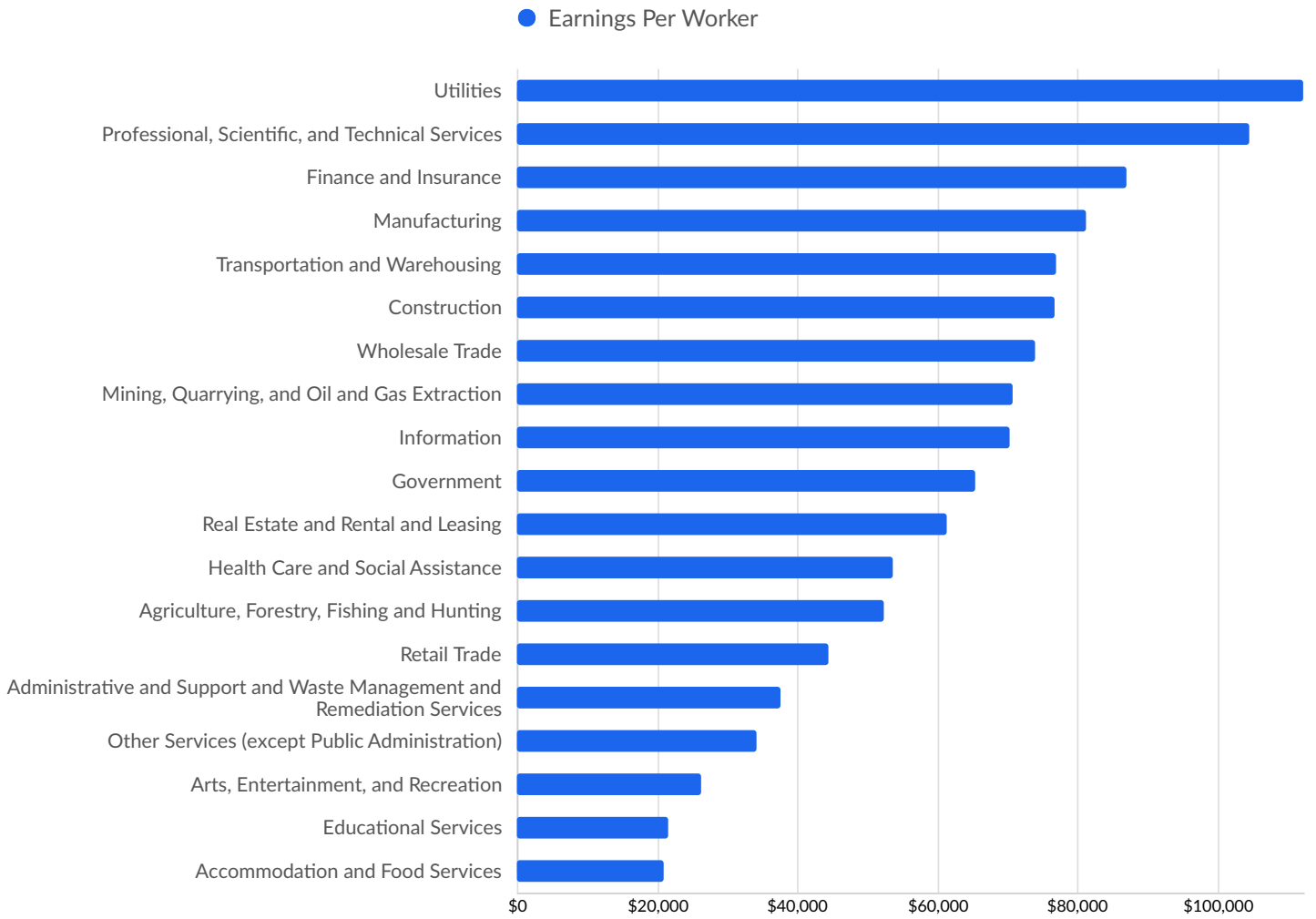
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

