- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 4.0% in Fond du Lac County, WI from 53,179 to 51,078. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 7.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 69.8% to 68.0% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.8% of Fond du Lac County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.7% below the national average), and **13.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Engine, Turbine, and Power Transmission Equipment Manufacturing, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Fond du Lac County, WI had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 2.53%, decreasing from 2.82% 5 years before.




Millennials

Fond du Lac County, WI has 18,527 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 21,121.




Fond du Lac County, WI has 5,917 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 5.307.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Fond du Lac County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 31,379 people 55 or older, while there are 35,887 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Fond du Lac County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 43,291 racially diverse people, while there are 13,593 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 2,061 graduates in Fond du Lac County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 4% over the last 5 years.