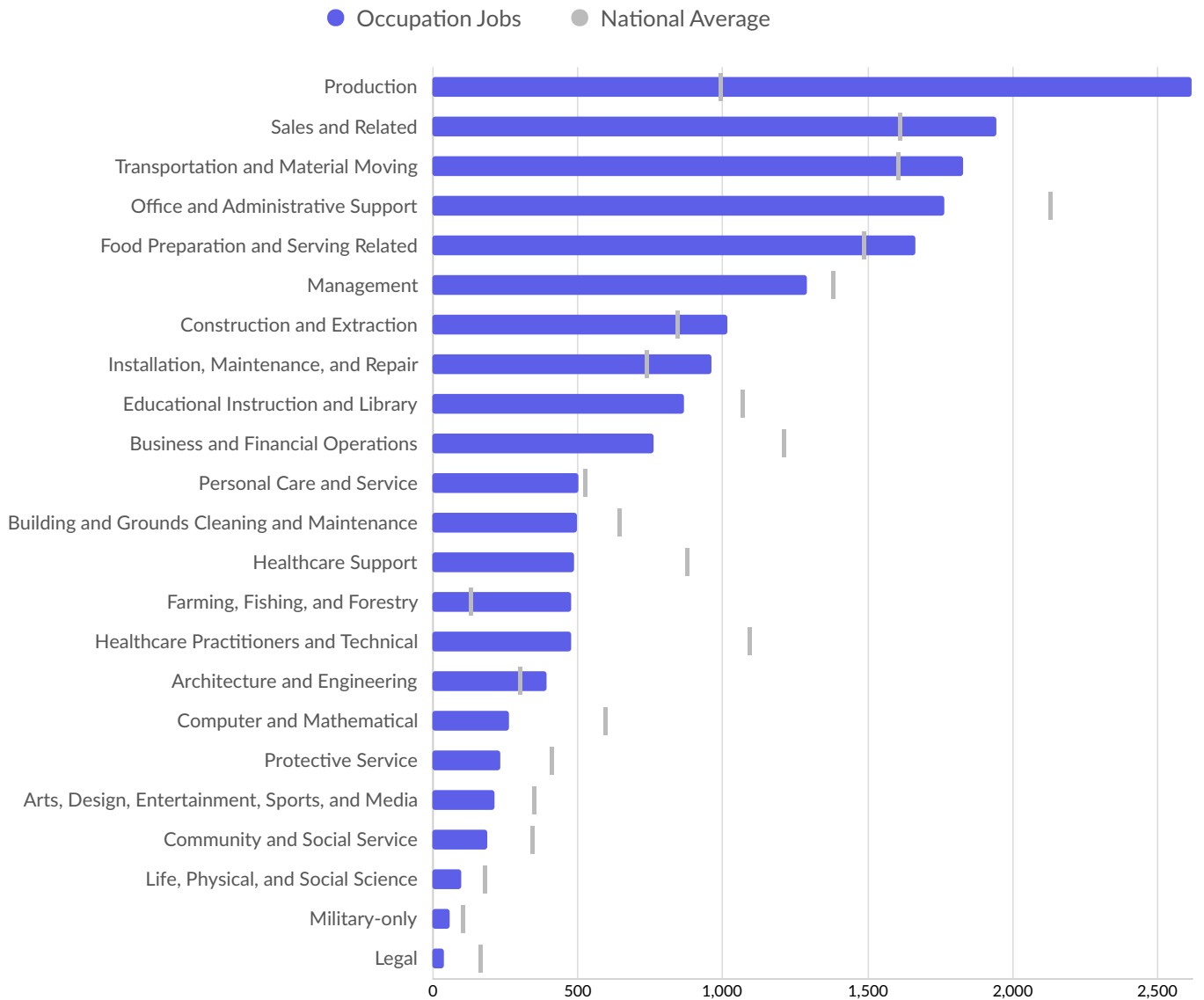

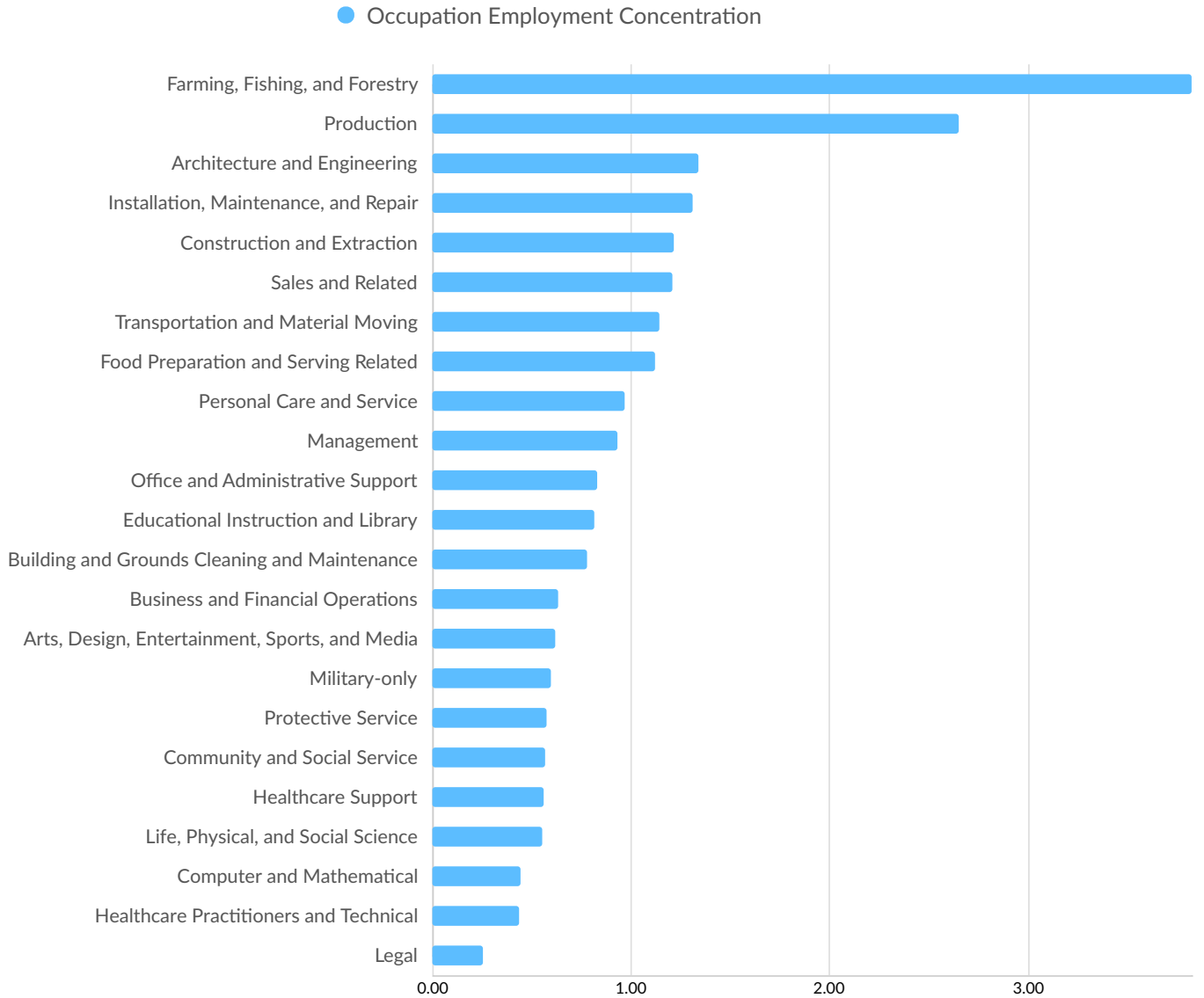
## Largest Occupations



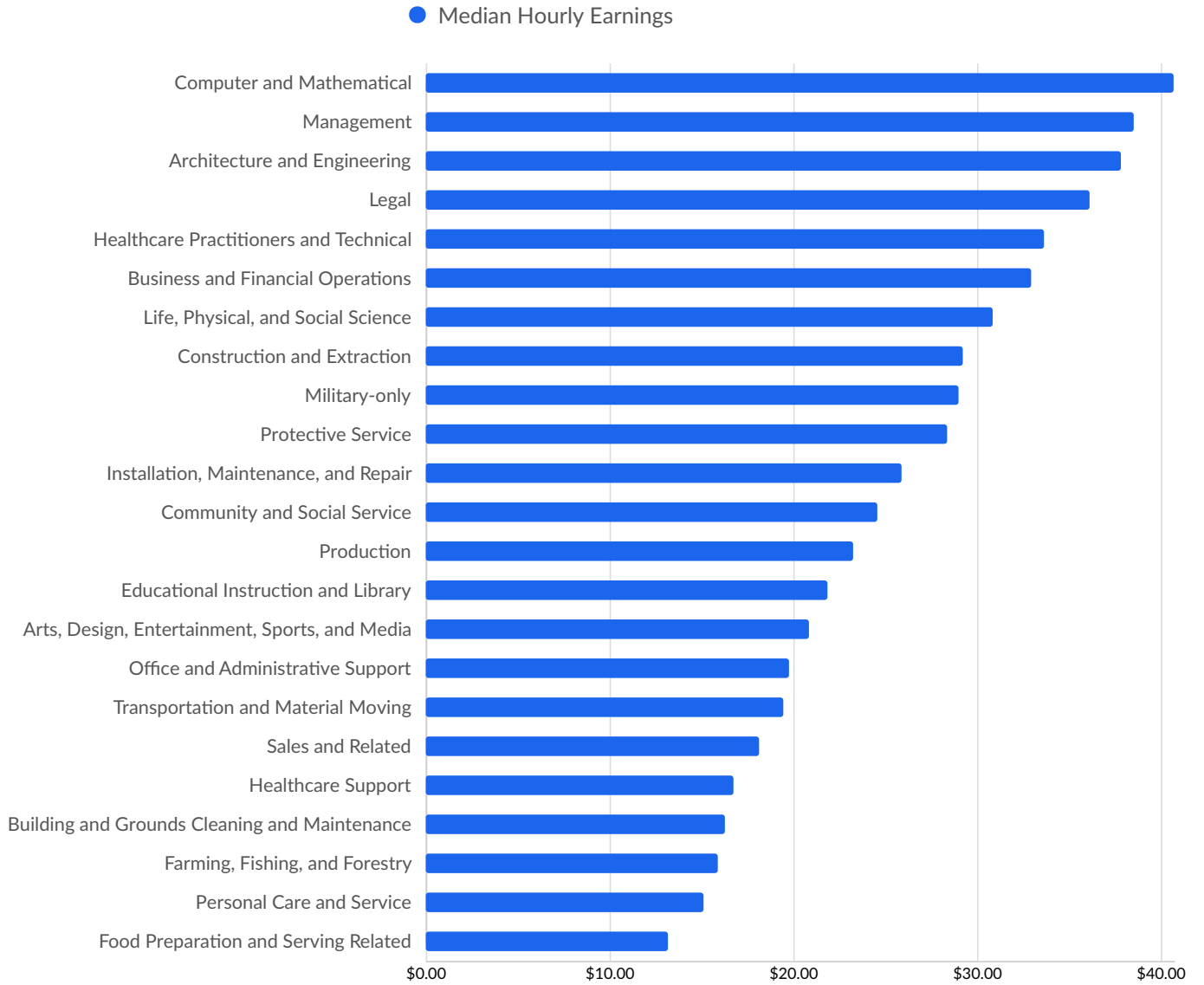
## Top Growing Occupations



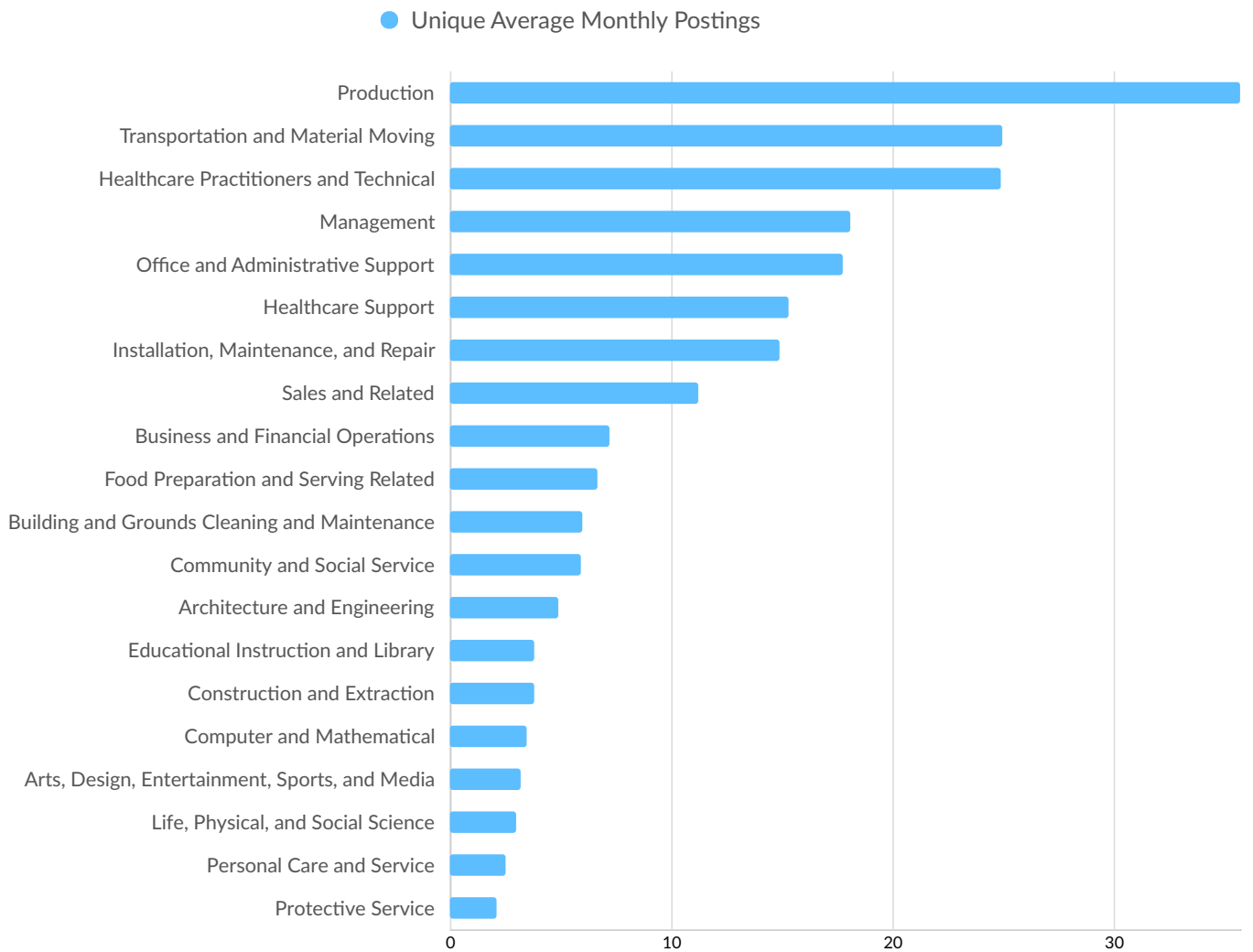
## Top Occupation Employment Concentration



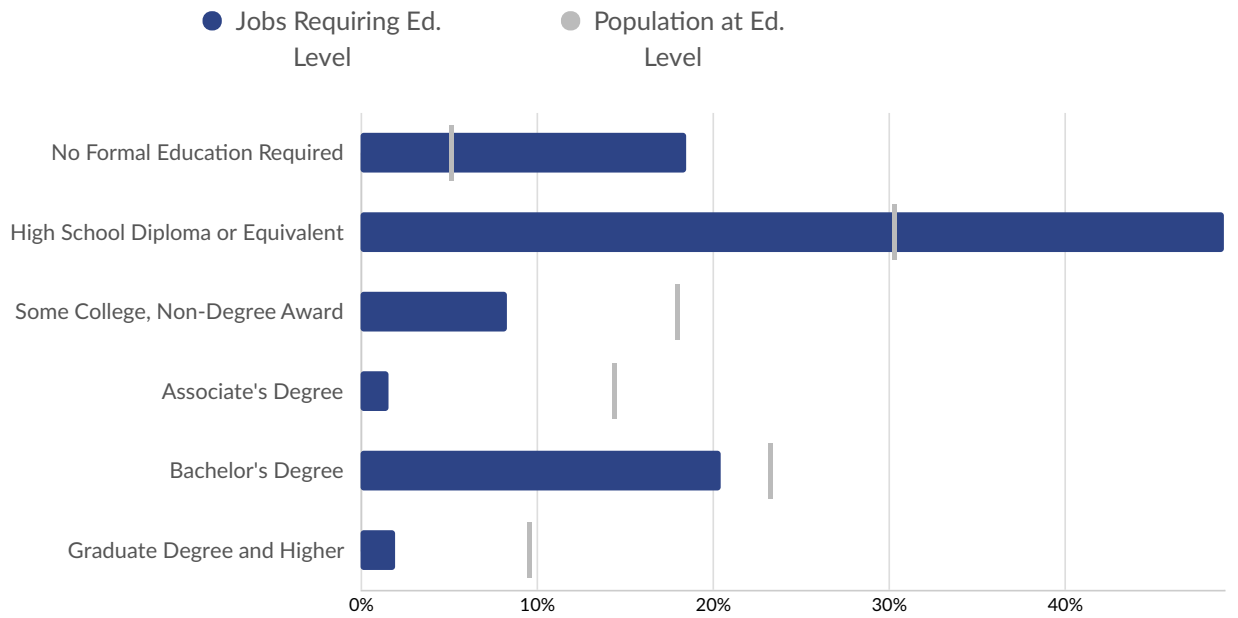
